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Round table challenges

- UNICEF delays with PCA signing. Causing challenges
- UNICEF continual absence in the coordination meetings is a missed opportunity to collaborate, communicate and resolve issues.
- In Darashkran 60% of sector E does not have water. ACF willing to take some emergency temp action. Waiting for approval from UNICEF & DSW.

The Directorate has raised the issue of lack of site plans for camps in Erbil governorate. They are very eager to move the construction of water networks forward, but depending on plans. An estimated 300M Dinars have already been spent on water trucking.
