

MAIN GAPS

Authorities in Nigeria have been receiving several Nigerian nationals expelled particularly from Cameroon via the border area. UNHCR continues to work with authorities to advocate for and support full compliance of return movements with international standards aimed at ensuring the voluntariness of return and the dignity and security of returnees.

In Niger health facilities in both camps needs to be strengthened - the nearest hospital for Sayam Forage camp is situated in Diffa (45 km).

In Cameroon a new refugee camps is needed in order to endure to the refugee population all the basic needs and the assistance

Education seems to be a gap in all the countries. New schools and trained teachers are needed.
