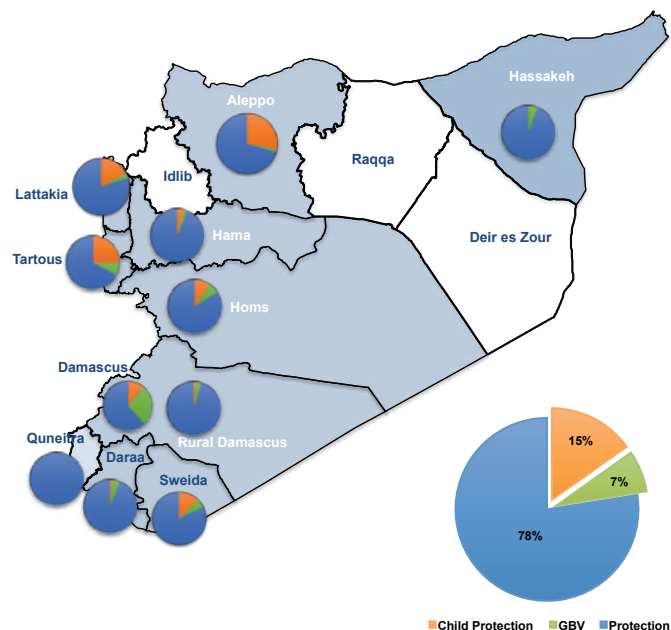
WORKING WITH PARTNERS

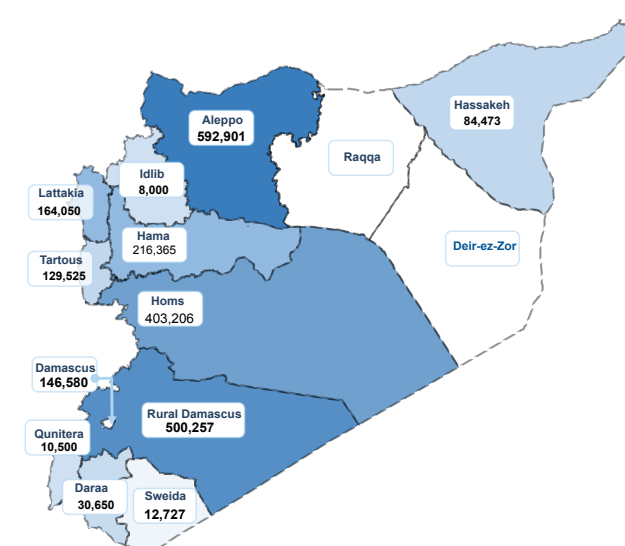

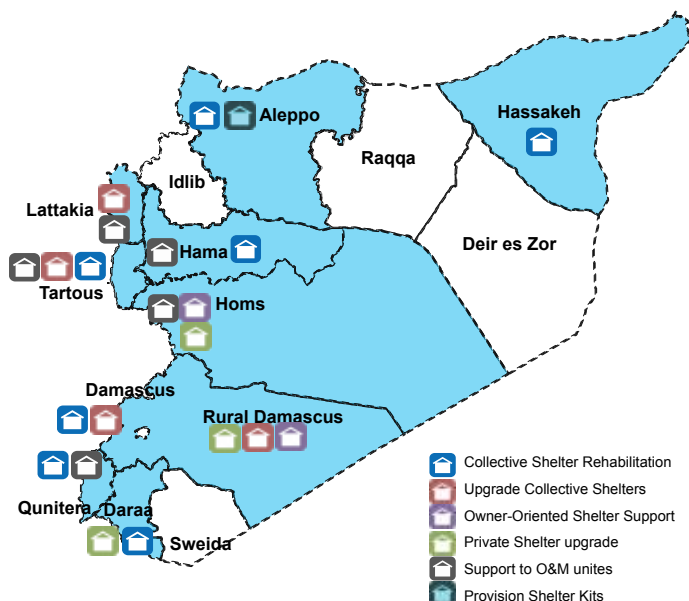
Core Relief Items

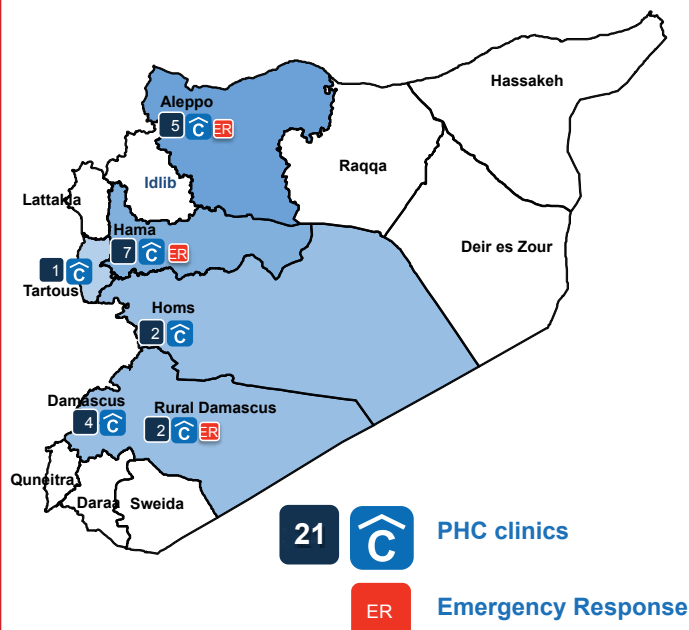
