Like nearly 200,000 other internally displaced people who have fled violence in northern Mali, Hidjaba is struggling to care for her family; 'I am ready to do anything to be able to buy food for my children'. Since January multiple waves of violence have tested the resilience of civilians caught up in the conflict.

UNHCR is providing non-food assistance to thousands of families. but is stretched in its efforts to help the displaced people of Mali.

Number of Syrian refugees hits half-a-million as winter sets in

The number of registered Syrian refugees has now exceeded 500,000, with estimates suggesting there may be up to 1 million in the first half of 2013. It is also likely that hundreds of thousands of unregistered refugees will come forward in the coming months, as resources diminish in host communities.

With the onset of winter, life in the refugee camps is becoming extremely challenging. **UNHCR and its** partners are working tirelessly to prepare for the winter, distributing thermal blankets and winter clothing, providing gas heaters, and building storm drainage systems.
