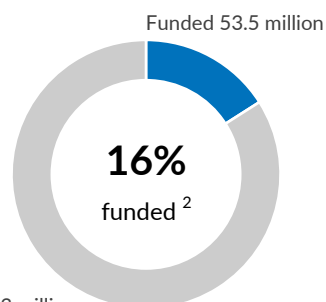

### Notes:

1. The financial requirements for Ethiopia include requirements for the operation's regular programme, Central Mediterranean Route Situation, Somalia Situation, South Sudan Situation and the Yemen Situation.
2. The percentage funded is calculated using earmarked contributions pending the eventual allocation of broadly earmarked and unearmarked contributions.
3. Contributions are shown by the level of flexibility in the earmarking. Contributions earmarked to a situation within a country are classified as country level.
4. The broadly earmarked contributions listed are those which can potentially be used for Ethiopia due to their earmarking to a related situation, region, sub-region or theme. The total amount of the contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$2 million and more.
5. The total amount of unearmarked contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$10 million and more.
