

Iraq: Child Protection Sub-Cluster HRP 2016 Achievements (January - December 2016)

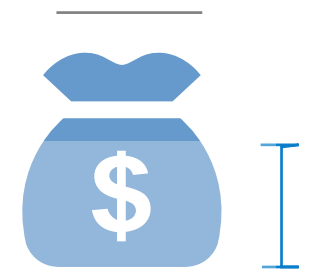
In 2016, the Iraq Child Protection Sub-Cluster reached 202,000 children with structured psychosocial support and specialized services implemented by 47 organizations in 62 Districts across 17 of the Governorates in Iraq. In addition, more than 180,000 children were reached through awareness and almost 19,000 participated in Community Based Child Protection Networks (CBCPNs). Out of the USD 25.7 million requested by Child Protection actors through the HRP, USD 19.1 million (74%) was received for implementation of activities in 2016.

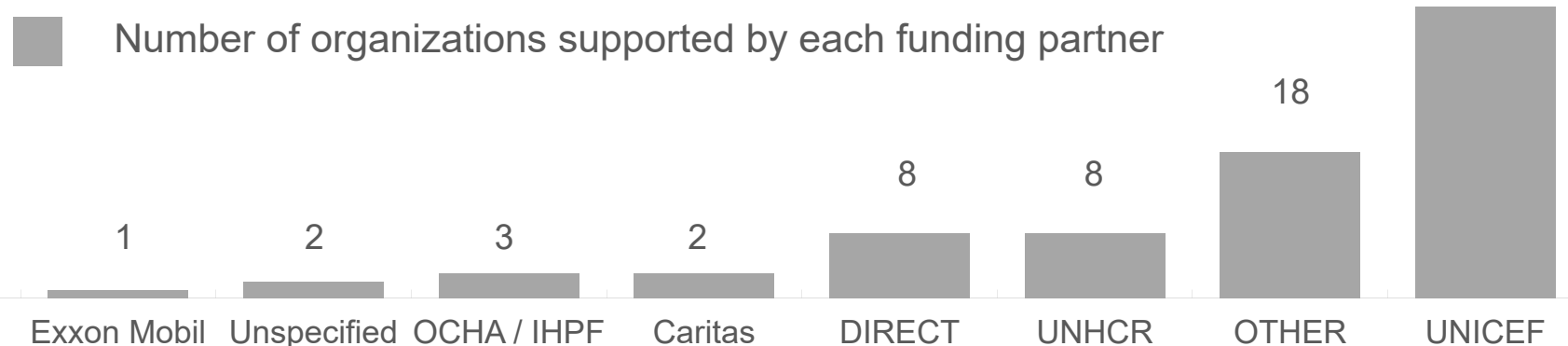
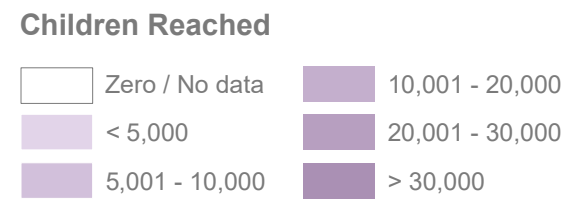

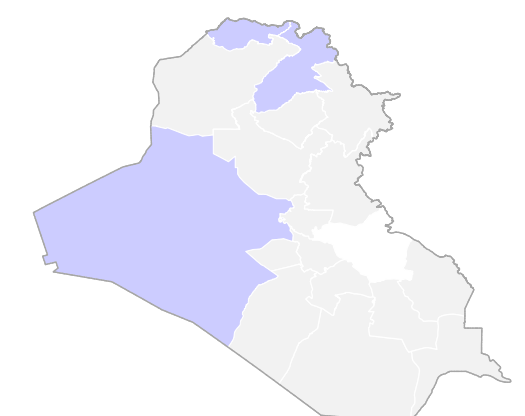
101% of girls and boys targeted for structured psychosocial support were reached

47 partners received funding through **7 key funding sources**, supporting provision of Child Protection services in **62 districts** across 17 Governorates in Iraq

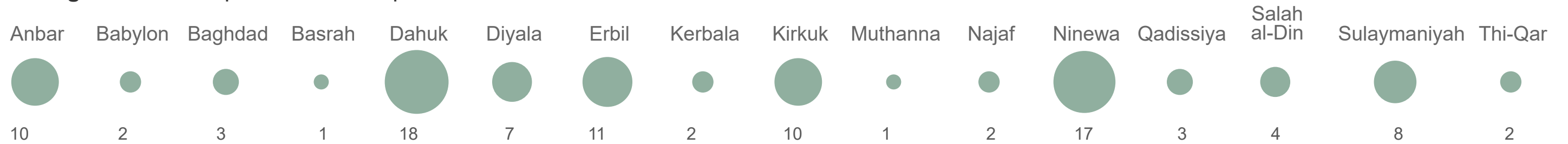


50% of children reached across Iraq were through activities implemented in Anbar, Dahuk, and Erbil Governorates

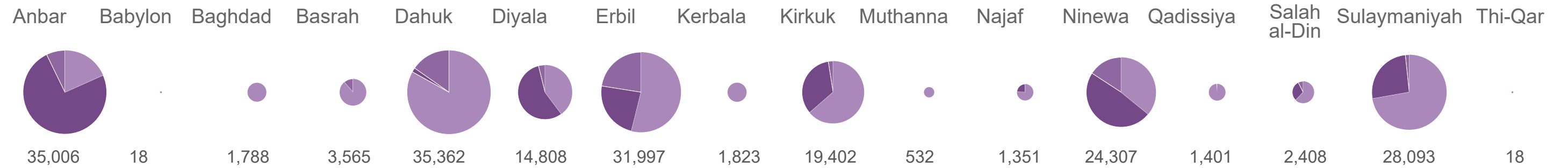
Iraq: Child Protection Sub-Cluster HRP 2016 Achievements (January - December 2016)



47 organizations implemented child protection activities across 17 Governorates in 2016

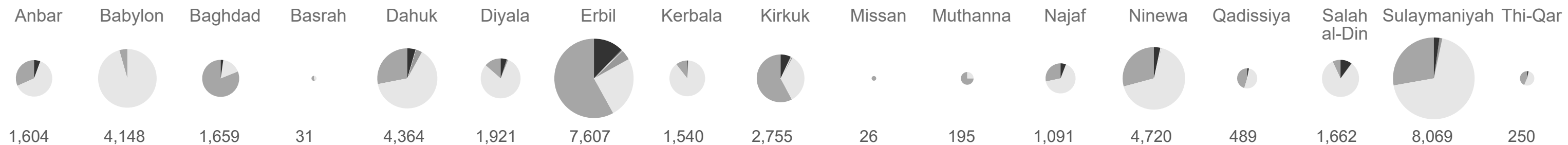


201,879 girls / boys reached through **structured psychosocial support programmes**



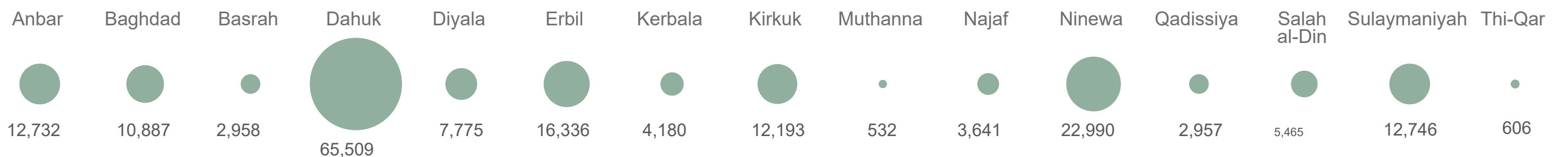
■ # of girls / boys receiving psychosocial support services in mobile CFS (69,244)
