

Expand the Out of Camp Policy to all nationalities for up to 75,000 refugees.

10% of the refugee population in Ethiopia will have permission to reside in urban settings.

Current state: Only applied to Eritrean refugees

Opportunities: Existing urban refugee programme and various funding for urban situations

Current Partners: ARRA, DICAC, JRS, OIC-E, ZOA

Future Partners: MoFA, Regional BoE



Increase enrollment:

Pre-school: from 44% to 60%

Primary school: from 54% to 75%

Secondary School: from 9% to 25%

Higher education: up to 2,500

Current state: Scholarships, skills and vocational training schemes.

Opportunities: Infrastructure, refugee teachers

Current Partners: MoE, ARRA, DICAC, IRC, SCI, WVE, AEEG, PIE.

Future Partners: UNESCO, British Council, GPE, WB.



Issue birth certificates to refugee children born in Ethiopia.

Refugee children will have access to civil documentation enabling their access to services.

Current state: Newborn refugees receive birth notifications from ARRA

Opportunities: New directives to implement the 2015 VERA Proclamation

Current Partners: FVERA, ARRA, UNICEF, SCI, PI, DRC, AHA, IRC, IHS, NRC, MCMDO

Future Partners: Regional Authorities, Transport authorities, NBE, CBE, MoFA, MIDIM

Provide work permits for refugees with resident ID & refugee graduates job creation for refugees & host communities
In areas allowed for foreigners

Current state: Drafting of the Regulations to complement and clarify the 2004 Refugee Proclamation.

Opportunities: New refugee Regulation. Jobs in Industrial parks to be allocated to refugees, graduated refugees (DAFI and government)

Current Partners: ARRA, MoSLA, MoFA, EIC, MoFEX, EIB, EU, WB, DFID, JRS, WVI, NRC, ZOA, ANE, OIC-E, DICAC, DRC, MCMDO, LWF, PRS, IHS, IOM, IRC

Allocate 10,000 Hs of irrigable land for refugees and host community.

Expand medical services, allow refugees to obtain bank accounts, driver's licenses and other benefits for foreigners are entitled to.

Current state: Livelihood projects for refugees and host communities

Opportunities: IKEA project, DRDIP

Allow refugees who have been in the country for 20+ years to locally integrate impacting some 13,000 refugees. Refugees in protracted situations find a durable solution.

Opportunities: Protracted refugees potentially in Jijiga and Pugnido, ARRA's Senior Leadership visit to Uganda

Current Partners: ARRA, UNHCR
