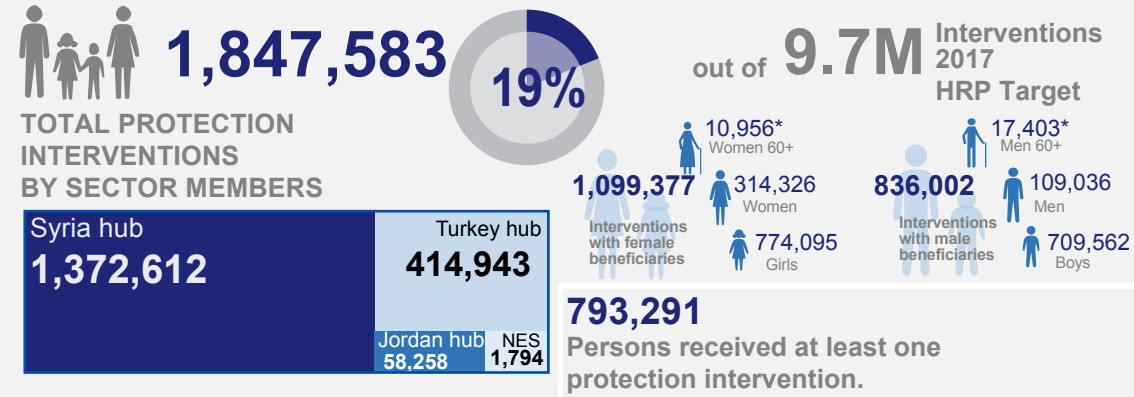
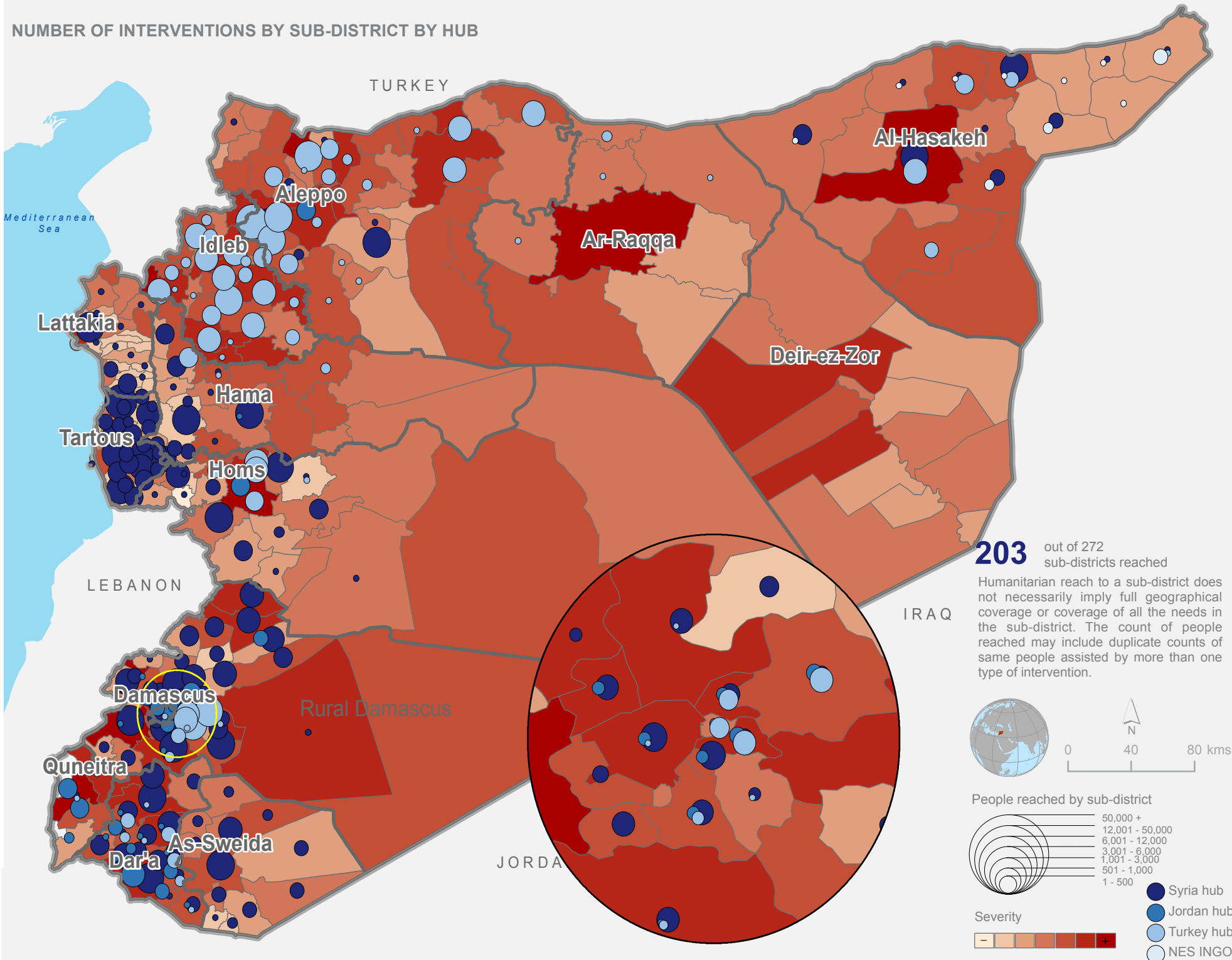


Syrian Arab Republic: Whole of Syria Protection Sector response snapshot for 2017 (as of 30 April)

From 1 January to 30 April 2017, the Protection sector conducted 1,847,583 interventions in 1,045 communities in 203 out of 272 sub-districts in Syria. These interventions include: awareness raising, risk education, protection monitoring, individual and group psychosocial support, case management, referrals to other services, material/cash assistance and others. Many of the interventions are done through community centres, schools, child friendly/ women and girls safe spaces or using outreach volunteers.
