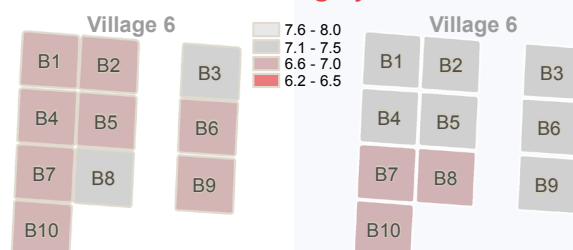

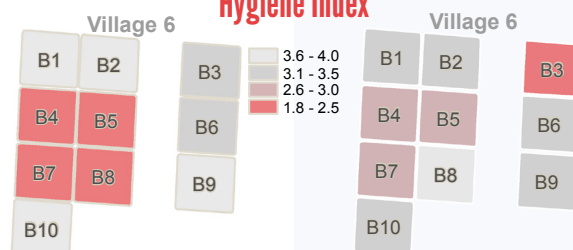

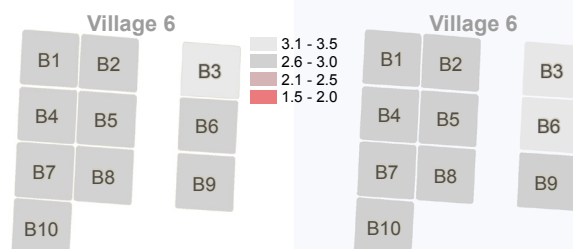

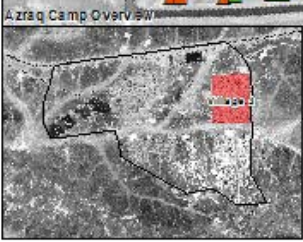
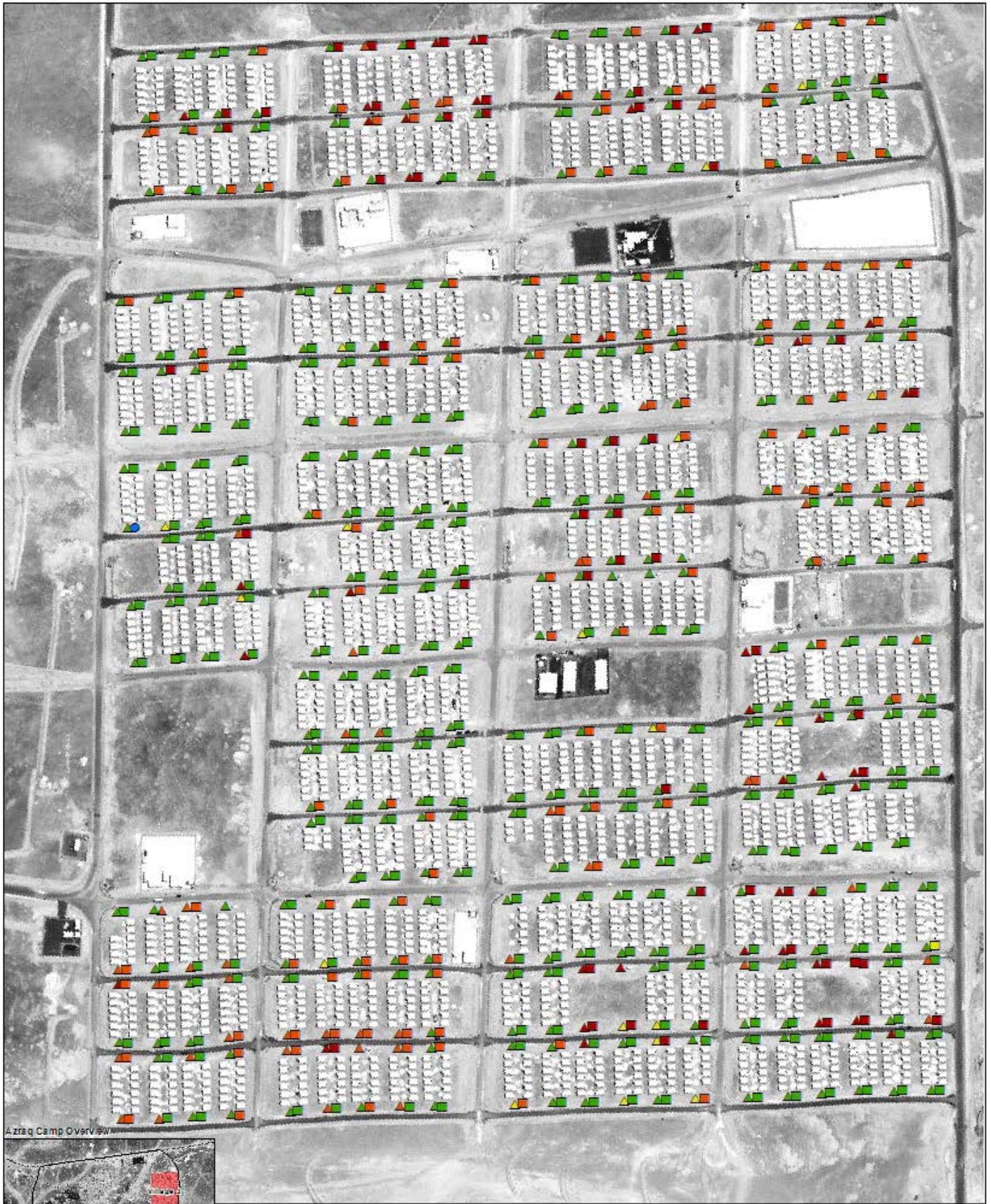

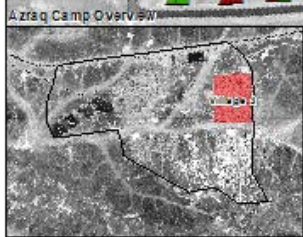
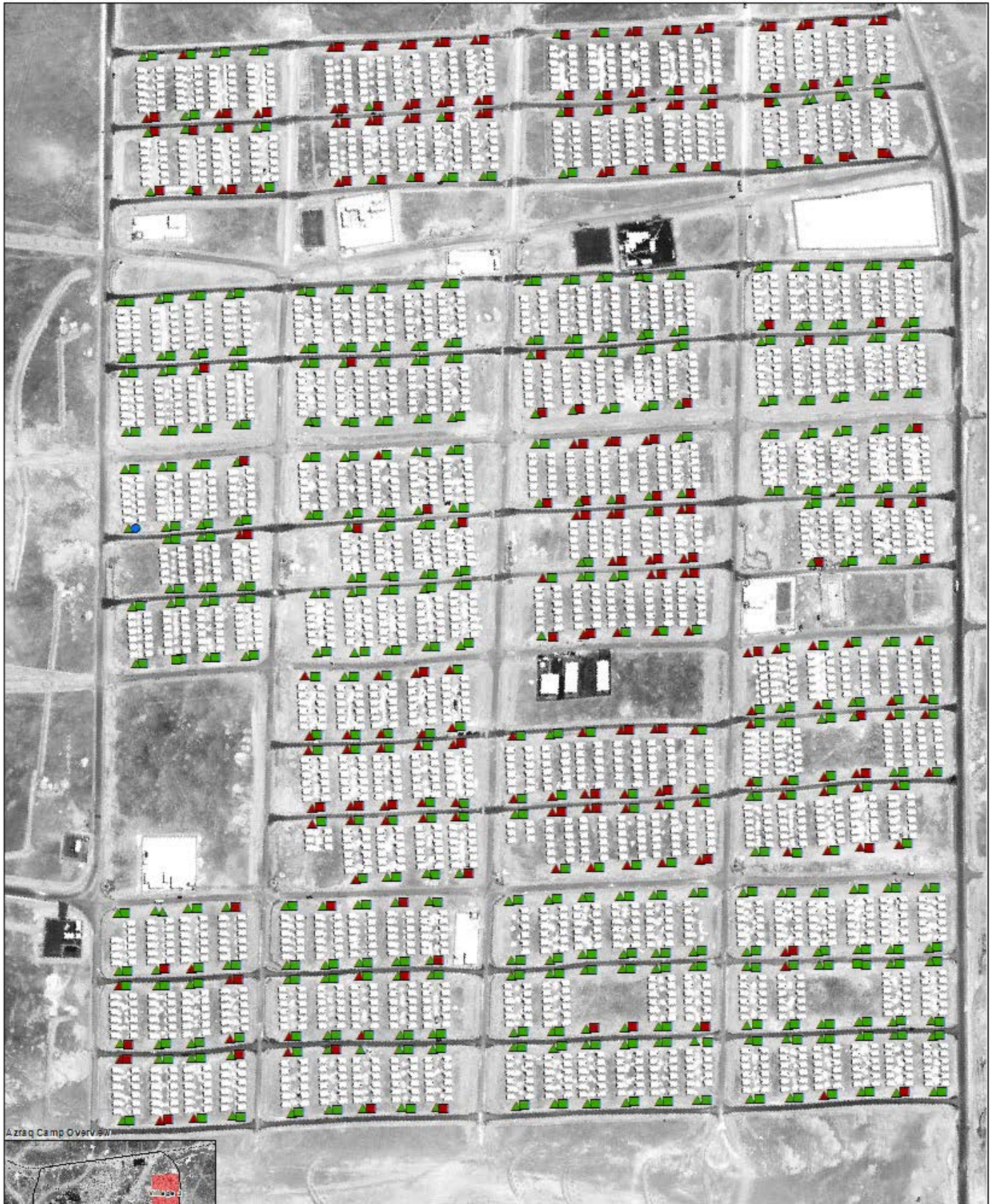

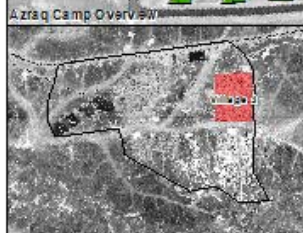

Map 5: Outside locks at the height of 1.2m from the ground or lower in Village 3

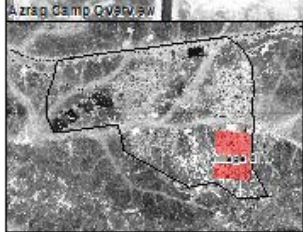
