Output-1.1: Communities are engaged in addressing vulnerabilities of boys, girls and caregivers - Children & Caregivers

Activity: Increasing capacity of children to negotiate risks and know where to go for help.

Indicator: # of girls and boys sensitized on CP/PSS

Activity: Increasing capacity and awareness of caregivers and community members to address child protection concerns

Indicator: # caregivers/community members sensitized on CP/PSS

Output-1.2: Child protection violations are addressed through increased response capacity of government and civil society actors - Children

Activity: Quality response services for children at high risk and who have experienced violence, exploitation, neglect and abuse

Indicator: # of girls and boys at high risk who receive focused PSS and life-skills programming

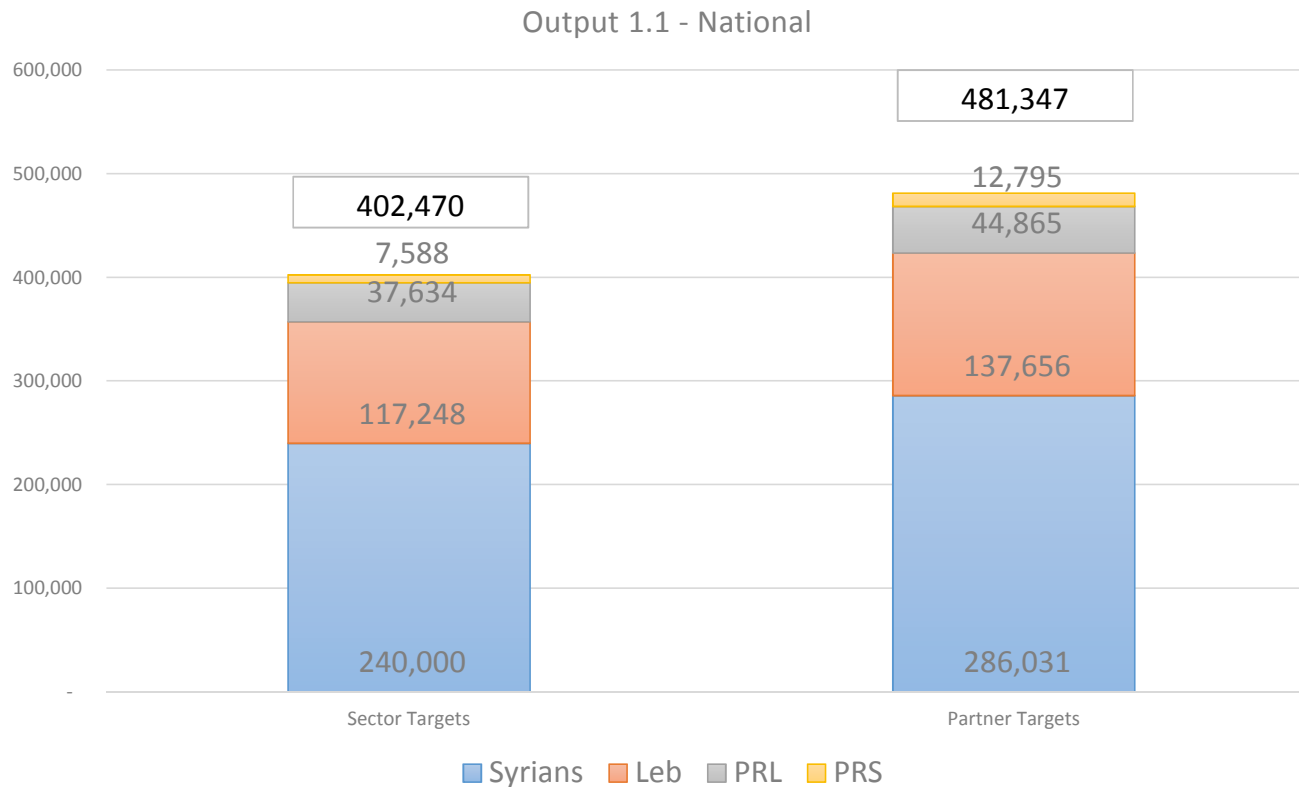

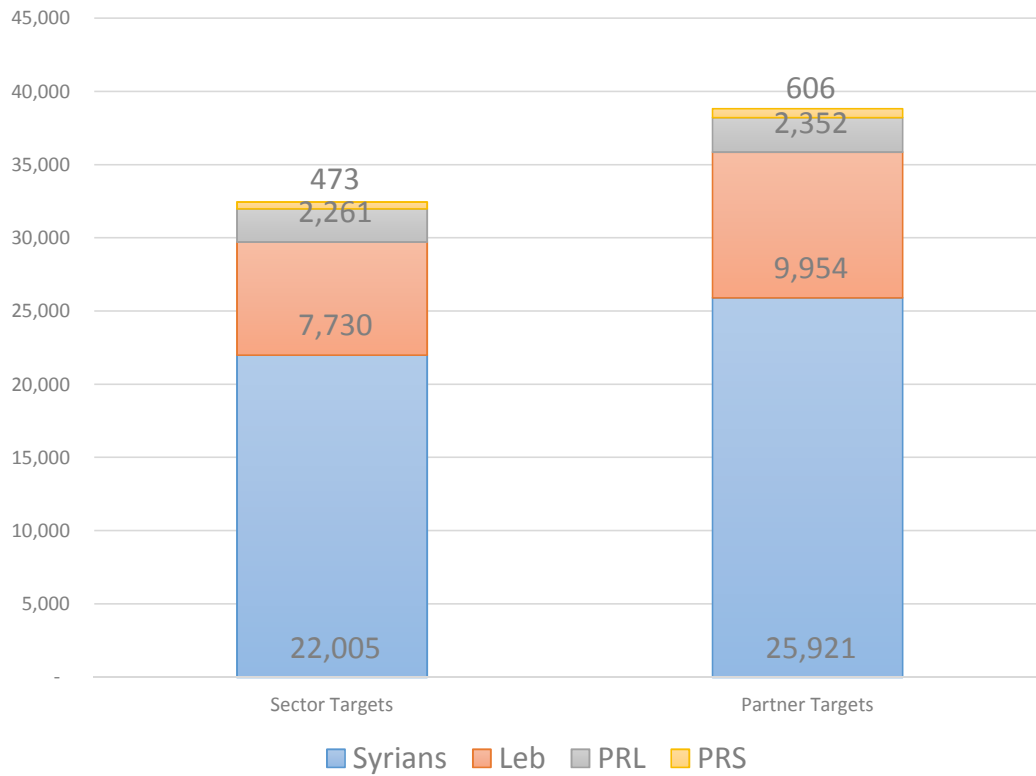

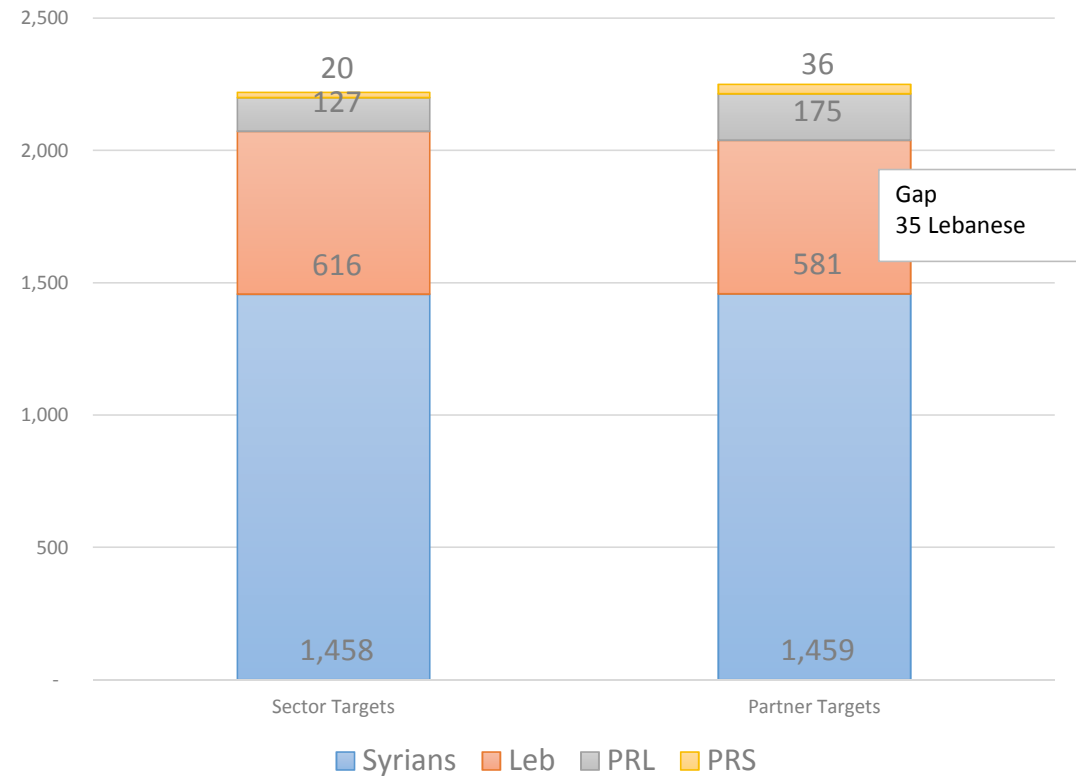

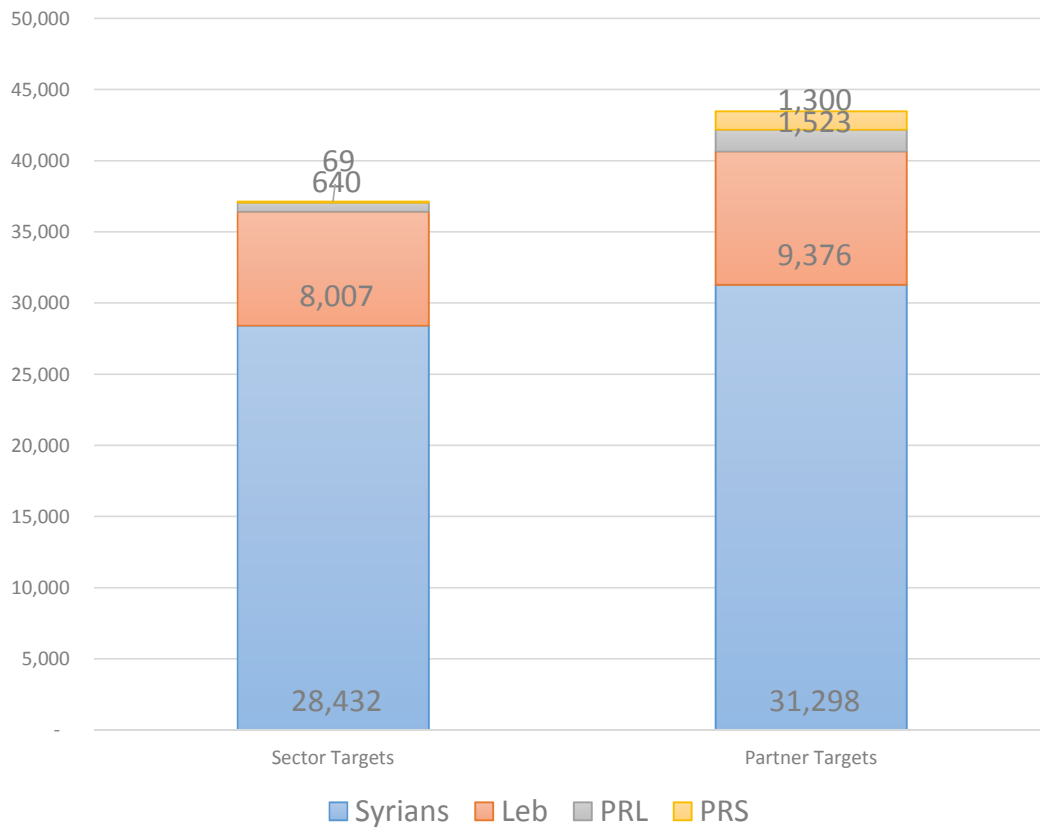

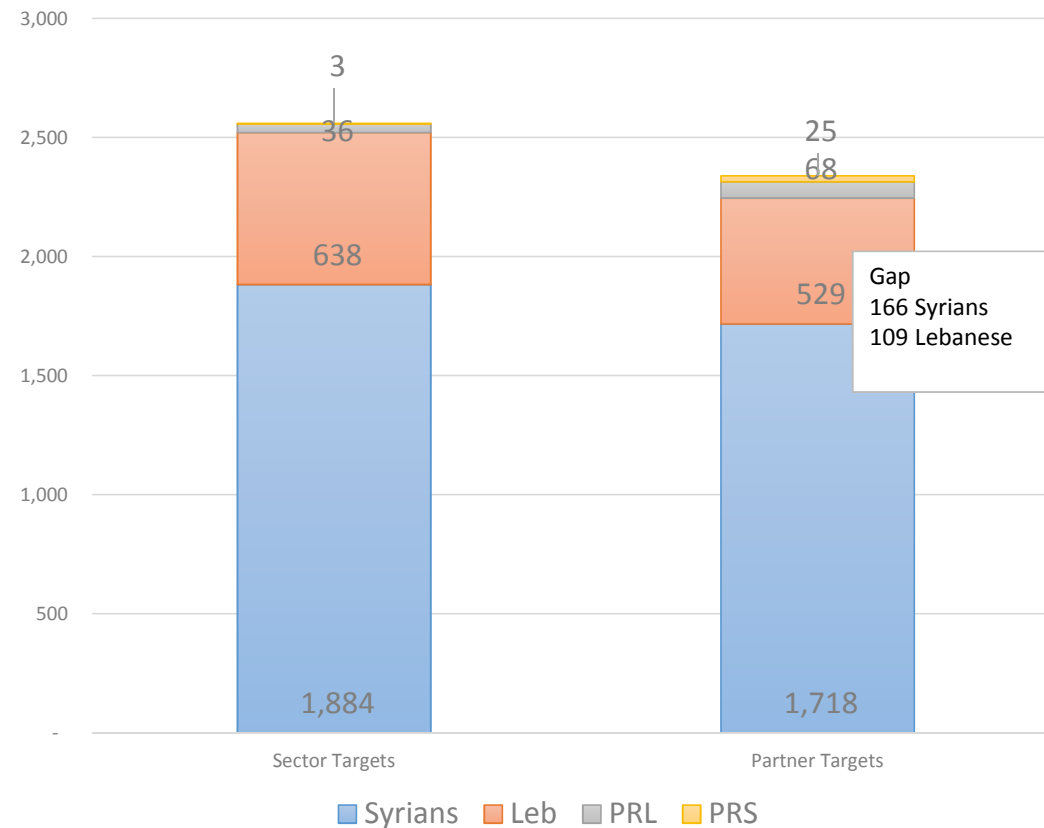
Comparison of Sector and Partner Targets in Field Working Group – Bekaa Group

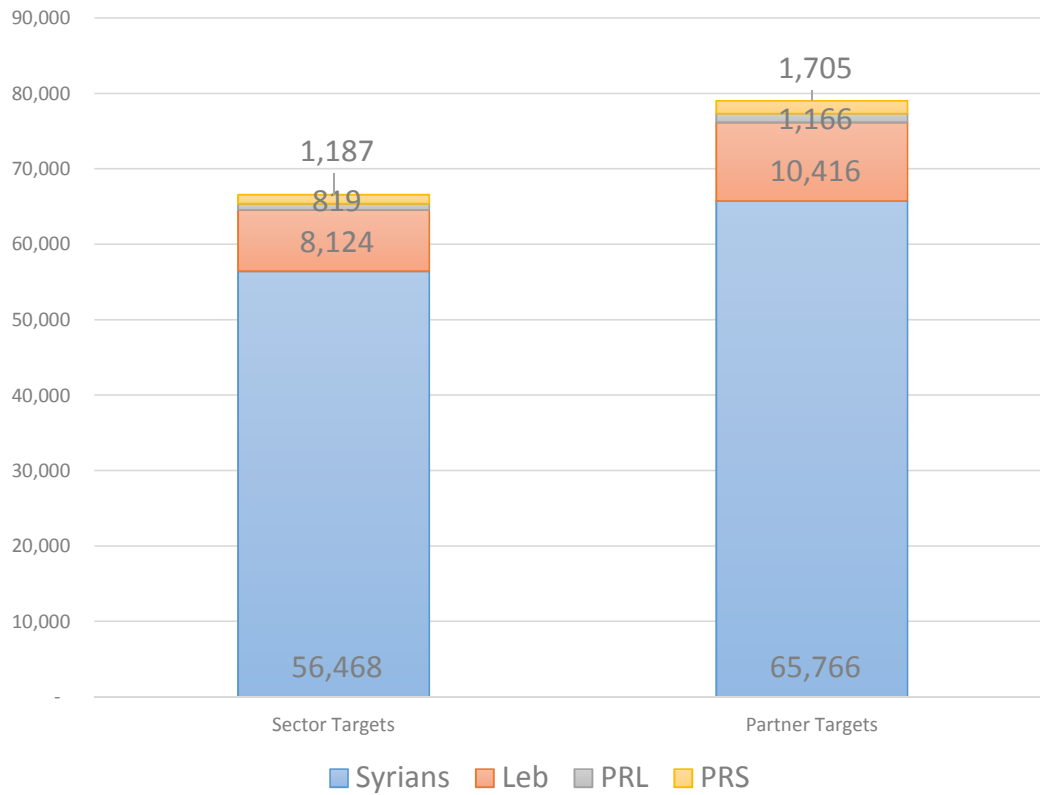

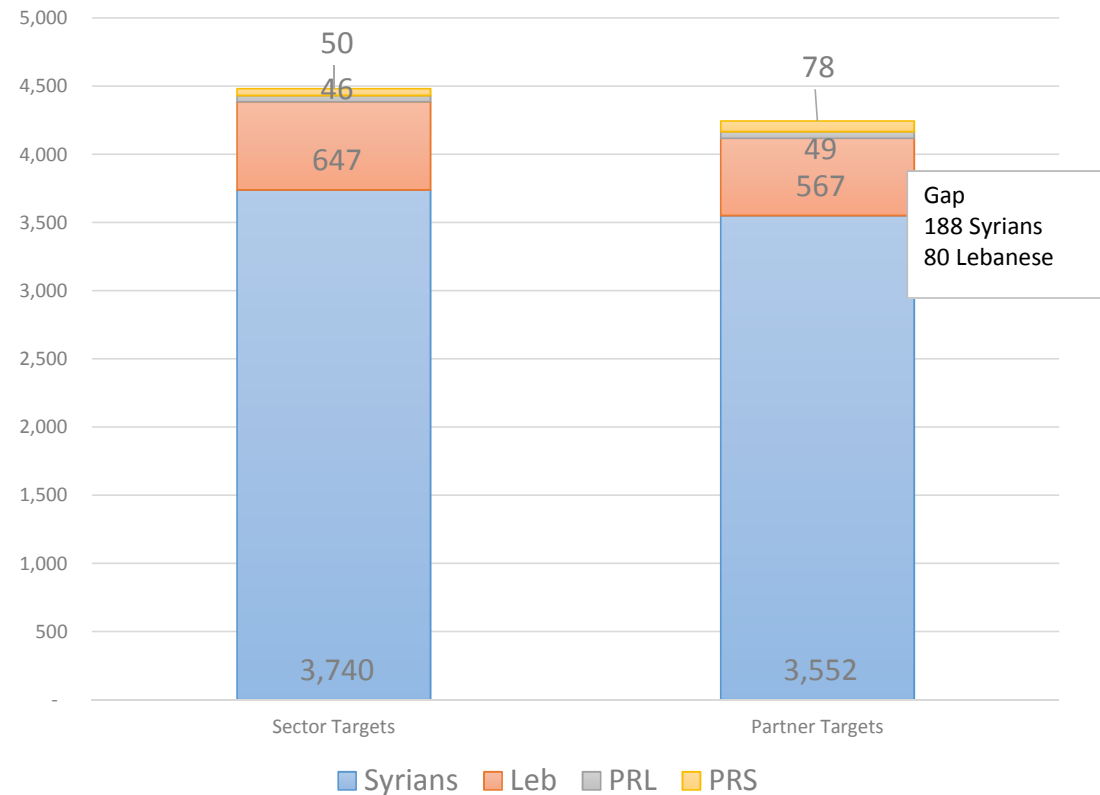

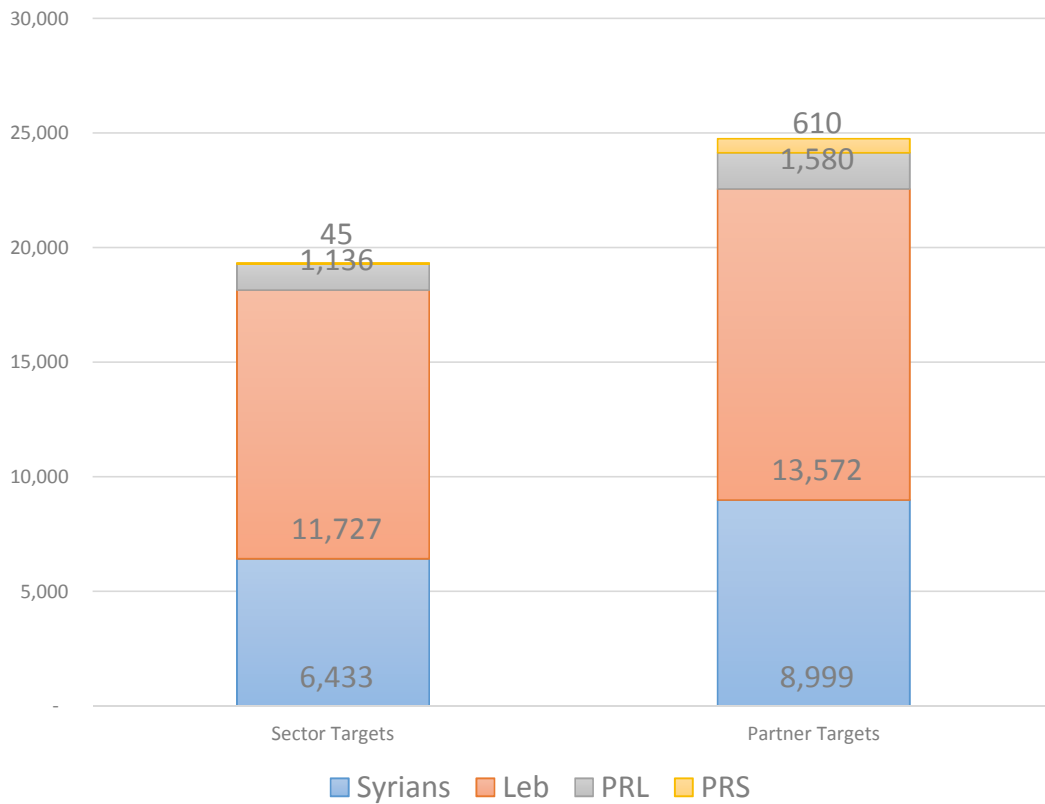

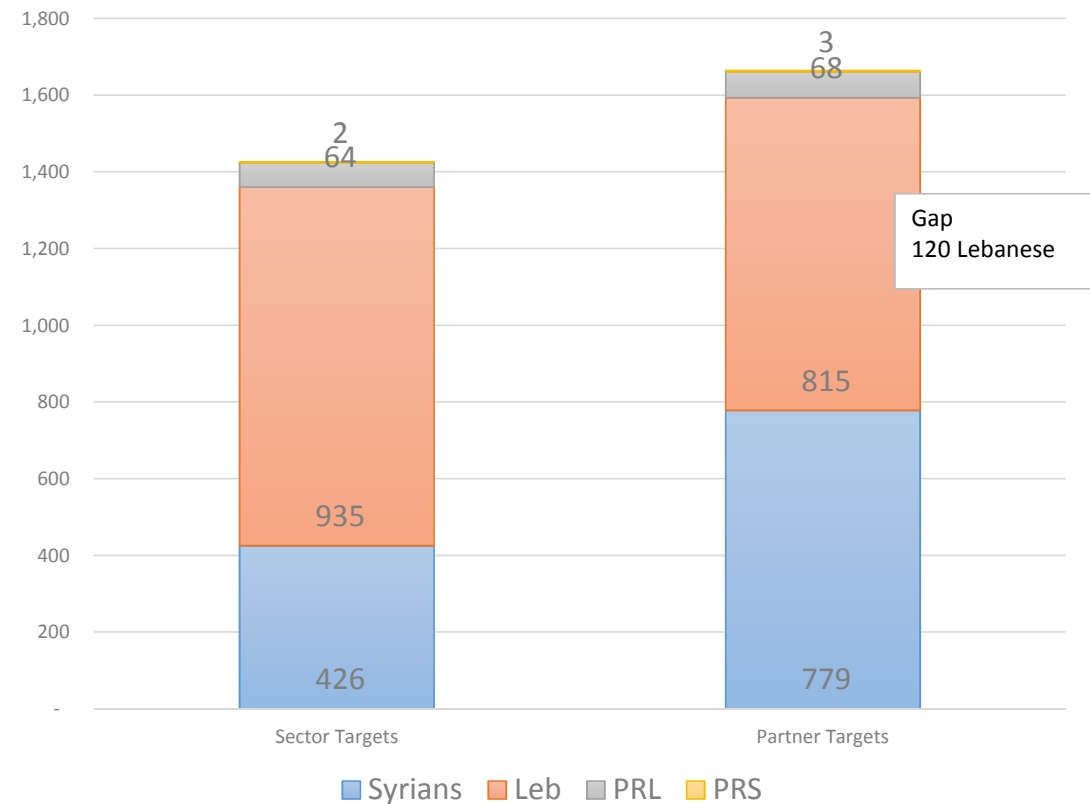
Comparison of Sector and Partner Targets in Field Working Group – Beirut Mt. Lebanon Group

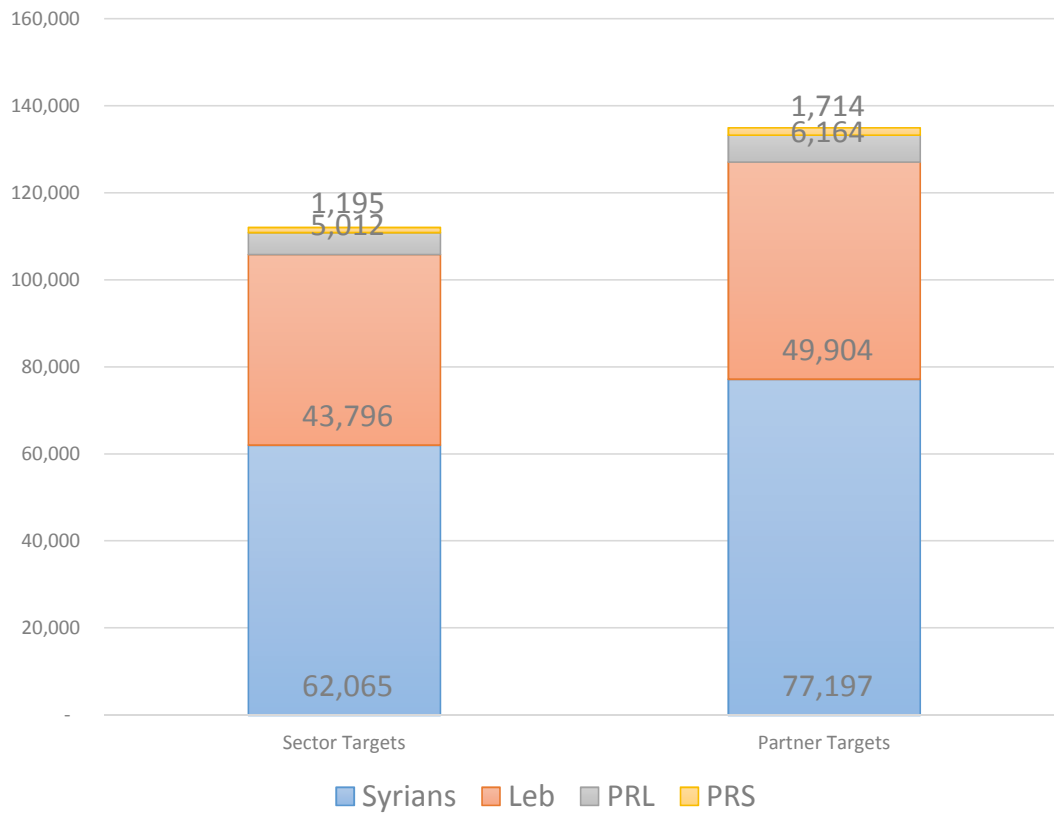

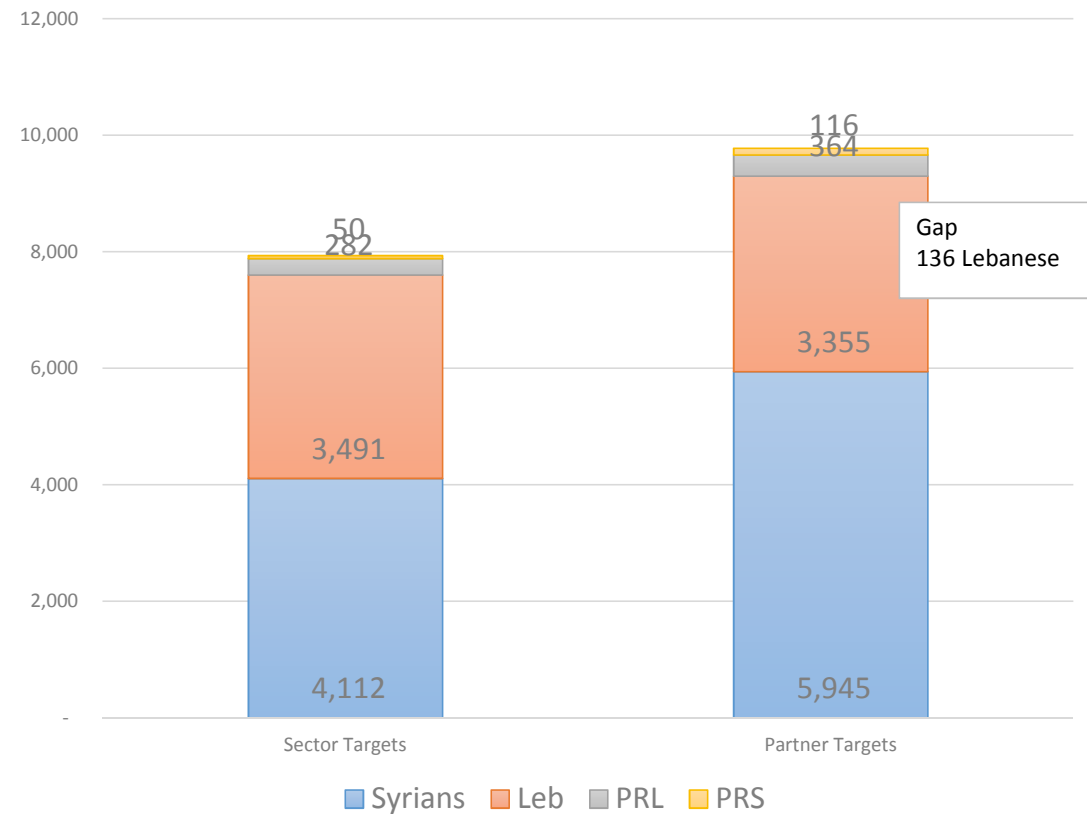
Comparison of Sector and Partner Targets in Field Working Group – Beirut Mt. Lebanon Group

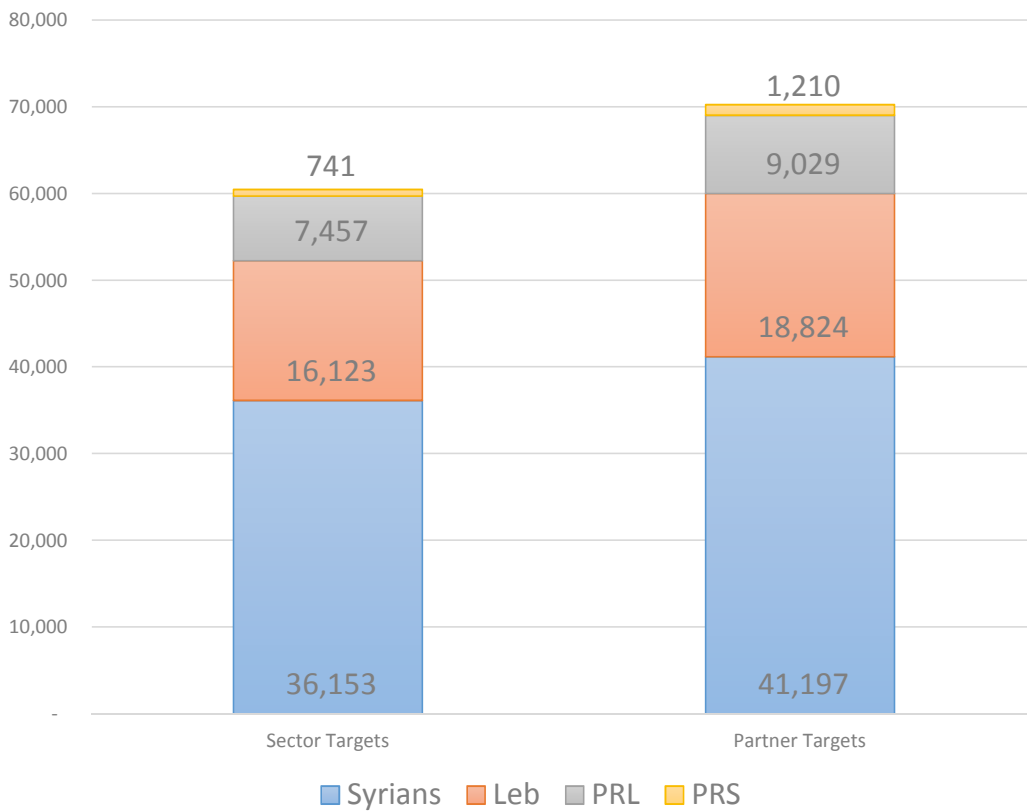

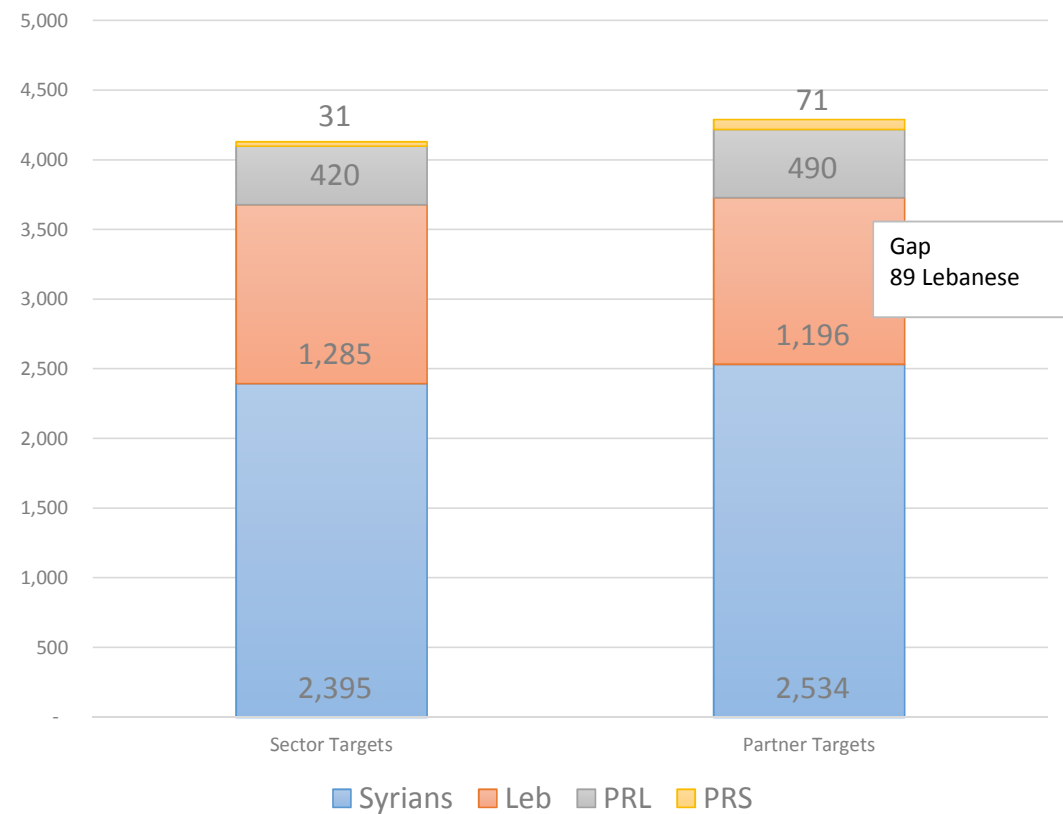
Comparison of Sector and Partner Targets in Field Working Group – North Group

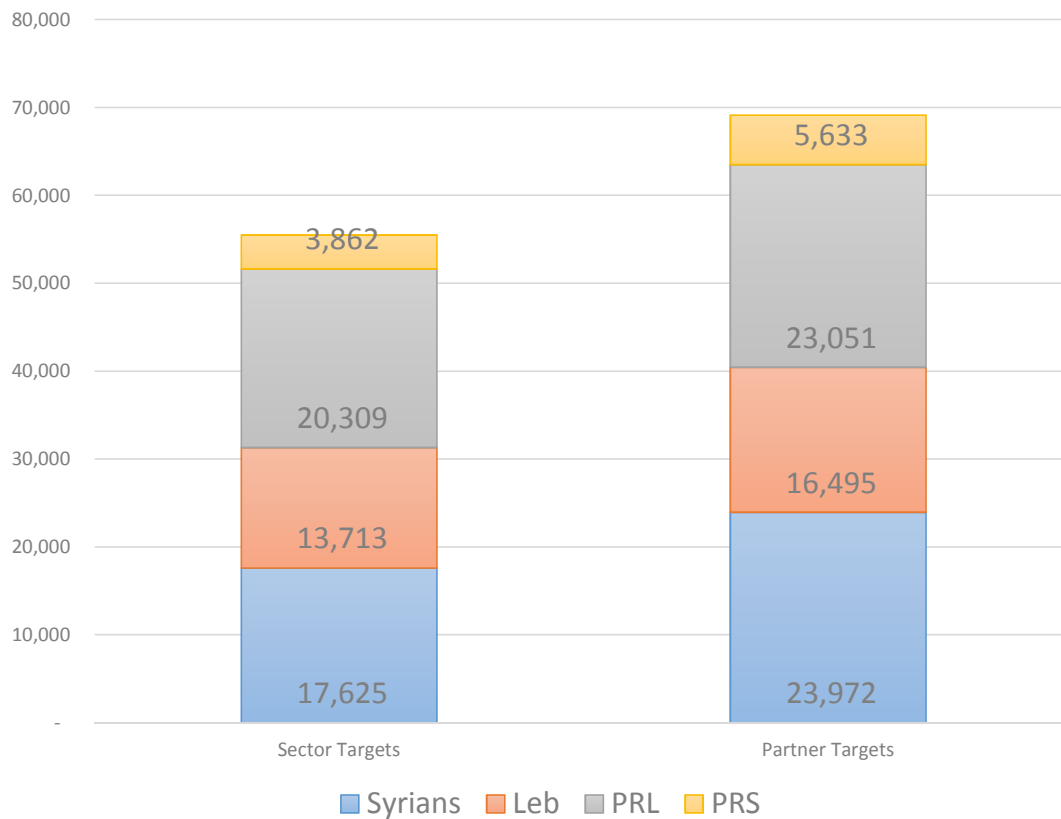

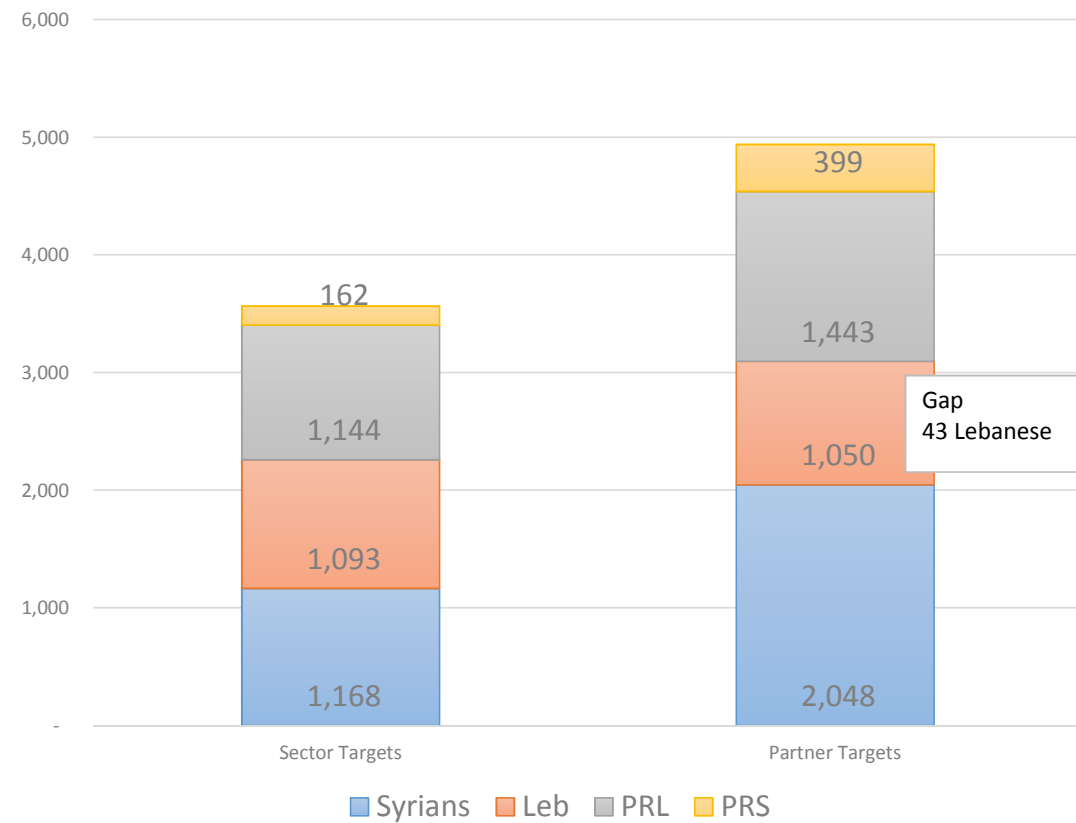
Comparison of Sector and Partner Targets in Field Working Group – South Group
