

Notes

- 1. The financial requirements for Syrian Arab Republic include requirements for the Iraq Situation Response and the Syria Situation Response.
- 2. The percentage funded is calculated using earmarked contributions pending the eventual allocation of broadly earmarked and unearmarked contributions.
- 3. Contributions are shown by the level of flexibility in the earmarking. Contributions earmarked to a situation within a country are classificated as country level.
- 4. The broadly earmarked contributions listed are those which can potentially be used for Syrian Arab Republic due to their earmarking to a related situation or theme, or to the region or sub-region. The total amount of the contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$2 million and more.
- 5. The total amount of unearmarked contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$10 million and more.
