Figure 1.1 - Total Refugee Population in Sub Office Jijiga

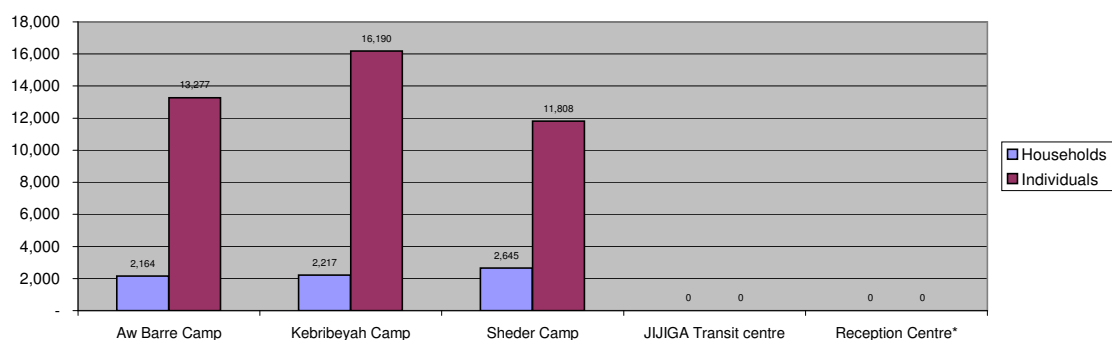

Figure 2.1 - ALL CAMPS Demographic Breakdown*

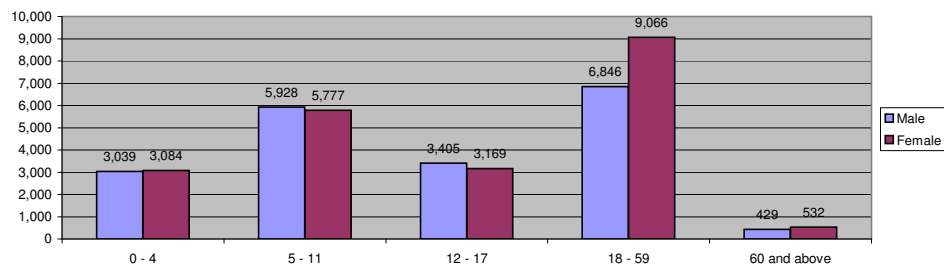

Figure 2.2 - Aw Barre Camp Demographic Breakdown

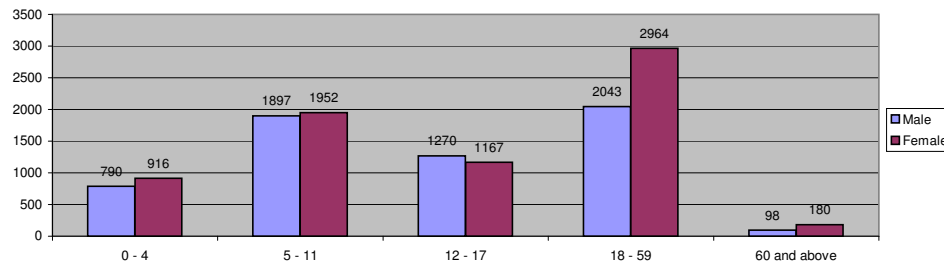

Figure 2.3 - Kebribeyah Camp Demographic Breakdown

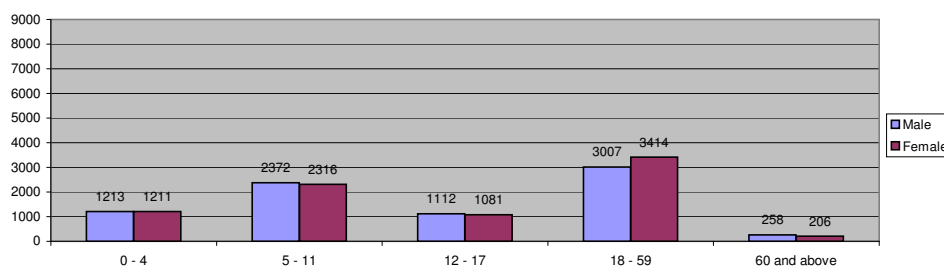
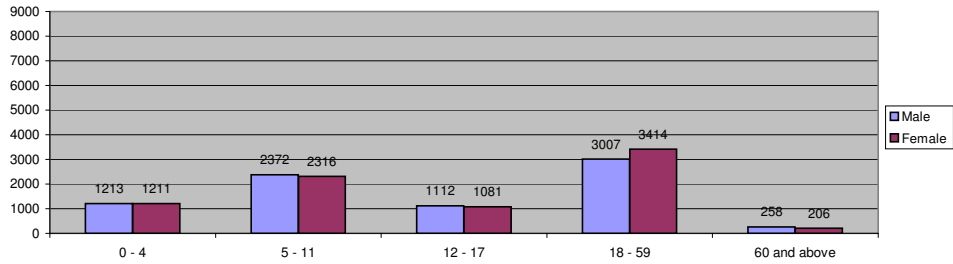

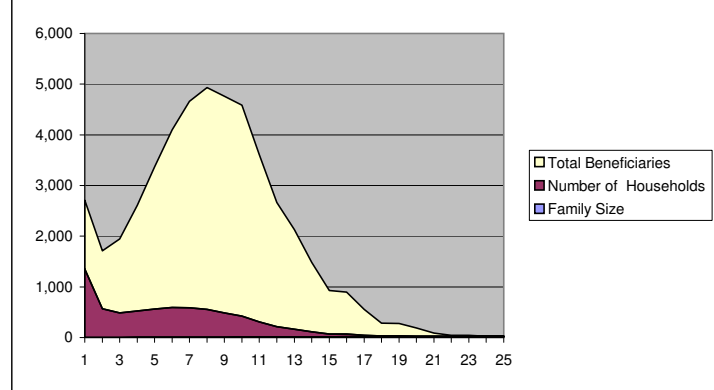

Figure 4.2- Aw Barre Camp Household Size

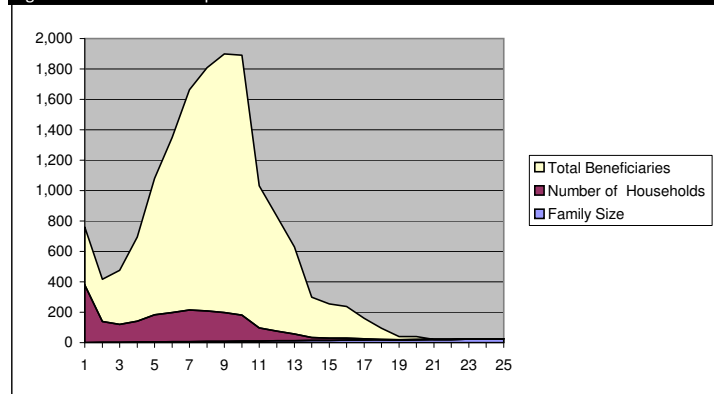
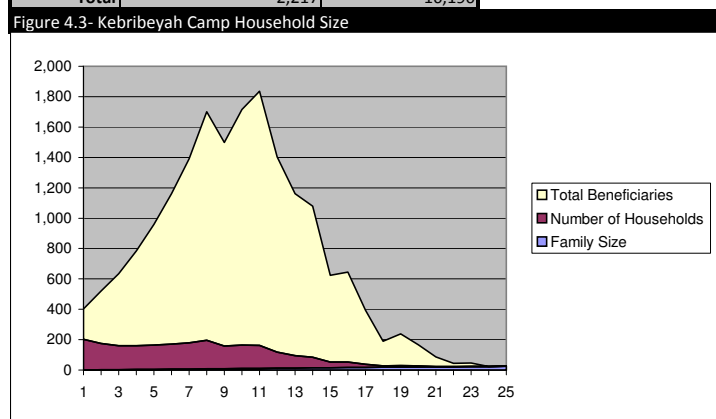


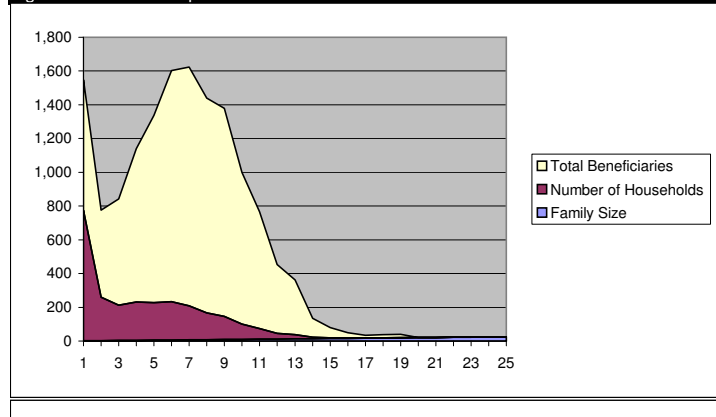
Figure 4.3- Kebribeyah Camp Household Size

Figure 5.1 - ALL CAMPS Specific Needs

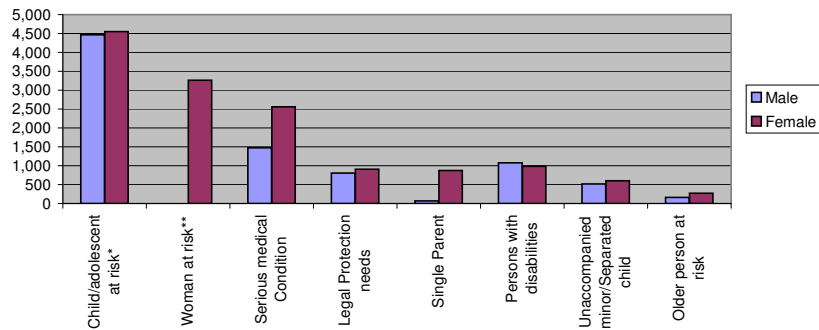
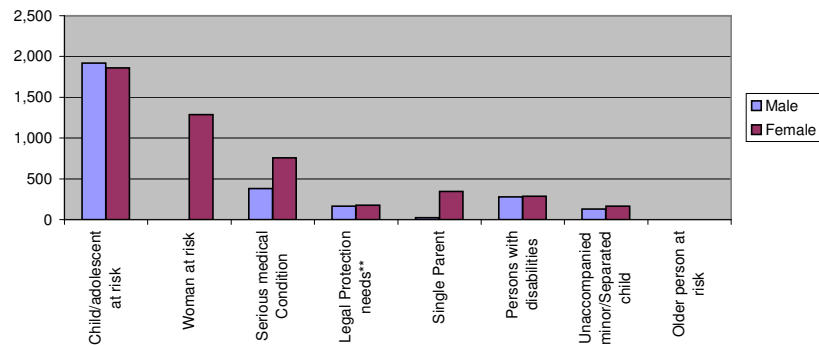

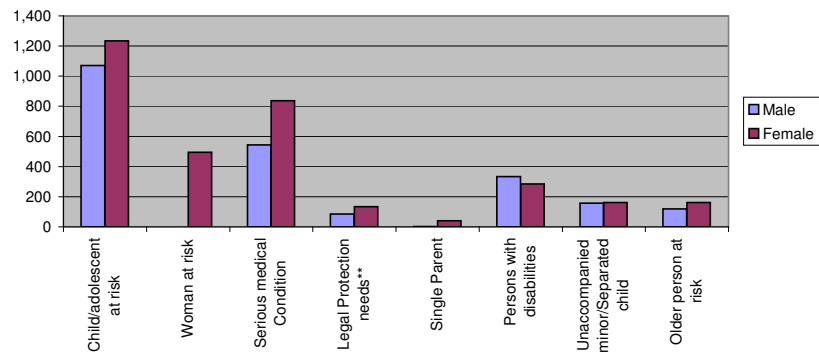

Figure 5.2 - Aw Barre Camp Specific Needs



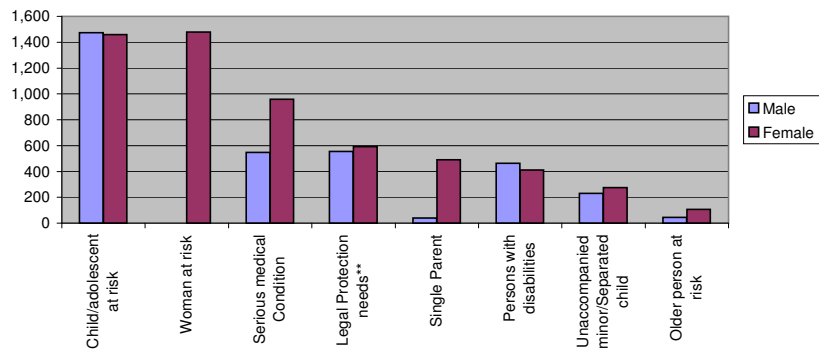

Figure 7.1 - ALL CAMPS Places of Origin

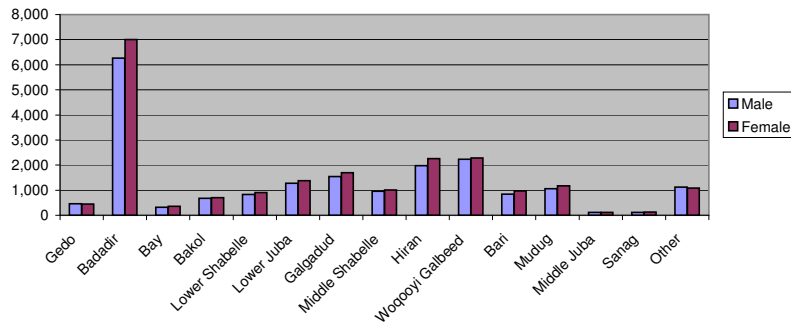
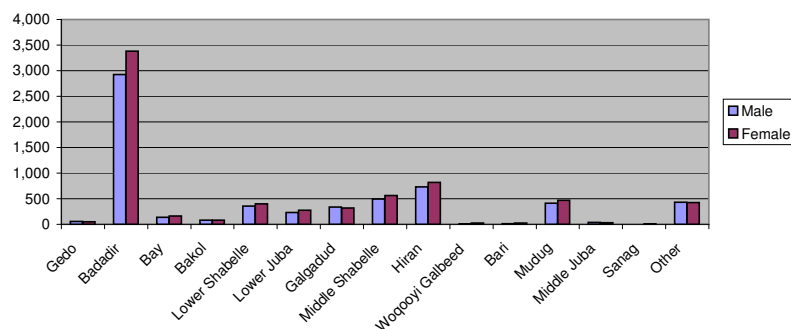

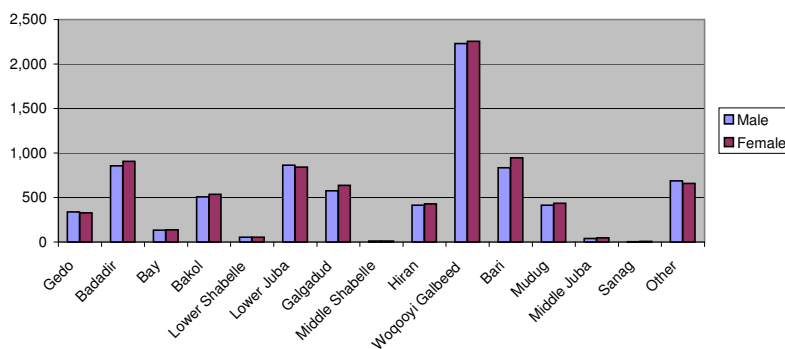

Figure 7.2 - Aw Barre Camp Places of Origin



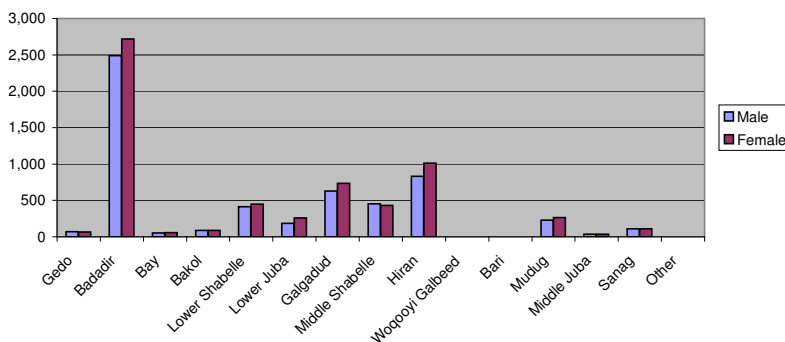

Figure 6.1 - ALL CAMPS Ethnic Breakdown

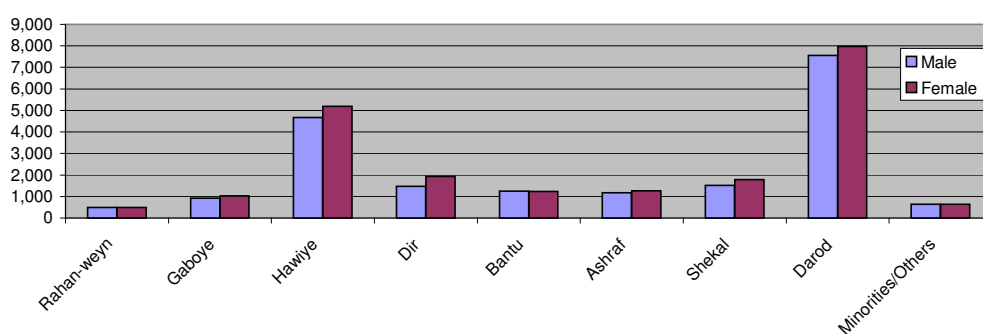
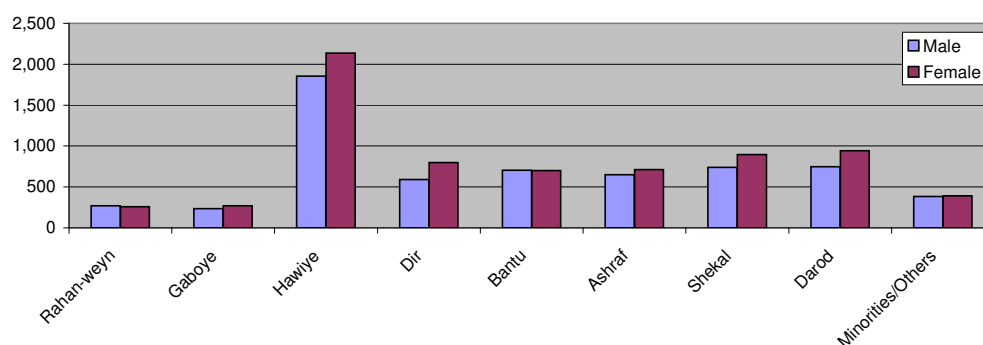

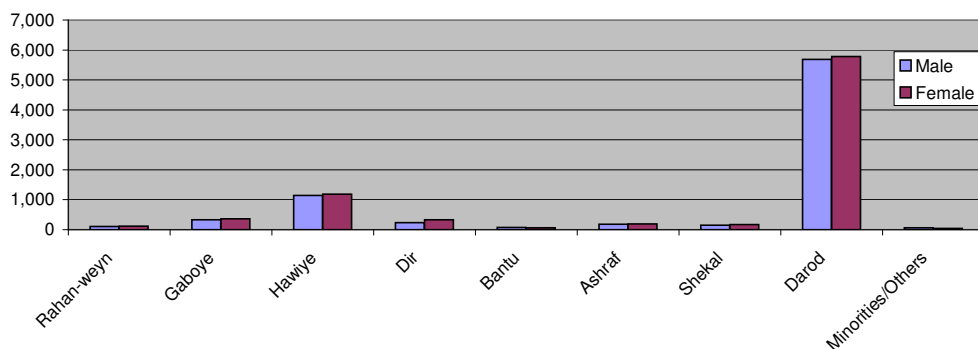
