



Directions to the Law Society pitch on Blackhall Place

If coming from Westmoreland Street/Grafton Street:

- Before crossing the bridge on to O'Connell street turn left onto Aston Quay.
- Continue along the Liffey for approximately 1.5km. (past the Ha'penny bridge, Temple Bar, Four Courts, Wood Quay, Usher's Quay)
- Turn right onto James Joyce Bridge (modern, wide, white and green, two lane bridge) and cross the river.
- Continue straight until you see the entrance for the Law Society, Blackhall Place on your left, approximately 200m from the bridge. There will be signs and volunteers at the gate to direct you.

If coming from O'Connell Street:

- Before crossing the bridge on to Westmoreland Street, turn right on to Bachelor's Walk
- Continue along the Liffey for approximately 1.5km.
- After Ellis Quay (past Smithfield), at the James Joyce Bridge turn right on to Blackhall Place.
- Continue straight until you see the entrance for the Law Society, Blackhall Place on your left, approximately 200m from the bridge. There will be signs and volunteers at the gate to direct you.

Parking is available here for about 100 cars in the Law Society car park. Alternatively, street parking is available around the area and close by on Queen Street and Smithfield Square.

By LUAS: The nearest Luas stop is Smithfield

By Bus: The 37, 39/a/c, 70/a and 70n buses stop on Blackhall Place
