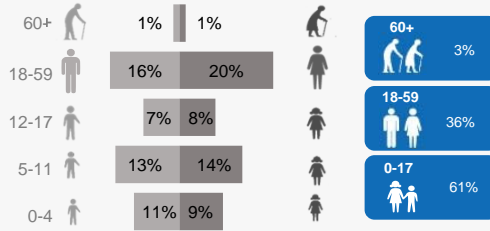

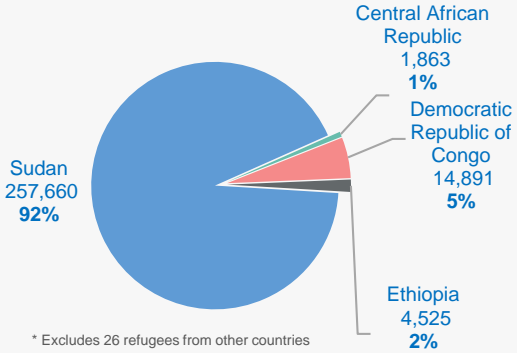

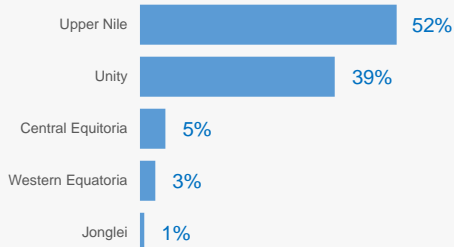


## Main countries of origin\*

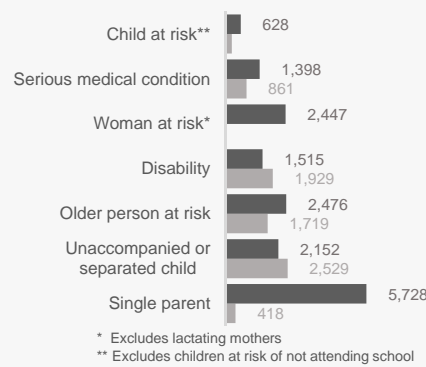

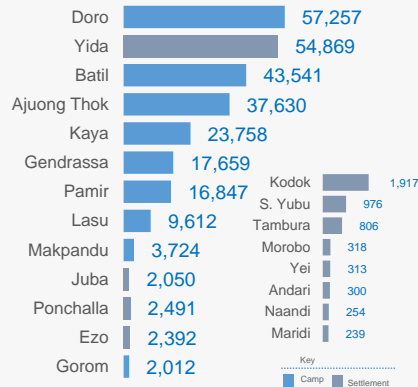

## Main Specific needs



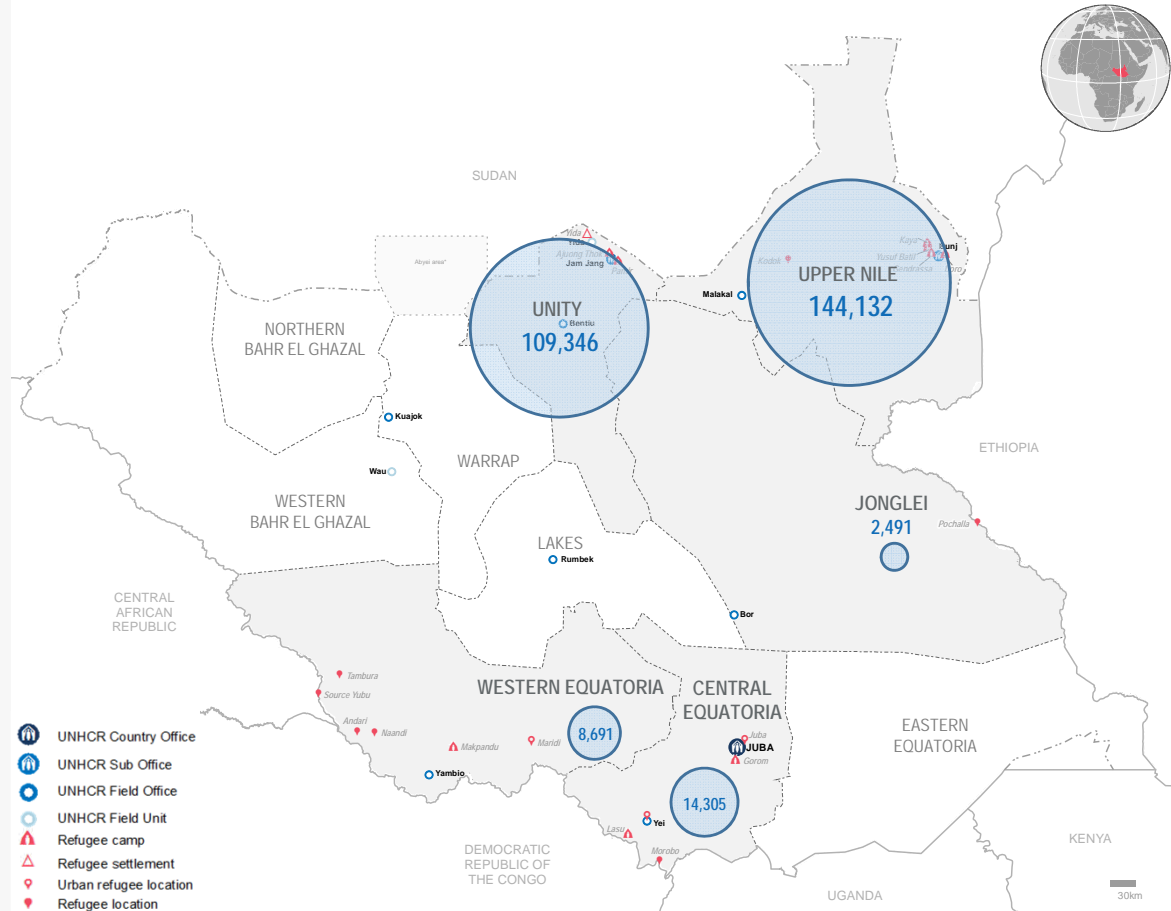
