
ALEPPO GOVERNORATE: WHOLE OF SYRIA PROTECTION SECTOR RESPONSE (as of 31 May 2016)





Summary information of protection response

- 334,300 Interventions from Jan to May with 80,200 in May
- Top three types of interventions in 2016: Structured Child Protection & PSS activities, Direct risk education for explosive hazards and Awareness raising sessions on child protection concerns
- 17 Sub-districts reached out of 40 targeted, with 11 reached in May
- 46 organizations are implementing activities on ground. 26 are reporting directly to the sector

Highlights

- Most number of interventions were done in Jebel Saman district.
- Awareness raising campaign through leaflets/pamphlets distribution (Afrin and Ain-al-arab subdistricts), Child protection communication/ social mobilization campaign (Jebel Saman), Referral of children with specific CP needs to specialised services (Jebel Saman), GBV case management training (Jebel Saman) and other GBV trainings (Aza'z) for frontline responders were the new activities reported in May


Response in Besieged locations and HTR area

- The Governorate does not have any besieged locations.
- 30 out of 992 communities in HTR area have been reached, five in May, with one for the first time

Key context information

- As of Aug 2015, the Governorate has an estimated 2.8M people in need
- Top three protection threats identified in the HNO 2016: Lack/loss of personal civil documents,
 Explosive threats and Recruitment/Use of children into armed groups
- Displacement
 - In the HNO 2016, as of Aug 2015, Aleppo Governorate is estimated to have 1.25M IDPs.
 - In 2016, from Jan to May, 154,928 new displacements have been reported to 9 sub-districts (CCCM Cluster)
 - In May, **25,639** displacements were reported to the Governorate. **21**, 847 was to Aza'z sub-district, 88% of which is to IDP sites (CCCM Cluster)
