

# Extradition (Papua New Guinea) Regulations 2010<sup>1</sup>

Select Legislative Instrument 2010 No. 158

I, QUENTIN BRYCE, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, make the following Regulations under the *Extradition Act 1988*.

#### 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Extradition (Papua New Guinea) Regulations 2010.* 

### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

## 3 Definition

In these Regulations: *Act* means the *Extradition Act 1988*.

#### 4 Extradition country

For the definition of *extradition country* in section 5 of the Act, Papua New Guinea is declared to be an extradition country.

#### 5 Offences that are not political offences

An offence mentioned in paragraph (d) of the definition of *political offence* in section 5 of the Act is not a political offence in relation to Papua New Guinea.

# 6 Modification of Act — application to Papua New Guinea

For section 11 of the Act, the Act applies in relation to Papua New Guinea as if a reference to 45 days in paragraph 17 (2) (a) of the Act were a reference to 60 days.
