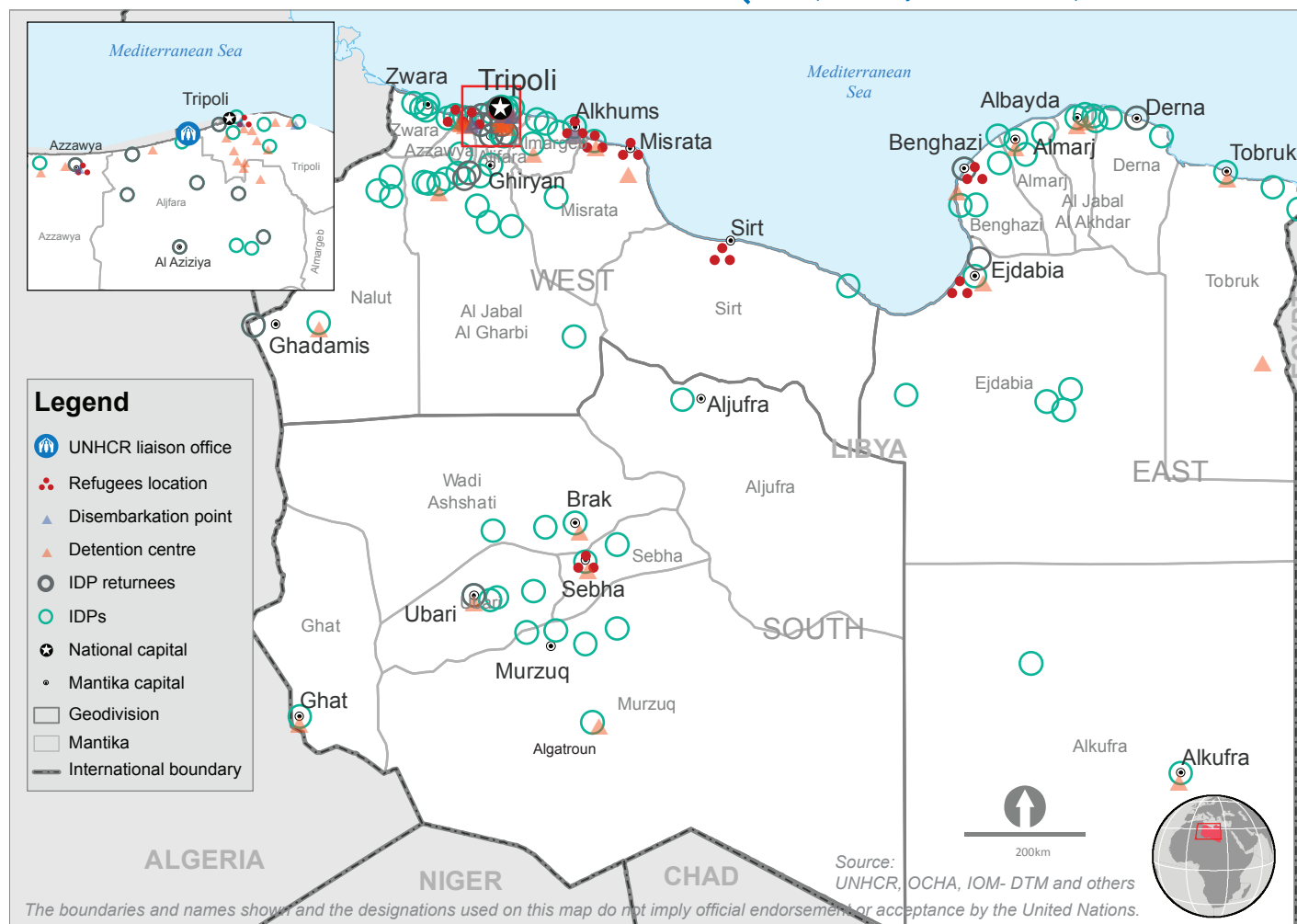

-  **14** capacity building events for stakeholders

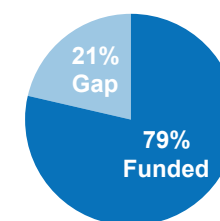


UNHCR Funding Requirements
