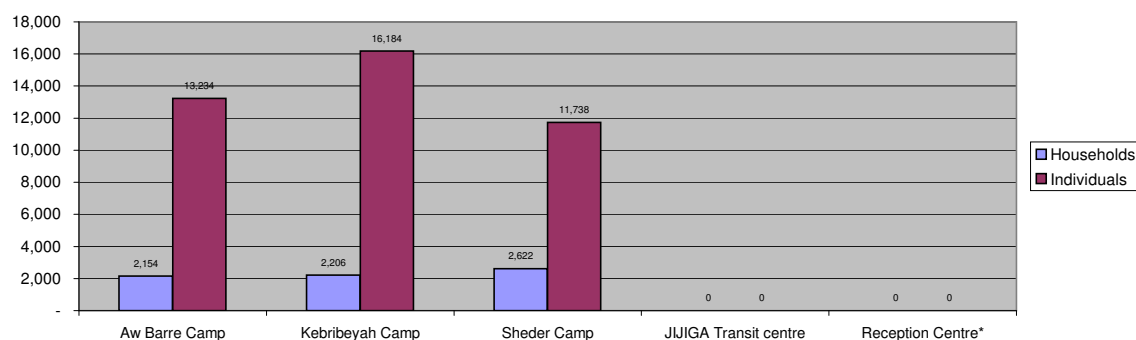

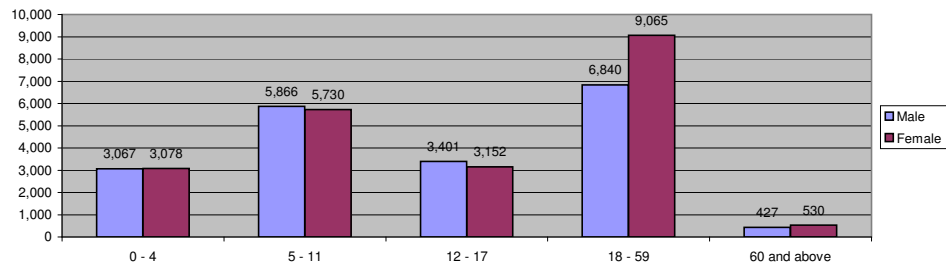

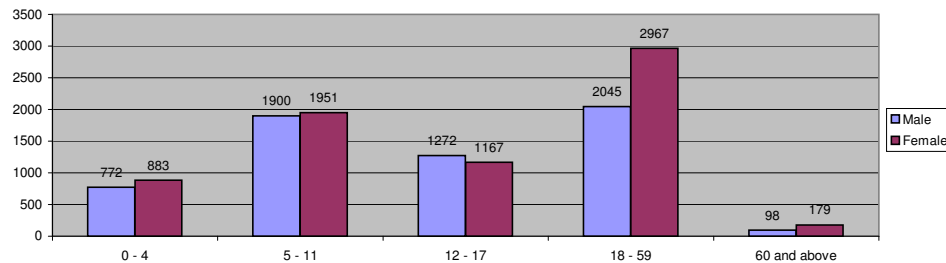
**Figure 2.1 - ALL CAMPS Demographic Breakdown\***

**Figure 2.3 - Kebribeyah Camp Demographic Breakdown**

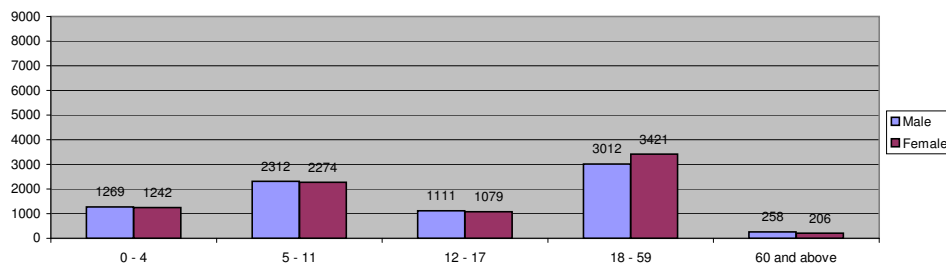
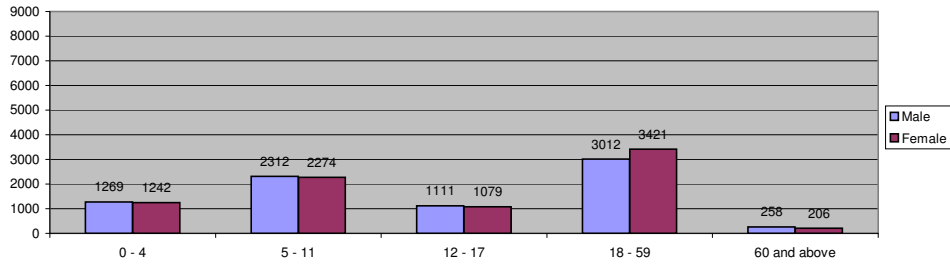

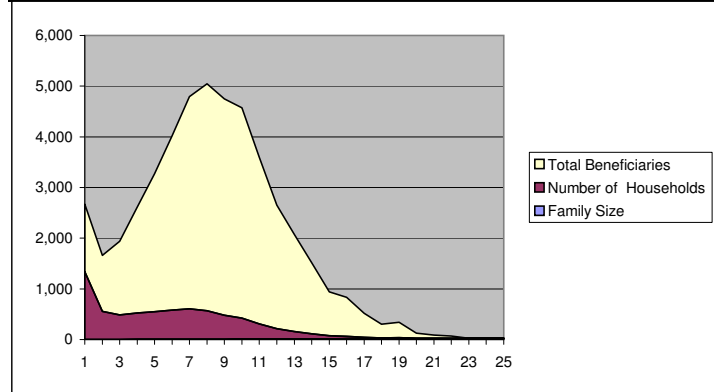

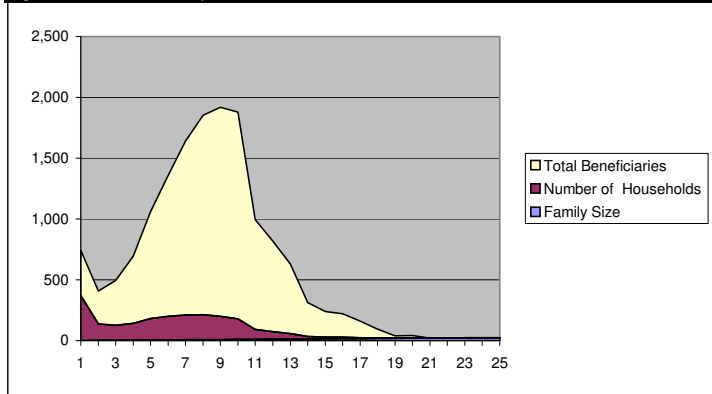

Figure 4.1- ALL CAMPS Household Size



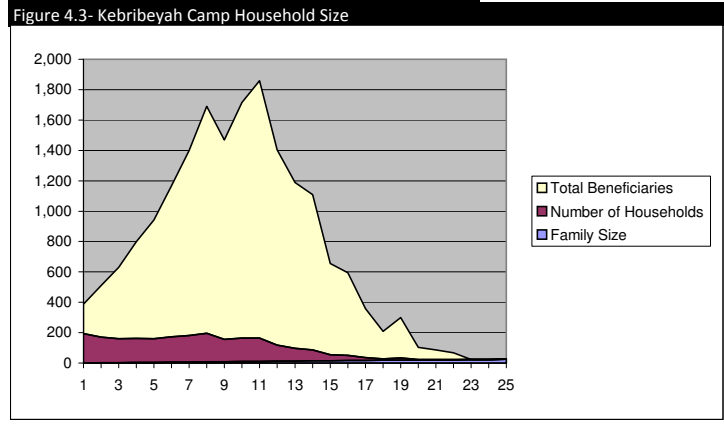

Figure 4.2- Aw Barre Camp Household Size



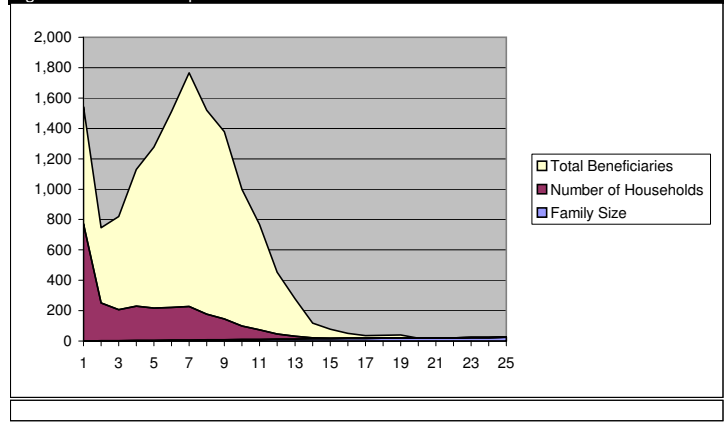
**Figure 4.3- Kebribeyah Camp Household Size**

Figure 4.4- Sheder Camp Household Size





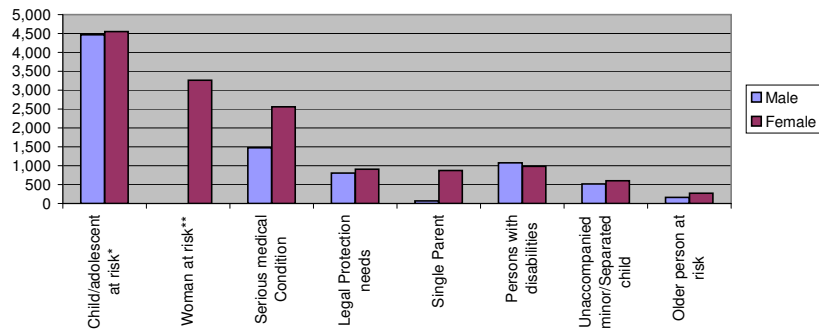

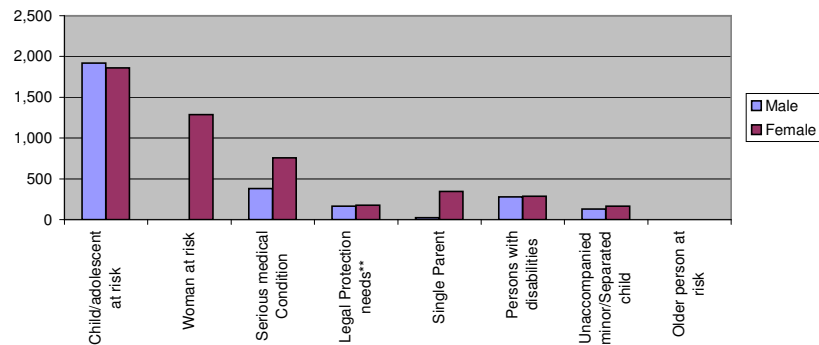
**Figure 5.1 - ALL CAMPS Specific Needs**

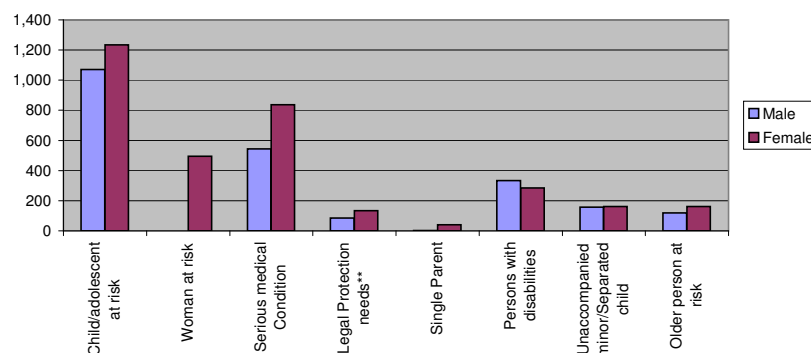

**Figure 5.2 - Aw Barre Camp Specific Needs**



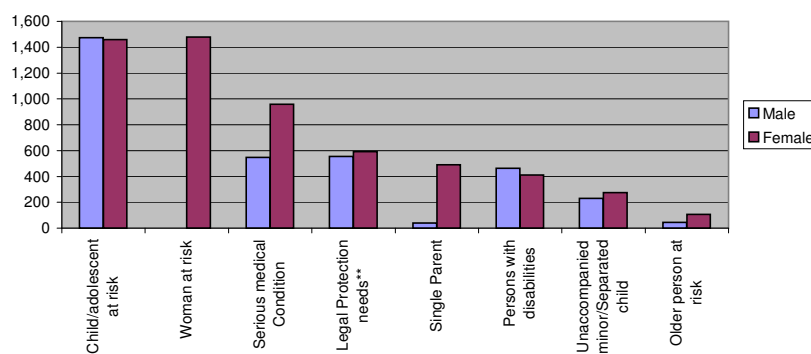

Figure 7.1 - ALL CAMPS Places of Origin

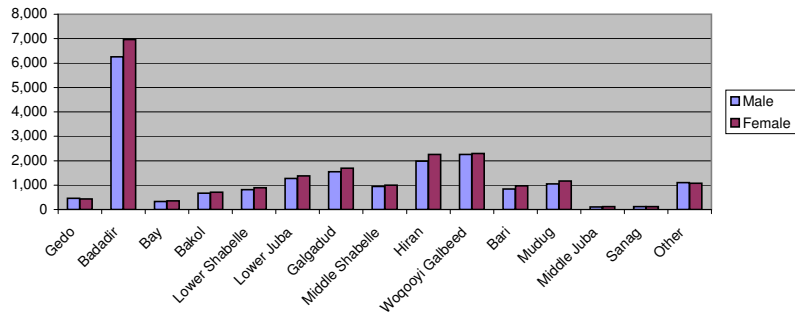
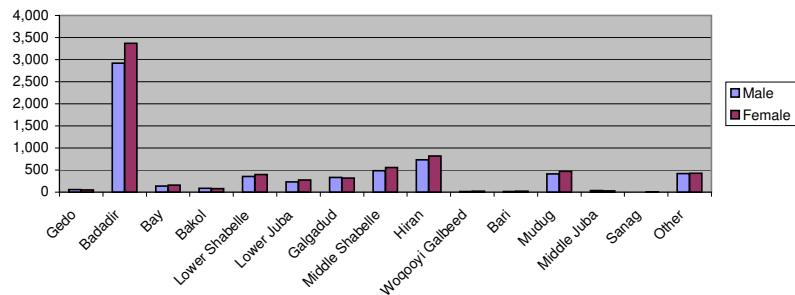

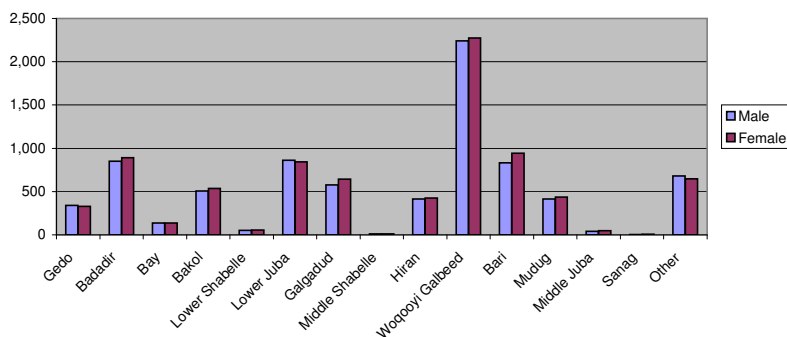

Figure 7.2 - Aw Barre Camp Places of Origin



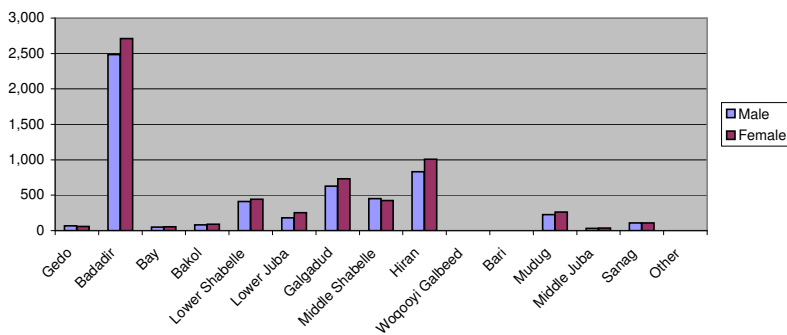

Figure 7.4 - Sheder Camp Places of Origin



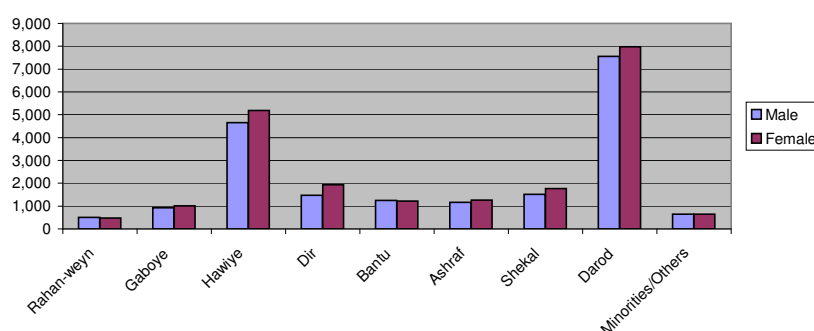

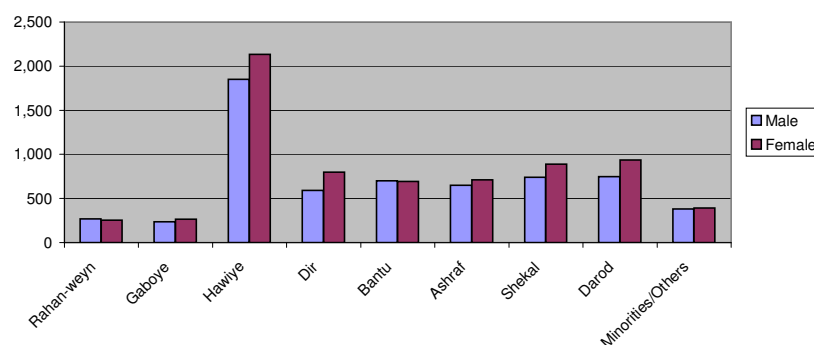
**Figure 6.1 - ALL CAMPS Ethnic Breakdown**

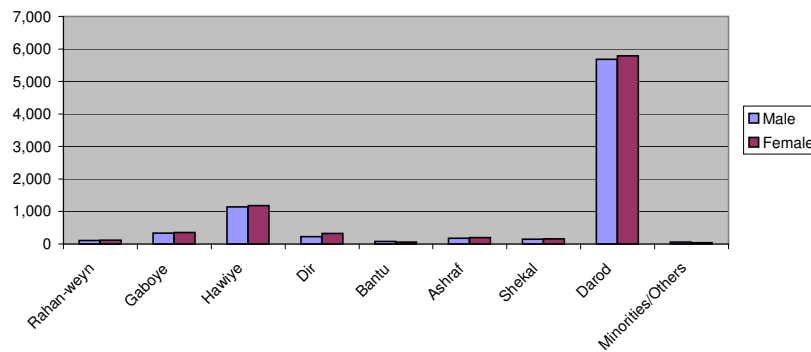
