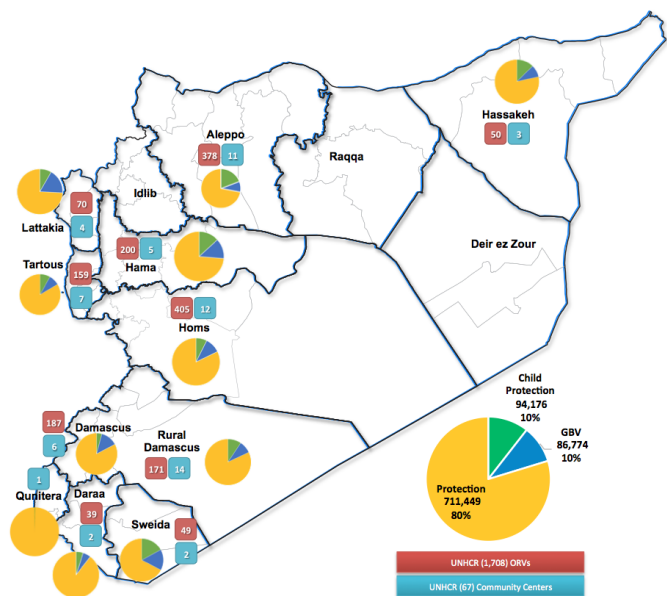
# WORKING WITH PARTNERS

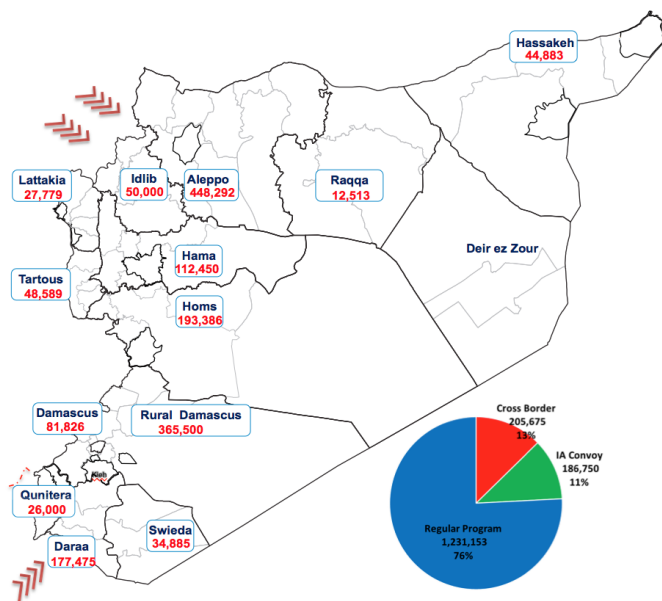

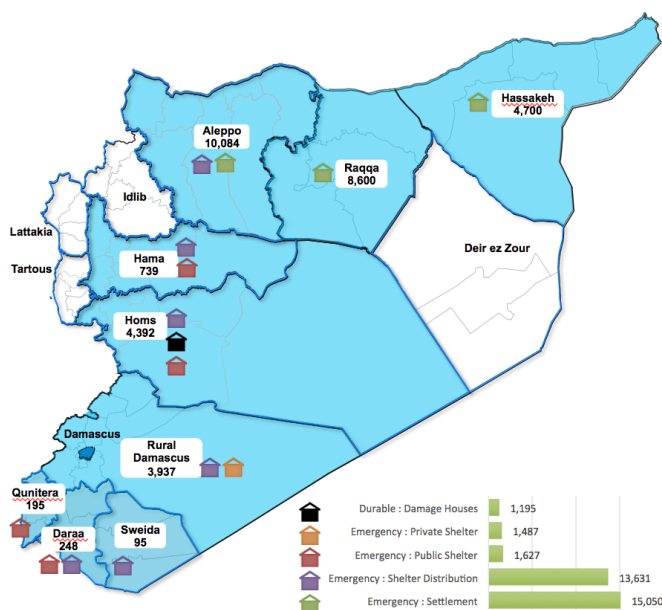

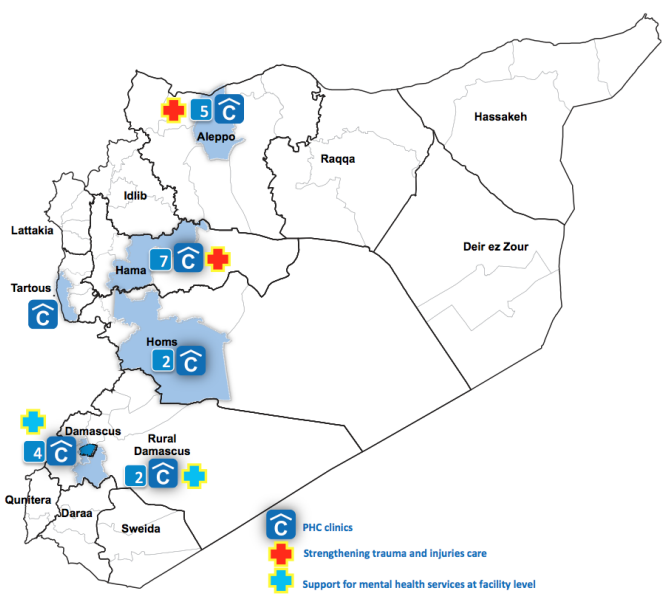
