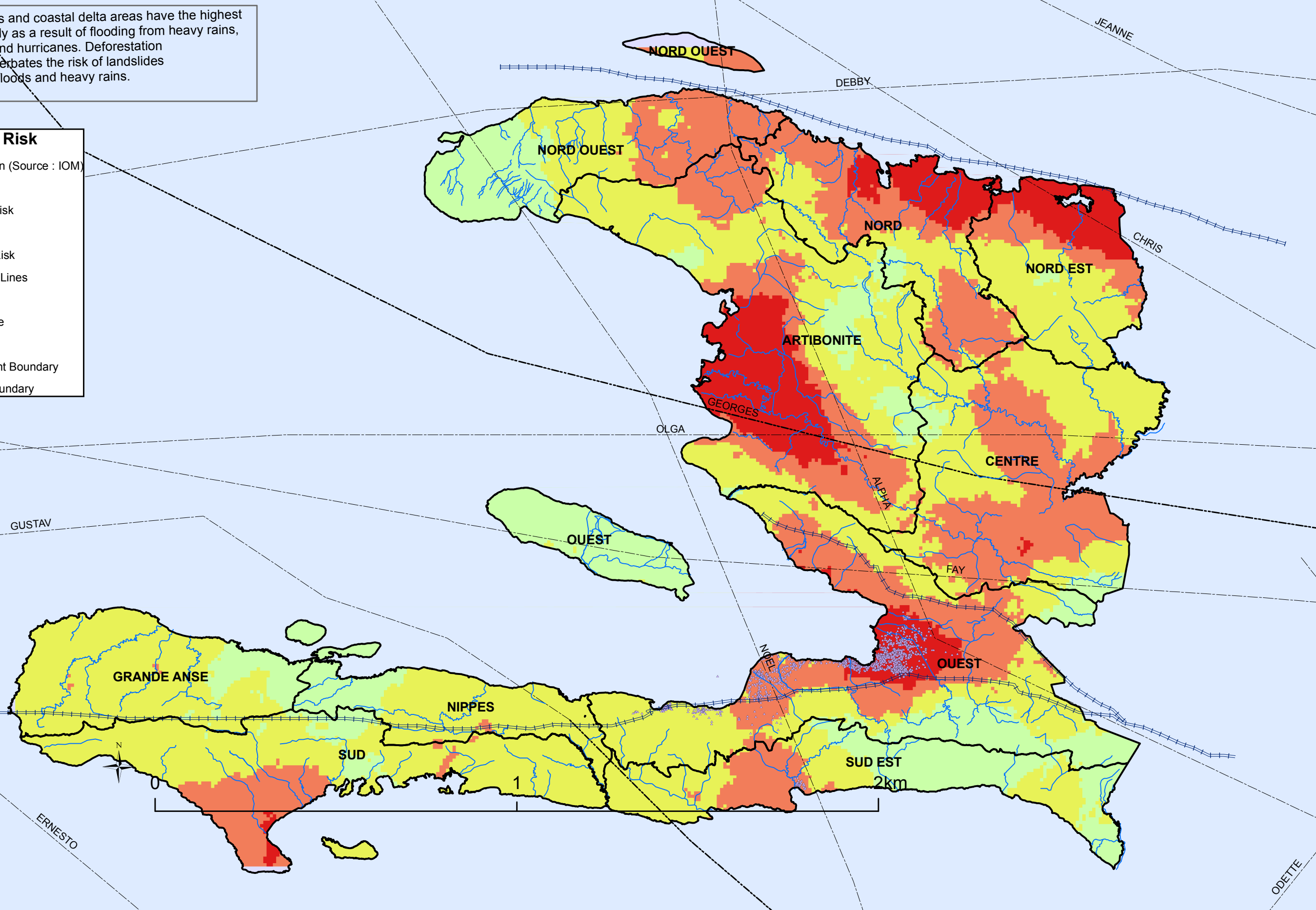


Haiti's river basins and coastal delta areas have the highest hazard risk, mostly as a result of flooding from heavy rains, tropical storms, and hurricanes. Deforestation and erosion exacerbates the risk of landslides associated with floods and heavy rains.
