

Establishment of Format and Technical Description of Estonian Passport and List of Data Entered in Passport

Regulation No. 431 of the Government of the Republic of 19 December 2001

(RT¹ I 2002, 2, 4),

entered into force 1 February 2002,

amended by the following Regulations:

01.10.2002 entered into force 22.10.2002 - RT I 2002, 82, 487;

26.07.2002 entered into force 01.08.2002 - RT I 2002, 67, 406.

This Regulation is established on the basis of subsection 9 (1) of the Identity Documents Act (RT I 1999, 25, 365; 2000, 25, 148; 26, 150; 40, 254; 86, 550; 2001, 16, 68; 31, 173; 56, 338; 2002, 61, 375; 63, 387).

Chapter 1

Format and Technical Description of Estonian Passport

§ 1. Format and measurements of Estonian passport

(1) The Estonian passport (hereinafter the passport) has the measurements of 88×125 mm in compliance with the standard ICAO 9303-01.

(2) The corners of the covers and pages of the passport are rounded.

(3) The passport has 32 pages.

(4) The format of the passport shall comply with the Annex to this Regulation.

§ 2. Technical description of covers of passport

(1) The covers of the passport are blue. The image of the grand national coat of arms of the Republic of Estonia together with the words EESTI ESTONIA PASS PASSPORT in gold appear on the front cover.

(2) The insides of the front and back cover are printed in a combination of light blue, dark blue, white and grey.

(3) The outline of images of barn swallows appear on the insides of the covers.

(4) The words EESTI ESTONIA in blue relief print appear at the top of the inside of the front cover in the centre.

(5) An ornamental strip in blue and green is printed at the bottom of the insides of the covers.

(6) On the inside of the front cover, the image of a cornflower appears to the right of the ornamental strip, and on the inside of the back cover, it appears to the left of the ornamental strip.

(7) The image of the grand national coat of arms of the Republic of Estonia in red, blue and gold is printed on the insides of the front and back cover, and the words EESTI VABARIIK in white, repeated in a wavy pattern, appear on the right-hand side of the insides of the covers.

§ 3. Technical description of pages of passport

(1) The pages of the passport are printed in a combination of light blue, dark blue, brown and green.

(2) The pages of the passport are numbered beginning from the fourth page. The number is white and appears twice in the outer margin.

(3) Beginning from the fifth page, the perforated number of the passport appears at the top of each page of the passport.

(4) On the pages with uneven numbers, except for the third page, the image of the grand national coat of arms of the Republic of Estonia in light blue is printed in the centre of the page, and the image of a cornflower in light blue is printed on the left-hand side of the lower part of the page.

(5) Beginning from the fourth page, the image of the territory of the Republic of Estonia appears on adjacent pages.

(6) The text on the pages of the passport is horizontal, except for the third and sixth page and the laminated film where the text is vertical.

(7) The words EESTI VABARIIK REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA PASS PASSPORT in dark blue appear on the first page of the passport.

(8) The image of the grand national coat of arms of the Republic of Estonia in light blue is printed in the centre of the second page of the passport, and the following text in dark blue is printed on the page:

“Käesoleva passi kasutaja on Eesti Vabariigi kaitse all. Eesti Vabariigi Valitsus palub kõigil ametivõimudel tagada selle passi kasutajale vaba läbipääs ja vajadusel igakülgne seaduslik abi ja kaitse.

The holder of this passport is under the protection of the Republic of Estonia. The Government of the Republic of Estonia hereby requests all civil and military authorities to permit the holder of this passport to pass freely without let or hindrance and in case of need to give all lawful aid and protection.”

(9) The image of a cornflower in light blue appears in the top left-hand corner of the third page of the passport, and the words PASS PASSPORT EESTI VABARIIK / REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA in dark blue are printed vertically along the left-hand side of the page. The words *EESTI VABARIIK* in white, repeated in a wavy pattern, appear at the outer margin of the page.

(10) On the third page of the passport, the scanned and perforated images of the holder of the passport, and the following data fields with text are entered:

- 1) *Liik* / Type;
- 2) *Väljaandja riik* / Issuing State;
- 3) *Dokumendi Nr* / Document No;
- 4) *Perekonnanimi* / Surname;
- 5) *Eesnimed* / Given names;
- 6) *Kodakondsus* / Citizenship;
- 7) *Sünniaeg* / Date of birth;
- 8) *Isikukood* / Personal code;
- 9) *Sünnikoht* / Place of birth;
- 10) *Sugu* / Sex;
- 11) *Kasutaja allkiri* / Holder's signature;
- 12) *Välja antud* / Date of issue;
- 13) *Kehtiv kuni* / Date of expiry;
- 14) *Väljaandja* / Issuing authority.

(11) The third page of the passport is covered with laminated film on which the image of the lion of the national coat of arms of Estonia whose colour varies from green to gold in optically variable ink, the words EESTI VABARIIK REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA repeated in a wavy pattern, and the image of the territory of the Republic of Estonia are printed.

(12) The number of the passport is printed at the bottom of the fifth page of the passport in the centre.

(13) The words MÄRKUSED / OBSERVATIONS in dark blue are printed on the left-hand side of the sixth page of the passport.

(14) The words VIISAD / VISAS in dark blue are printed at the top of the page in the centre, from the eighth up to the thirtieth page of the passport.

(15) On the thirty-second page of the passport, the following text is printed in dark blue:

“Passis on 32 lehekülge
This passport contains 32 pages
Käesolev pass on Eesti Vabariigi omand
This passport is the property of the Republic of Estonia”.

Chapter 2

Data Entered in Estonian Passport

§ 4. Data entered in passport

(1) The following data shall be entered on the third page of the passport:

- 1) P – the abbreviation of the type of the travel document;
- 2) EST – the code of the issuing state of the passport;
- 3) the surname of the holder of the passport;
- 4) the given names of the holder of the passport;
- 5) the sex of the holder of the passport;
- 6) the date of birth of the holder of the passport;
- 7) the place of birth of the holder of the passport;
- 8) the personal code of the holder of the passport;
- 9) the citizenship of the holder of the passport;
- 10) the photographic image of the holder of the passport;
- 11) the signature of the holder of the passport;
- 12) the number of the passport;
- 13) the date of issue of the passport;
- 14) the date of expiry of the passport;
- 15) KMA – the abbreviation of the name of the Citizenship and Migration Board.

(1¹) If the holder of a passport is a person under 15 years of age, a person with restricted active legal capacity or incapable of giving a signature, the stylised images of cornflowers shall be entered on the data field of the third page of the passport “Kasutaja allkiri / Holder’s signature”.

(2) On the machine-readable field on the right-hand side of the third page of the passport, the following data in compliance with the standards ICAO 9303-01 and ISO 7501-1 shall be entered in structured form:

- 1) the type of the document (name);
- 2) the code of the issuing state (EST);
- 3) the surname of the holder of the passport;
- 4) the given names of the holder of the passport;
- 5) the number of the passport;
- 6) the citizenship of the holder of the passport;
- 7) the date of birth of the holder of the passport;
- 8) the sex of the holder of the passport;
- 9) the date of expiry of the passport;
- 10) the personal code of the holder of the passport.

Chapter 3

Implementing Provisions

§ 5. Repeal of Regulation

Government of the Republic Regulation No. 344 of 12 November 1999 “Approval of Technical Description of Estonian Passport, List of Data Entered and Format of Passport” (RT I 1999, 88, 810) is repealed.

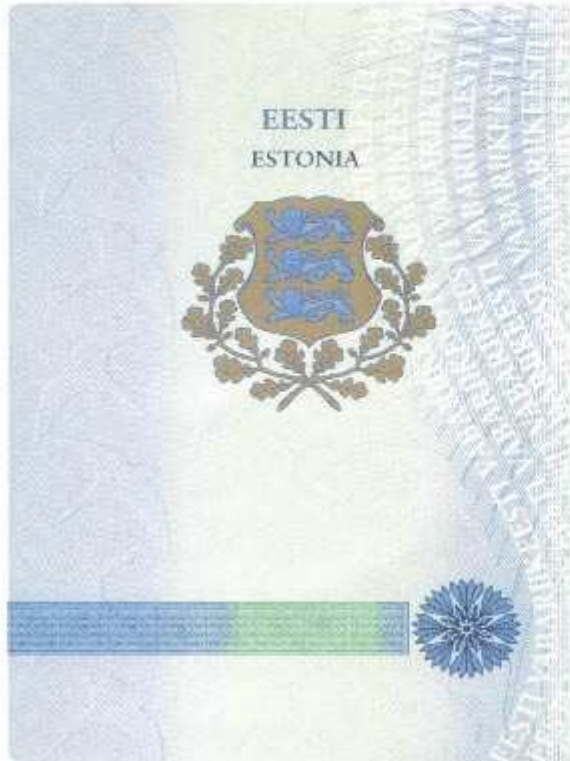
§ 6. Entry into force of Regulation

This Regulation enters into force on 1 February 2002.

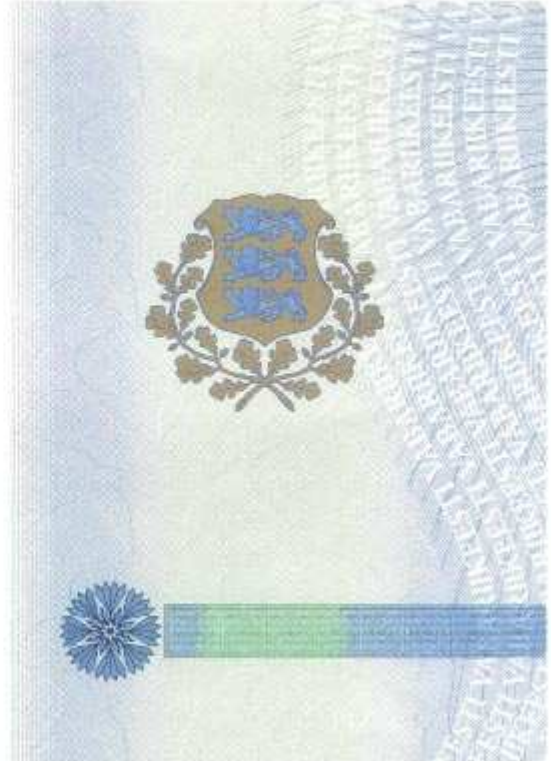

Esikaane sisekülg

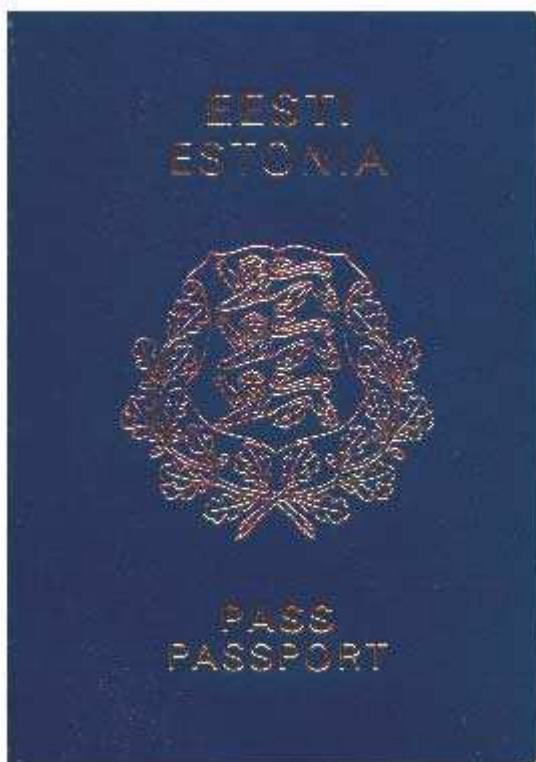


Tagakaane sisekülg

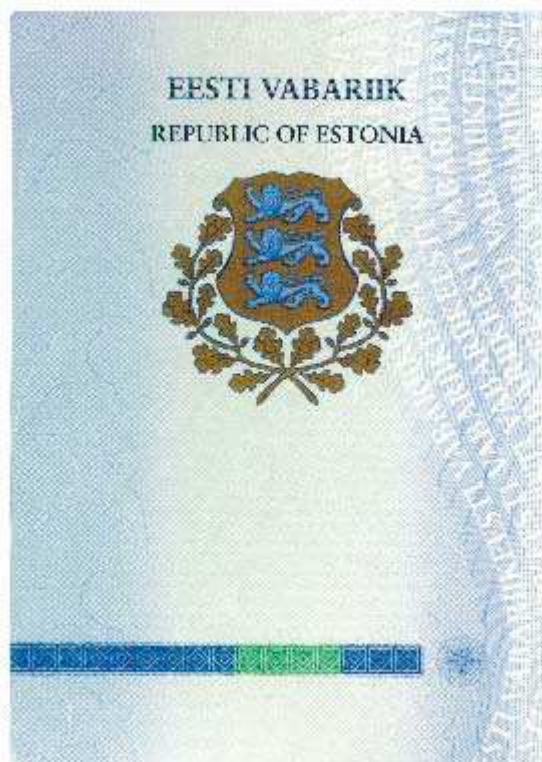

Esikaane väliskülg



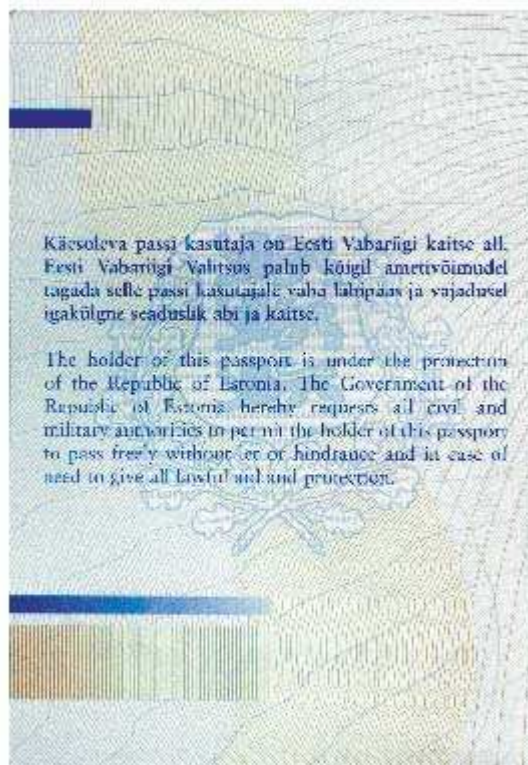
