




Total monthly arrivals and voluntary returns of Syrians in Turkey



Total registered Syrian refugee population in camps and non-camp locations by province



The total registered Syrian refugee population stood at 624,308 (35% in camps; 65% outside camps) at the end of February 2014. This represents a 2% increase in the proportion of total non-camp refugees compared to the past month. The actual difference in the monthly increase of registered non-camp refugees doubled between January and February 2014. This can be attributed mostly to the increased registration activities facilitated by the new mobile registration centres currently being used by AFAD in cities in Hatay, Sanliurfa and Gaziantep.

Monthly arrivals at the beginning of the year were significantly more than returns, similar to the beginning of 2013. Sanliurfa, Gaziantep, Kilis and Hatay provinces continue to register the highest refugee numbers in both camp and non-camp locations.
