



Situation Update: Unaccompanied Children (UAC) in Greece

31 March 2018



3,010 Estimated number of UAC currently in Greece

Out of the total:

- 96,3% Boys
- 3,7% Girls
- 5,1% <14 years old

The population estimation excludes separated children.

1,102 Total number of places in UAC shelters

2,137 in the waiting list for shelter, out of which:

- 157 in RICs
- 87 in Protective custody

11,817 Total number of UAC referrals received and processed between January 2016 and 31 March 2018.

Out of which:
9,680 have been processed and completed,
2,137 have been processed and are in the waiting list for shelter, (including 195 separated children)

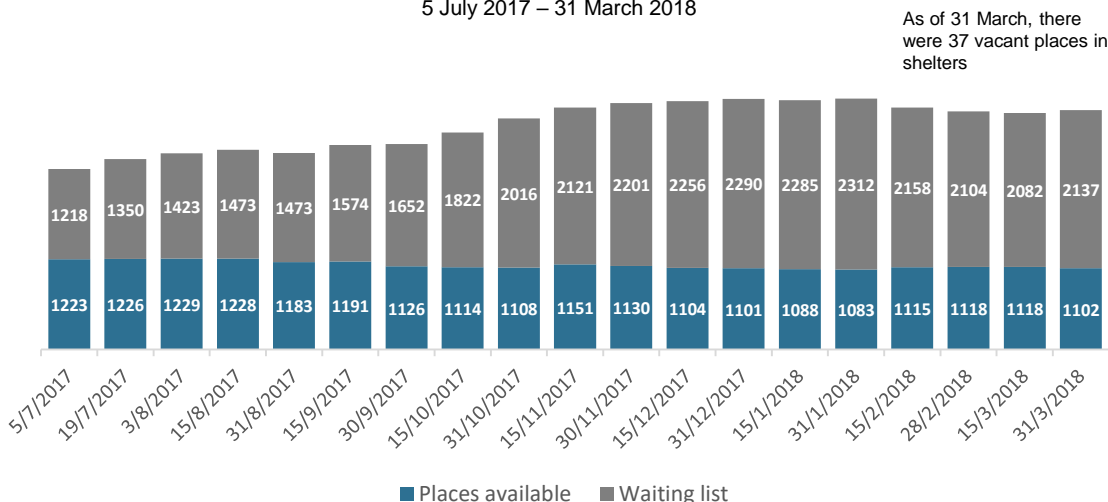

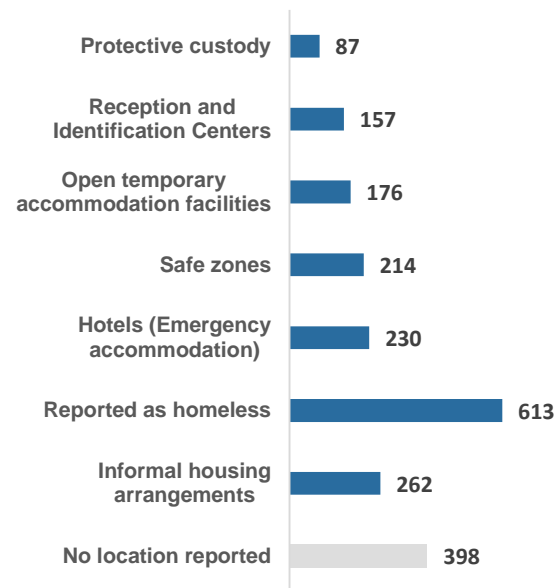


Number of places in UAC shelters vs. Waiting list

5 July 2017 – 31 March 2018

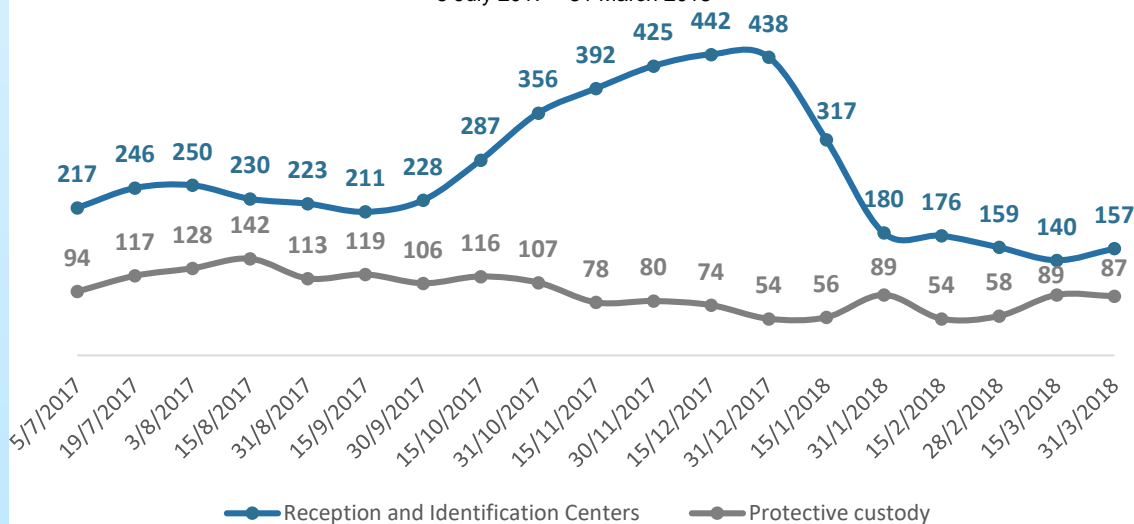


Reported place of stay of children in the waiting list – Total: 2137

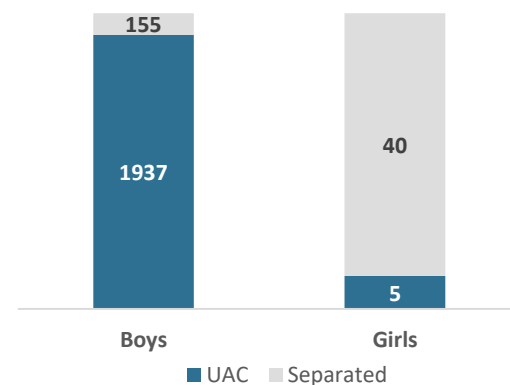


Number of UAC in Reception and Identification Centers/Protective Custody

Key Facts

as of 31 March 2018

UAC shelters

- **Current: 49** UAC shelters with total **1,102** places

Safe zones* (short-term)

- **Current: 10** Safe Zones for UAC with total **300** places

Hotels** (emergency)

- **Current: 6** Hotels for UAC with total **310** places

***Safe Zones** are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their best interests.

****Hotels** are emergency accommodation spaces being used as a measure to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Priority is given to UAC in Reception and Identification Centers.

Available places by type and region



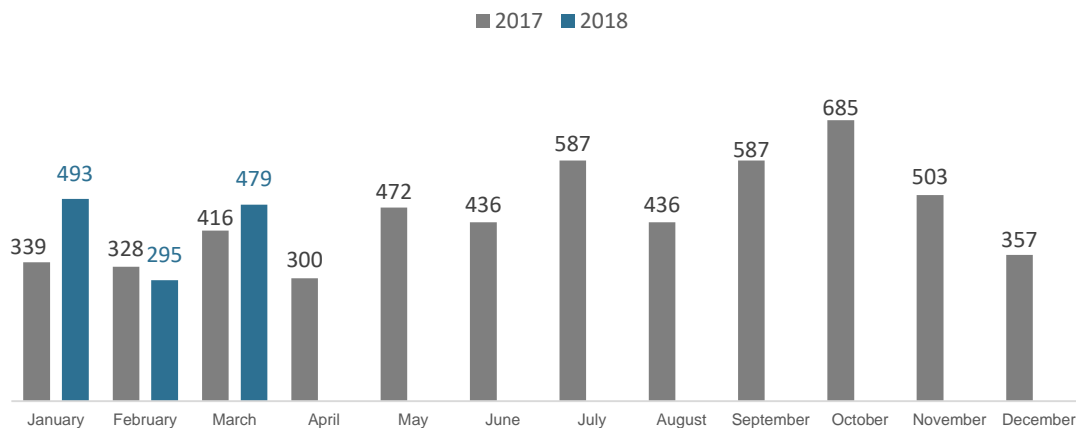

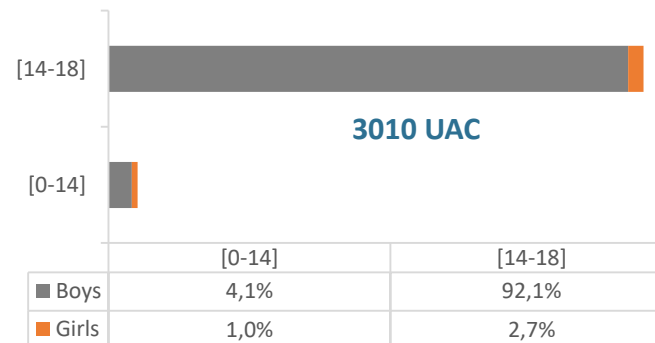

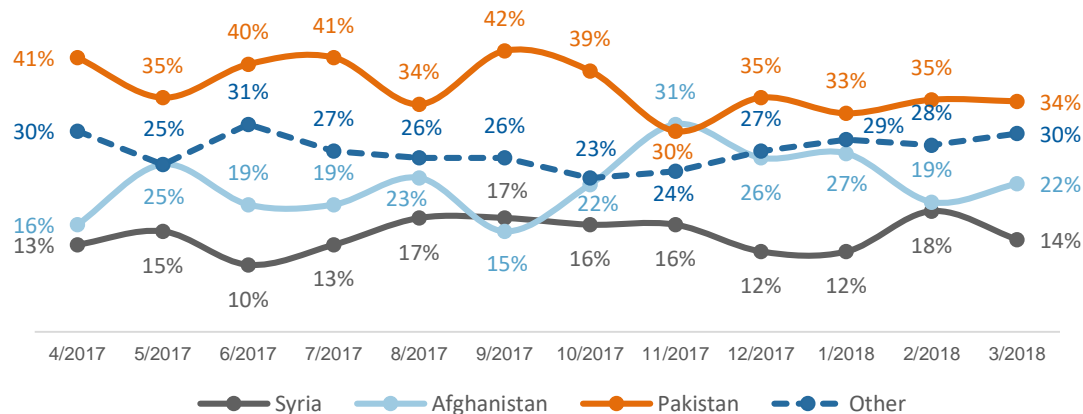
Number of UAC Referrals to EKKA by month
(updated on a monthly basis)



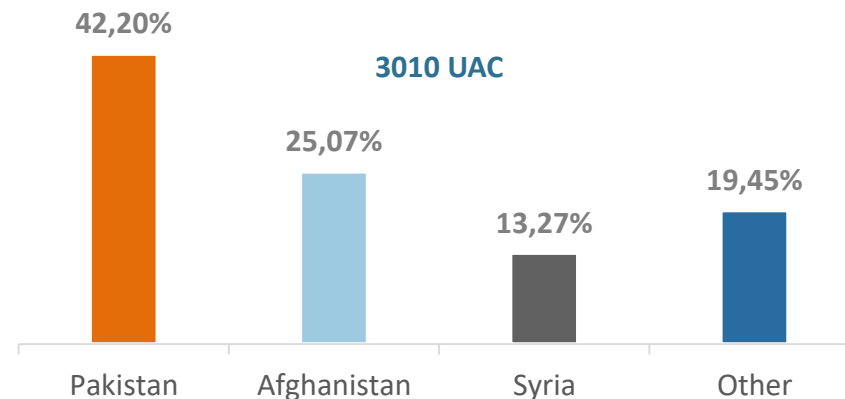
Estimated UAC population disaggregated by sex and age group
