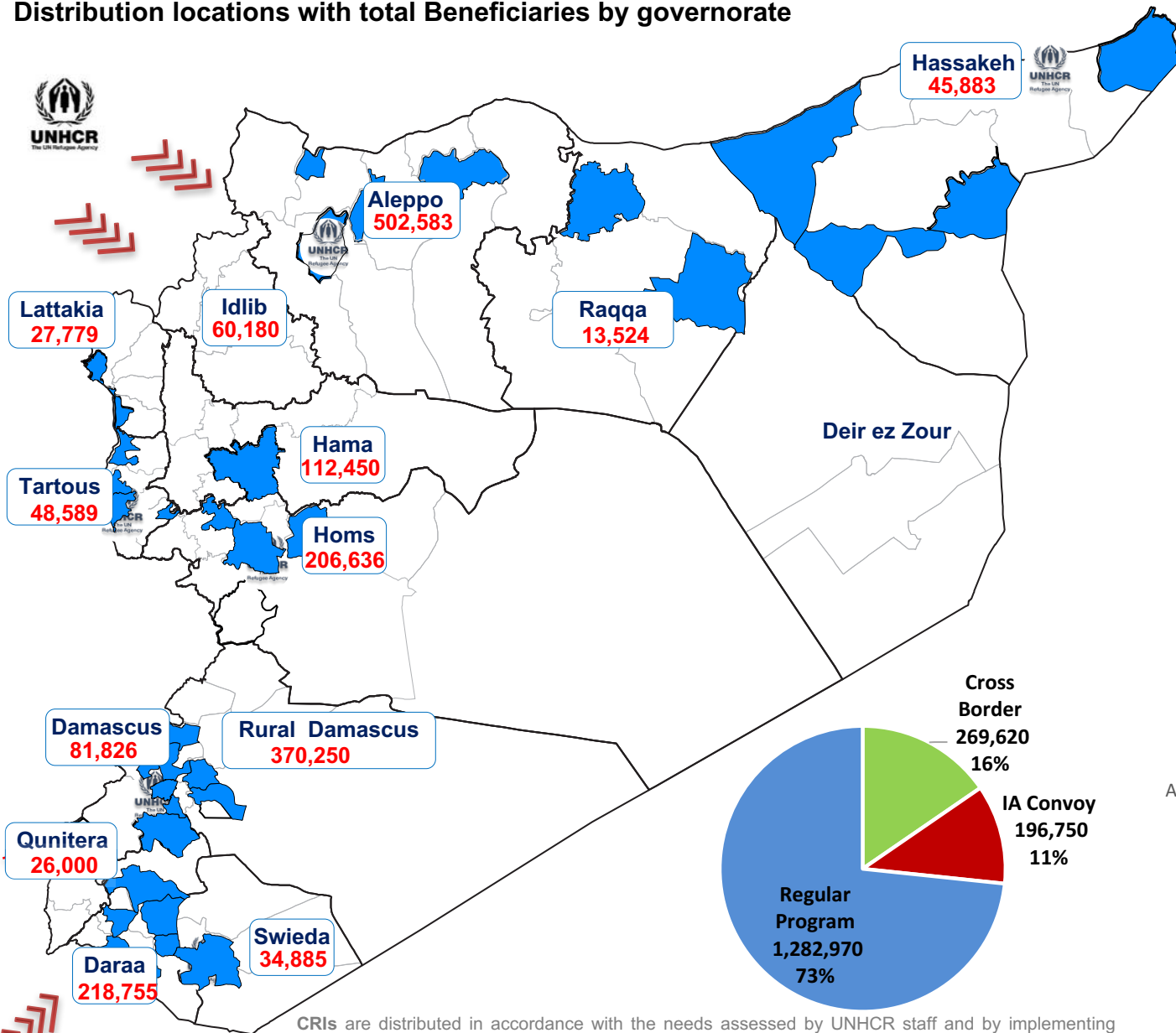

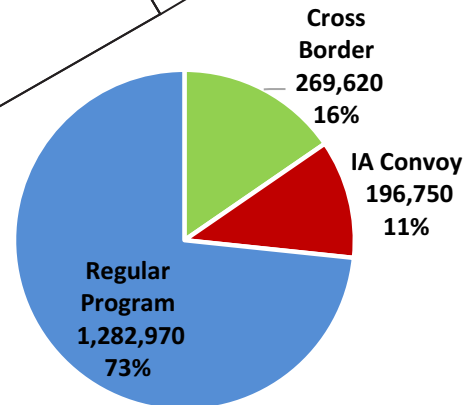
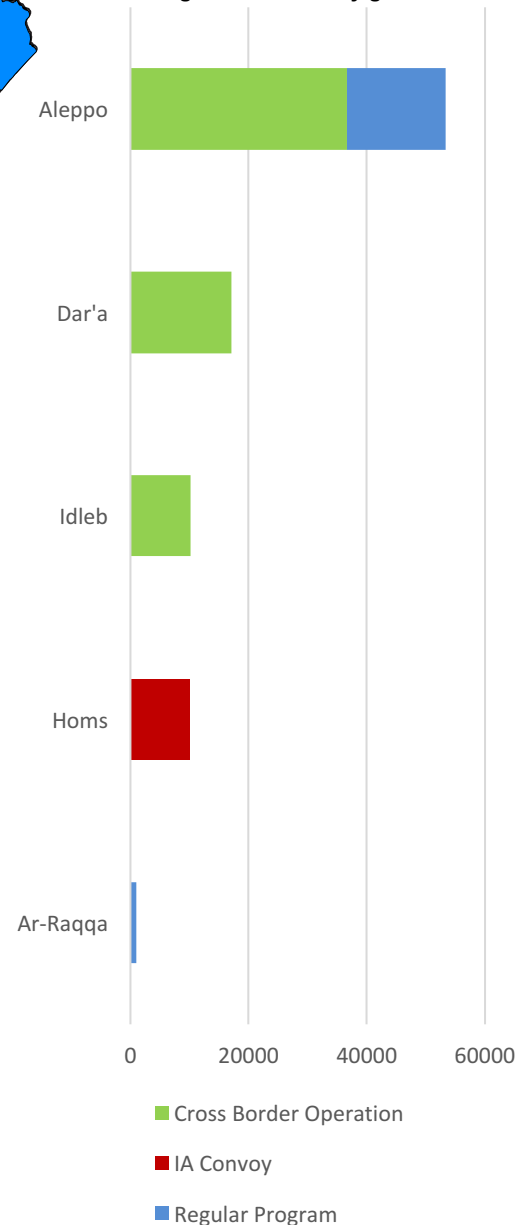

Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate

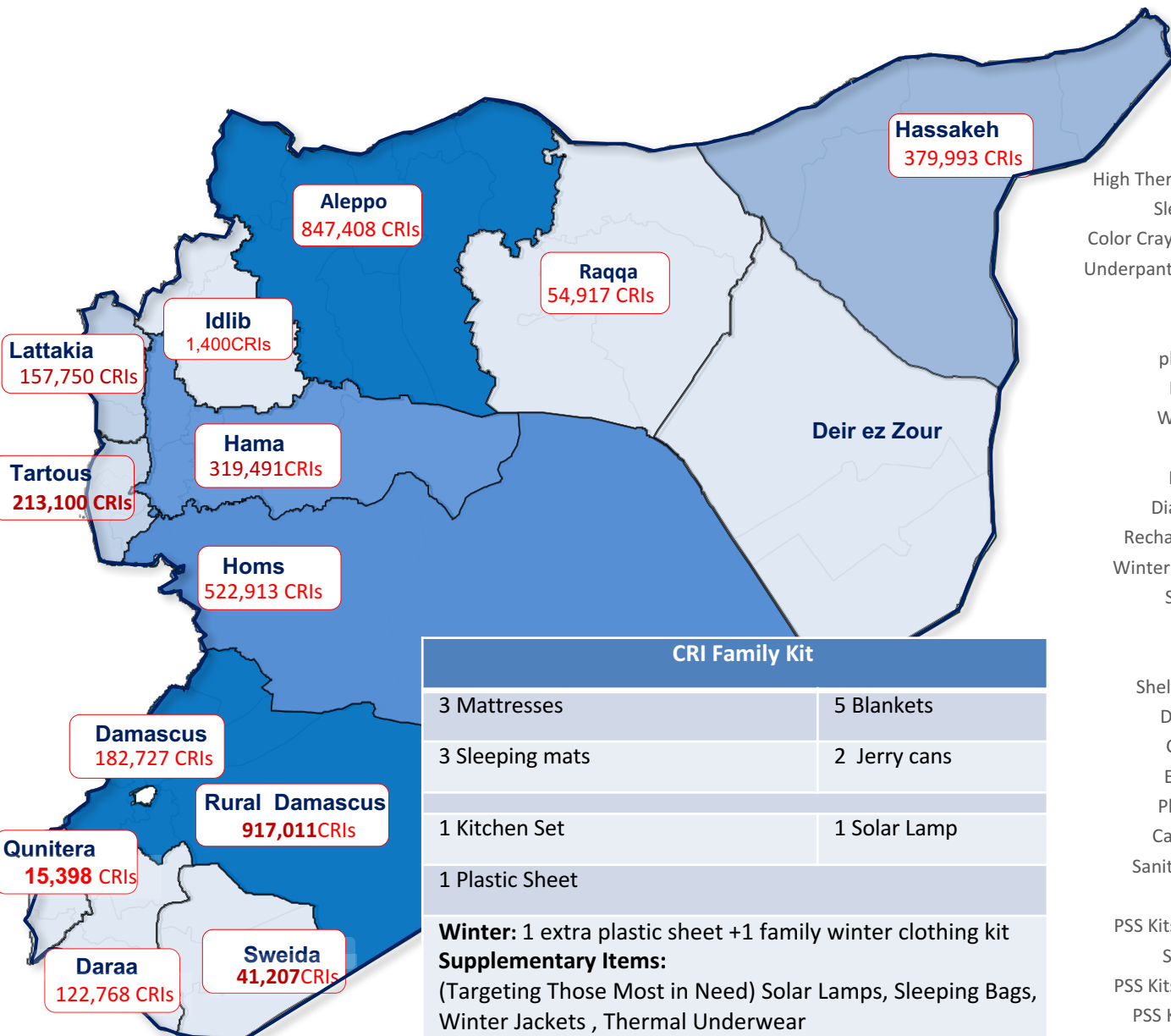


Aug Beneficiaries by governorate

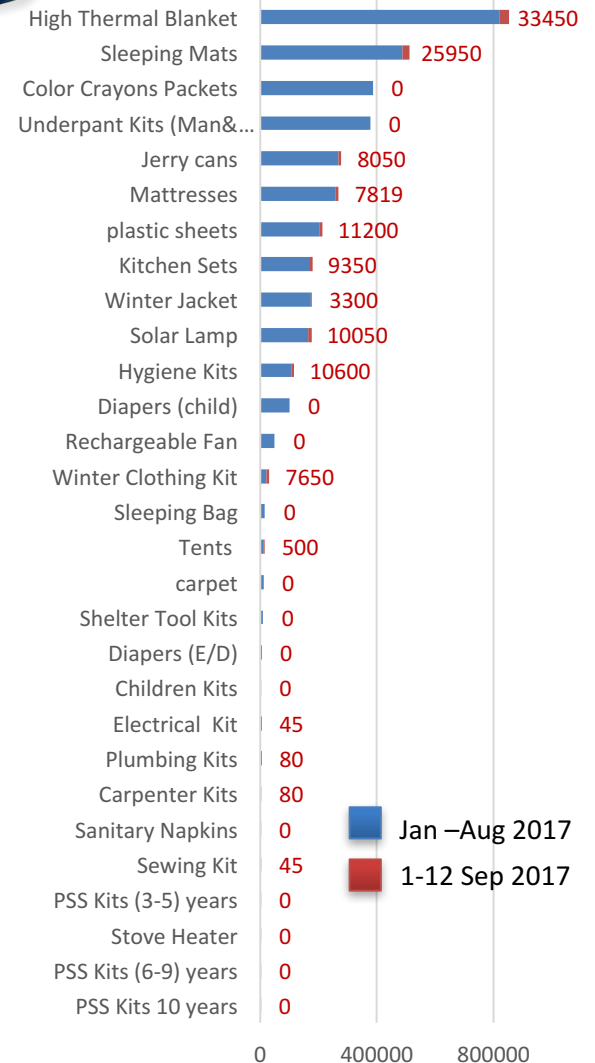

So far in 2017 UNHCR Dispatched 3,776,083 CRIs to 13 Governorates as of 12/09/2017



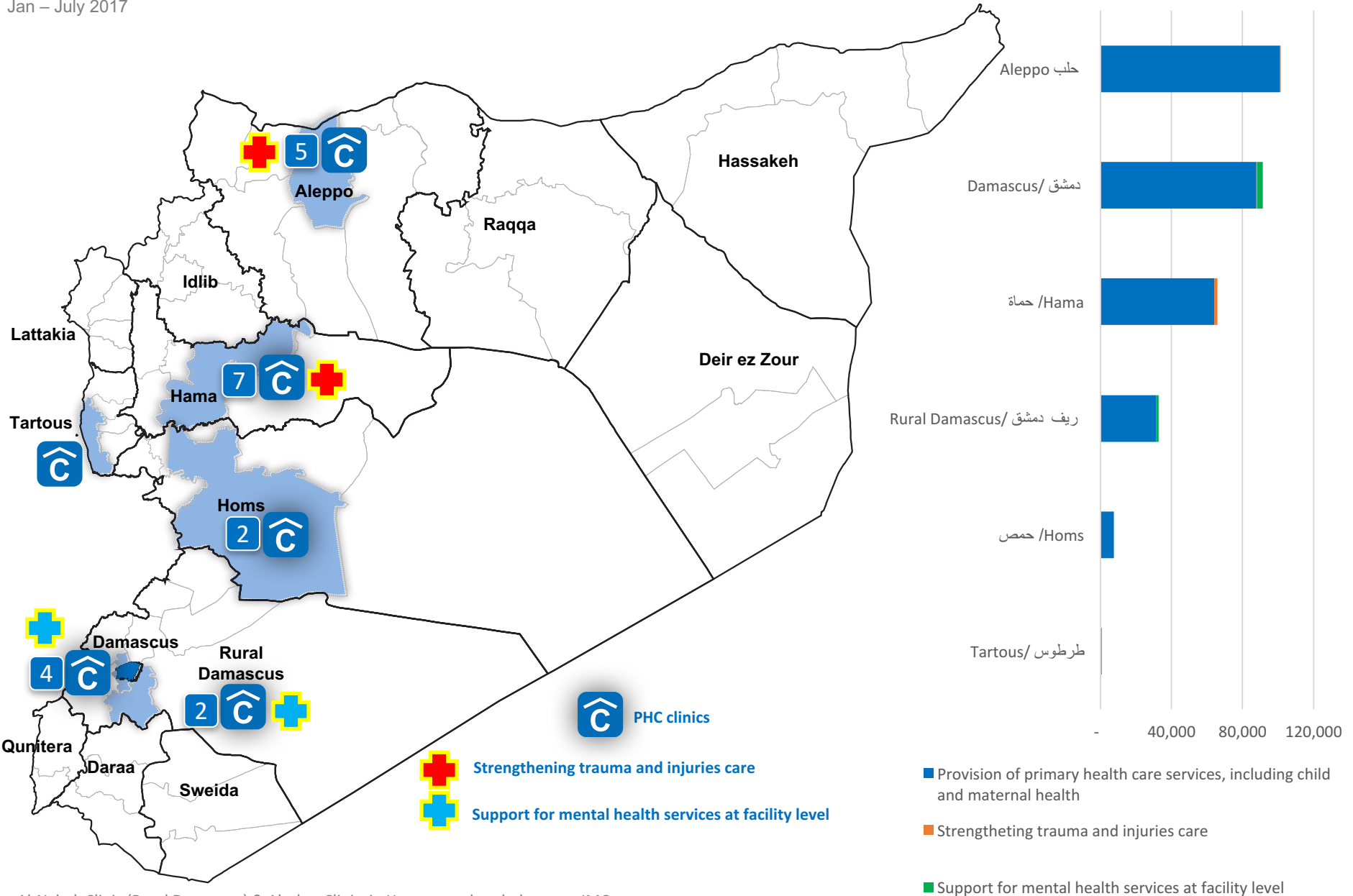
