

UNHCR RESETTLEMENT IN 2015

- Resettlement took place from more than gees from 65 countries of origin.
- 134,044 individuals submitted for resettlement (28% increase from 103,890 in 2014).
- 81,893 individuals departed for resettlement (12% increase from 73,330 in 2014).
- Submissions from Africa reached 38,870 in 2015 which is a 147% increase in total submissions from 2012.
- Over 100,000 Bhutanese refugees resettled out of Nepal since the launch of the programme in 2007.

Slovakia provide over 400 places for refugees to continue the resettlement process.


