
QUNEITRA GOVERNORATE: WHOLE OF SYRIA PROTECTION SECTOR RESPONSE (as of 31 May 2016)





Summary information of protection response

- 1,200 Interventions from Jan to May with 300 in May
- Top three types of interventions in 2016: Structured Child Protection & PSS activities, Child protection community event/ activity day and Training for frontline responders in Protection mainstreaming
- Four Sub-districts reached out of six targeted, with three reached in May
- **Seven** organizations are implementing activities on ground with all of them, reporting directly to the sector

Highlights

- Fig sub-district was reached in May, for the first time in 2016
- In May, only Child protection and psychosocial support (PSS), including parenting
 programmes was the only activity reported and it was conducted in Al-Khashniyyeh and
 Quneitra sub-districts., apart from Fiq


Response in Besieged locations and HTR area

- The Governorate does not have any besieged locations.
- Only one (Quneitra city) out of nine communities in HTR area has been reached

Key context information

- As of Aug 2015, the Governorate has an estimated **65,266 people in need.**
- Top three protection threats identified in the HNO 2016: Lack/loss of personal civil documents, Recruitment/Use of children into armed groups and Explosive threats
- Displacement
 - In the HNO 2016, as of Aug 2015, the Governorate is estimated to have **38,700** IDPs
 - 250 new displacements were reported to the Governorate in 2016, 100 of them in May 2016 to Al-Khashniyyeh sub-district (OCHA Jordan)
