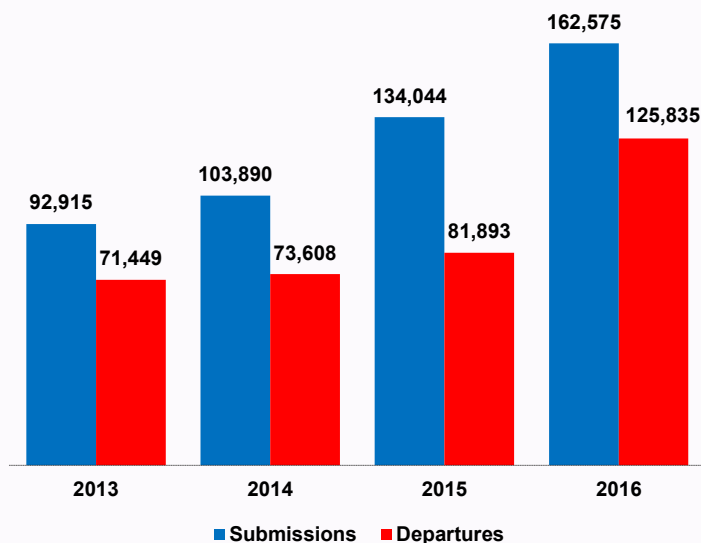

UNHCR RESETTLEMENT IN 2016

- Resettlement took place from 79 countries of asylum involving refugees from 71 countries of origin.
- 162,575 individuals submitted for resettlement (+21% compared to 2015).
- 125,835 individuals departed for resettlement (+54% compared to 2015).
- UNHCR submissions from the Africa region reached 44,000 individuals.
- Some 80,500 refugees from the Democratic Republic of the Congo have been submitted since launch of the programme in 2012.

RESPONSE TO THE SYRIA EMERGENCY

- 76,943 Syrians were submitted for resettlement from MENA and Turkey, compared to 53,005 in 2015. The largest number of Syrians came from Jordan (30,181), Lebanon (23,498) and Turkey (16,682).
- The largest number of Syrians were submitted to the United States (34,427), Canada (16,890) and the United Kingdom (7,476).
- 47,773 Syrians departed for resettlement from MENA and Turkey.
- From MENA and Turkey combined, more than 156,000 Syrian refugees have been submitted for resettlement and humanitarian admission since 2013.

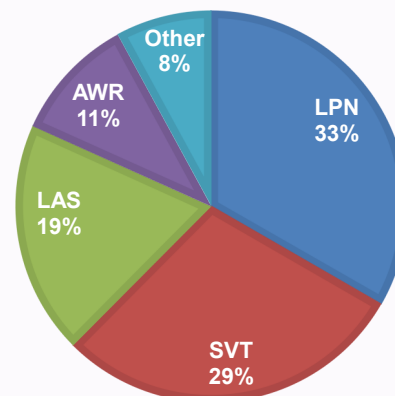
EMERGENCY TRANSIT FACILITIES (ETFs)
