



## UNHCR urgently needs funds to assist displaced Malians

UNHCR has renewed its appeal to help meet the needs of more than 175,000 Malian refugees and 282,000 internally displaced people.

"UNHCR needs US\$144 million to cover the basic protection and assistance needs,"stressed spokesman Adrian Edwards. "So far we have only received 32 per cent of this amount."

The funding will go towardsthe expansion and construction of transit centres, provision of supplementary and therapeutic food, shelters and other core relief items, and the delivery of basic services such as health care, water and sanitation and education.

# UNHCR and Partners Tackle Malnutrition in Mauritania Camp

Malnutrition is one of UNHCR's main concerns in the Mbera refugee camp in Mauritania, which hosts more than 70,000 Malians. This photo gallery Rosette Wabenga, a Congolese refugee, has thanked UNHCR for helping her secure a small-business loan that enabled her to set up a beauty salon. "Words cannot express how grateful I am to UNHCR. They have helped me fulfil my dream," she exclaimed.

After Rosette's husband was captured and imprisoned in 2006, she and her three children fled the Democratic Republic of the Congo and moved to Uganda. Years later, Rosette suffered again when she was kidnapped briefly. The loan from InterAid - a counselling, health and legal aid service funded by UNHCR - has allowed her to move on with her life.


# UNHCR report says Syrian influx strains host country health services

A UNHCR report released has warned that the Syrian refugee crisis is increasingly straining the health services of host countries. Refugees with chronic and other costly health conditions are also shown to be facing increasing difficulties in accessing the quality treatment they need.

The report coveres the first three months of 2013 in Iraq, Jordan and Lebanon where more than 1 million Syrian refugees currently reside. It highlights how low funding levels alongside an increasing demand for services is having a detrimental effect on the health systems in these countries.
