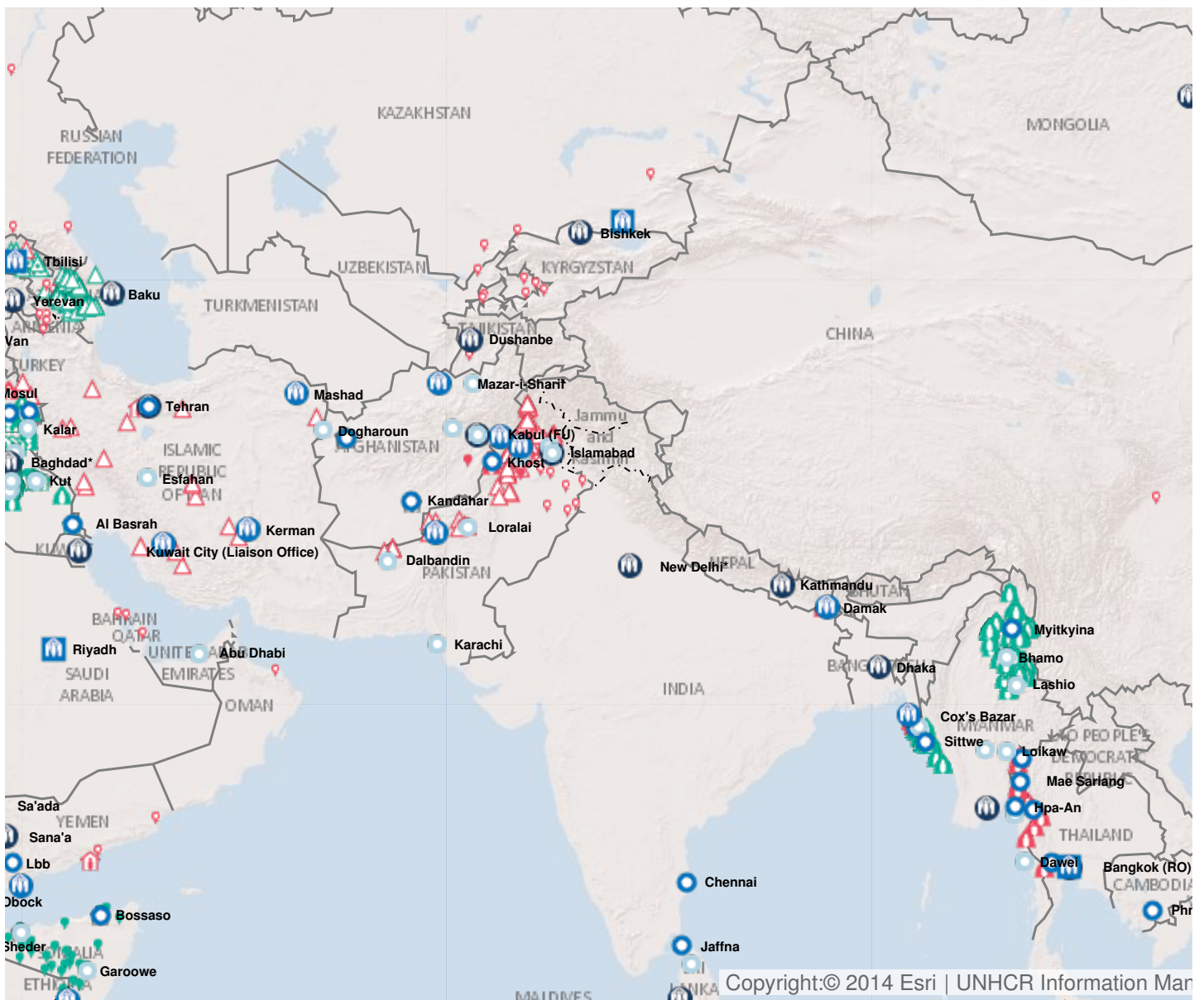


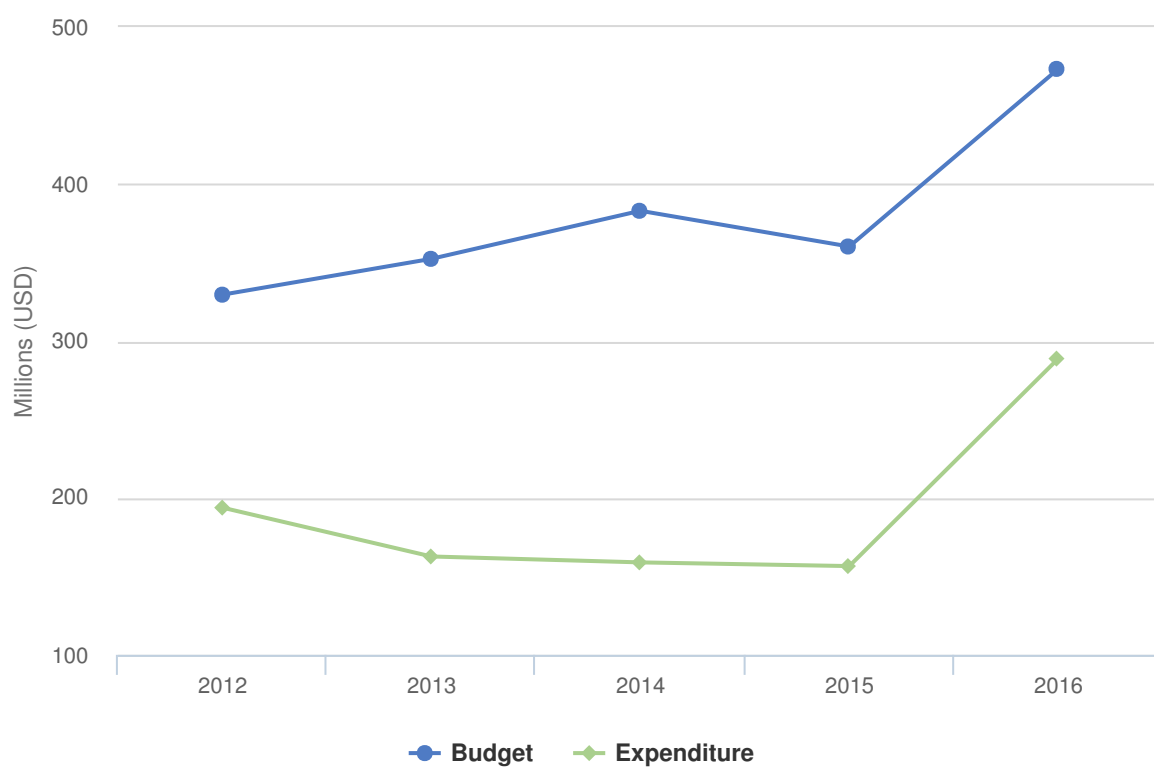

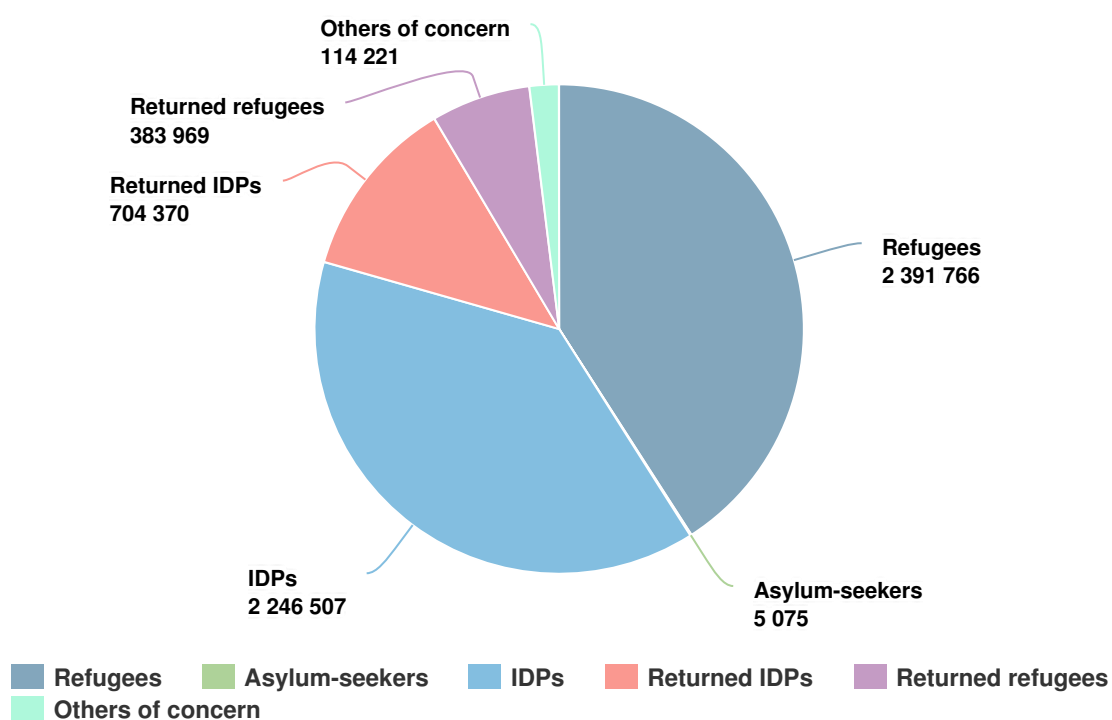

Response in 2016

Afghan refugees remained the largest protracted refugee population of concern to UNHCR in Asia. More than 2.6 million registered Afghan refugees are hosted in over 70 countries. The Islamic Republics of Iran and Pakistan host approximately 95 per cent of all Afghan refugees.

In 2016, UNHCR engaged with the Governments of the Islamic Republics of Afghanistan, Iran and Pakistan to implement the activities contained in the “UNHCR Regional Plan on building resilience and solutions for Afghan refugees in South-West Asia”. These activities are in line with the “Solutions strategy for Afghan refugees to support voluntary repatriation, sustainable reintegration and assistance to host countries” (SSAR) that remains the overall policy framework for the region, focusing on voluntary return, sustainable reintegration and support to hosting countries. The respective governments and UNHCR continued efforts to achieve solutions through tripartite and quadripartite meetings.

UNHCR’s efforts towards solutions were made also in the context of rejuvenated focus by the international community towards lasting peace, stability and development in Afghanistan. The Afghan government and European Union co-organized the Brussels Conference on Afghanistan in October 2016, with the participation of 75 countries and 26 international organizations. The international community pledged USD 15.2 billion for the next four years. Translating commitments into actions will be vital to ensure that the Government of Afghanistan has the support and resources required to assist its population, including uprooted people.

UNHCR operations in the subregion have been greatly affected by funding shortfalls and the Office will continue mobilize additional support from the international community in support of Afghan refugees.
