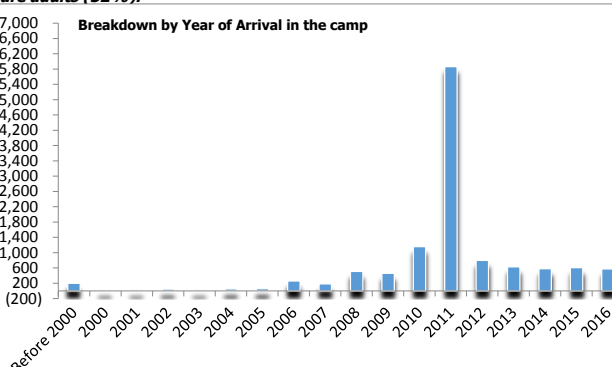

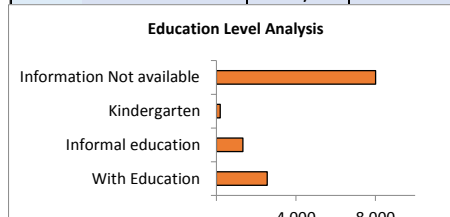

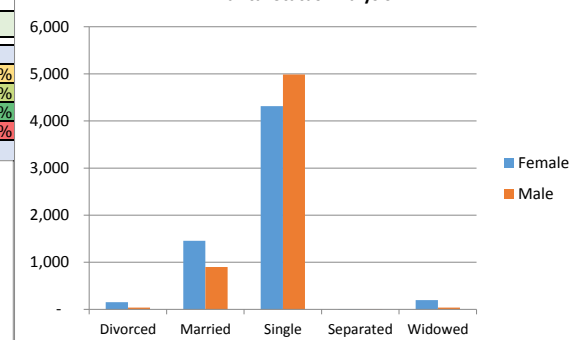

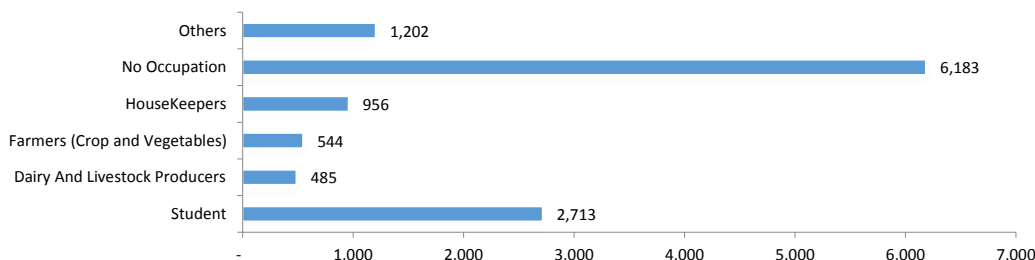


Marital Status Analysis



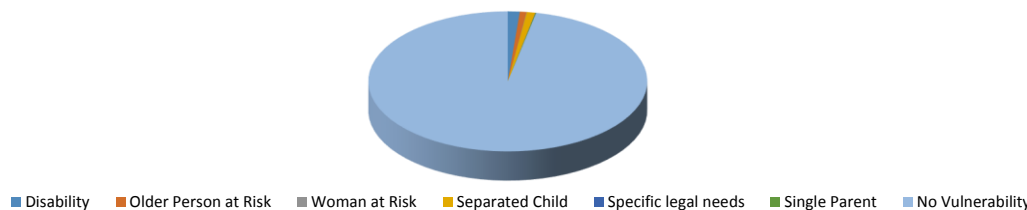

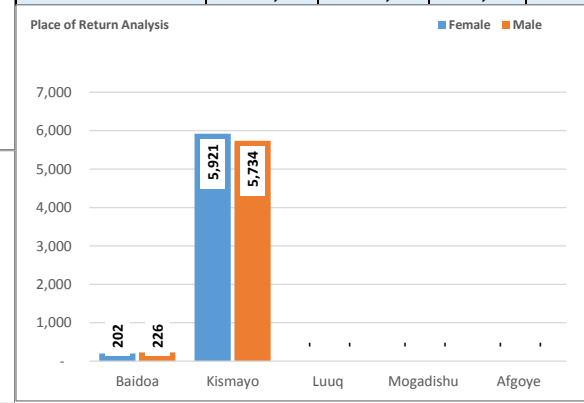

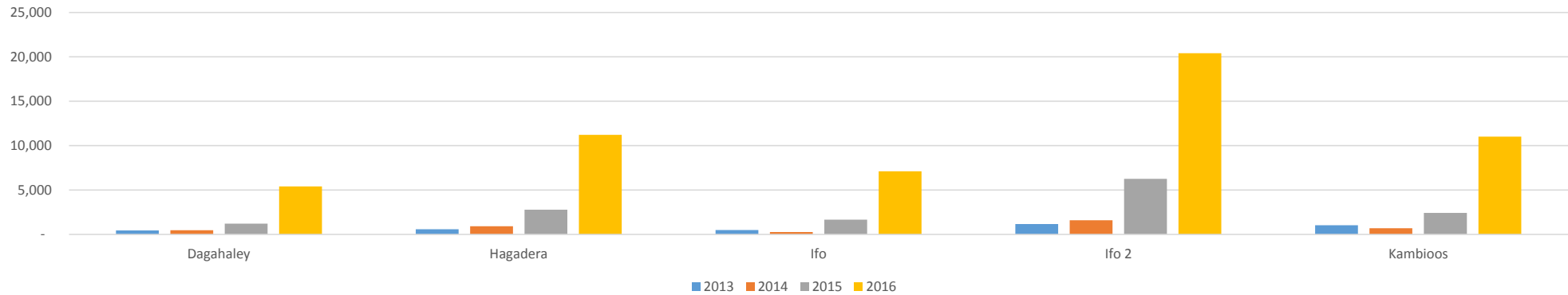

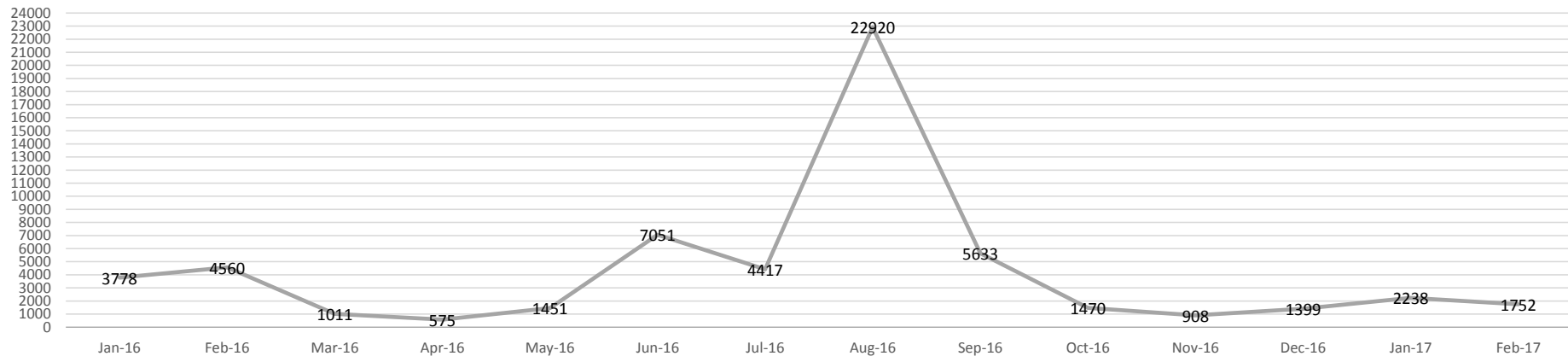

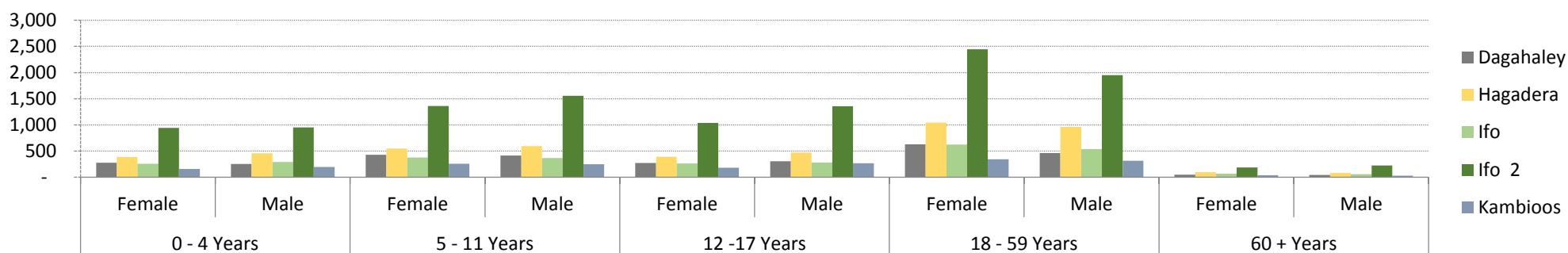


Trends of POCs Approaching the Return Help Desk between January 2016 and February 2017

From the launch of Return Help Desk in all Dadaab's camps at the end of November 2013; 81,175 PoCs were interviewed and 80,622 among them have expressed their intention to repatriate to Somalia. 51,397 Individuals have been repatriated to Somalia as of 24th February 2017. 3,903 have been inactivated in proGres database for No-show or spontaneous departure. While 25,322 refugees willing to return (in principle) remain active.
