Equestrian sport

Introduction

Equestrian sport featured on the Olympic programme for the first time at the Games of the II Olympiad in <u>Paris in 1900</u>. It was not staged at the next two editions of the Games, but returned in <u>1912</u>. Since then, the sport has always been on the programme. Until <u>1948</u>, only men could compete in the events, as the riders had to be officers. This restriction was lifted in 1951 and, since the Games of the XV Olympiad in <u>Helsinki in 1952</u>, women have competed with men in mixed events. They competed first in dressage, then gradually in the other equestrian events.

Key stages

participation

Entry	 1894: At the Paris Congress held in June, the desire was expressed for equestrian sport to be included on the Olympic programme.
	 1924: At the 23rd IOC Session held in Paris in June and July, the IOC drew up a list of obligatory and optional sports. Equestrian sport was placed in the first category.
Women's	• 1951: At the 46 th IOC Session, held in Vienna in May, it was decided that

women could henceforth compete in equestrian events.

Evolution in the number of events

- 1900 and 1912: 5 events (men's)
- 1920: 7 events (men's)
- 1924: 5 events (men's)
- 1928-1948: 6 events (men's)
- 1952: 6 events (4 men's and 2 mixed)
- 1956: 6 events (2 men's and 4 mixed)
- 1960: 5 events (2 men's and 3 mixed)
- 1964-2016: 6 mixed events
