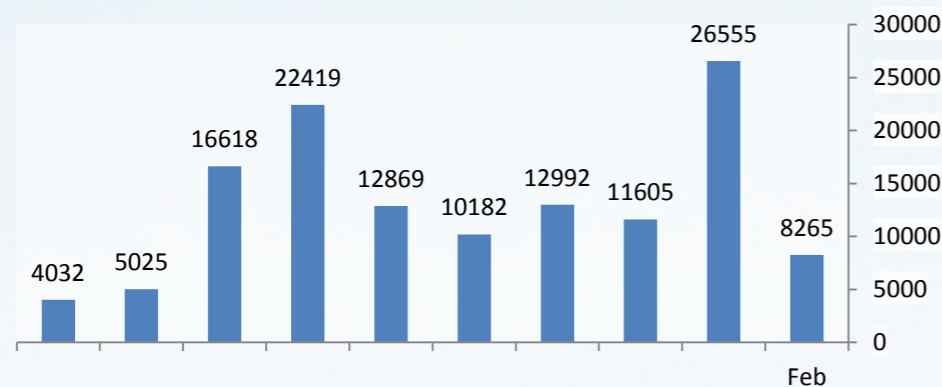


Total Number of Persons of Concern	239,379
Registered Refugees	189,988
Individuals Awaiting Registration	49,391

The refugee crisis is worsening. Average daily arrivals in the past 30 days have increased. January 2013 will likely be the month with the biggest arrival figures. We have now **1506 arrivals per day** when the average in the past 180 days was around **702 persons/day**. UNHCR is currently reinforcing its registration capacity in order to process the pending registration and certificate renewal.

Monthly record of Syrian arrivals in Jordan

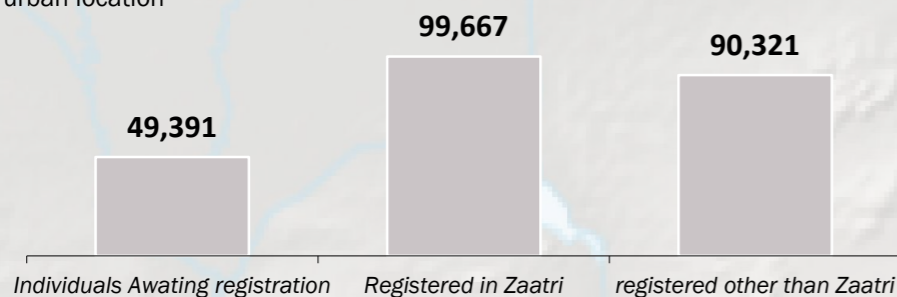
This figure represents the monthly arrival figure as recorded by IOM. IOM collects People Of Concern from the border and brings them to the UNHCR reception center. Note that NOT ALL those persons do then register with UNHCR.



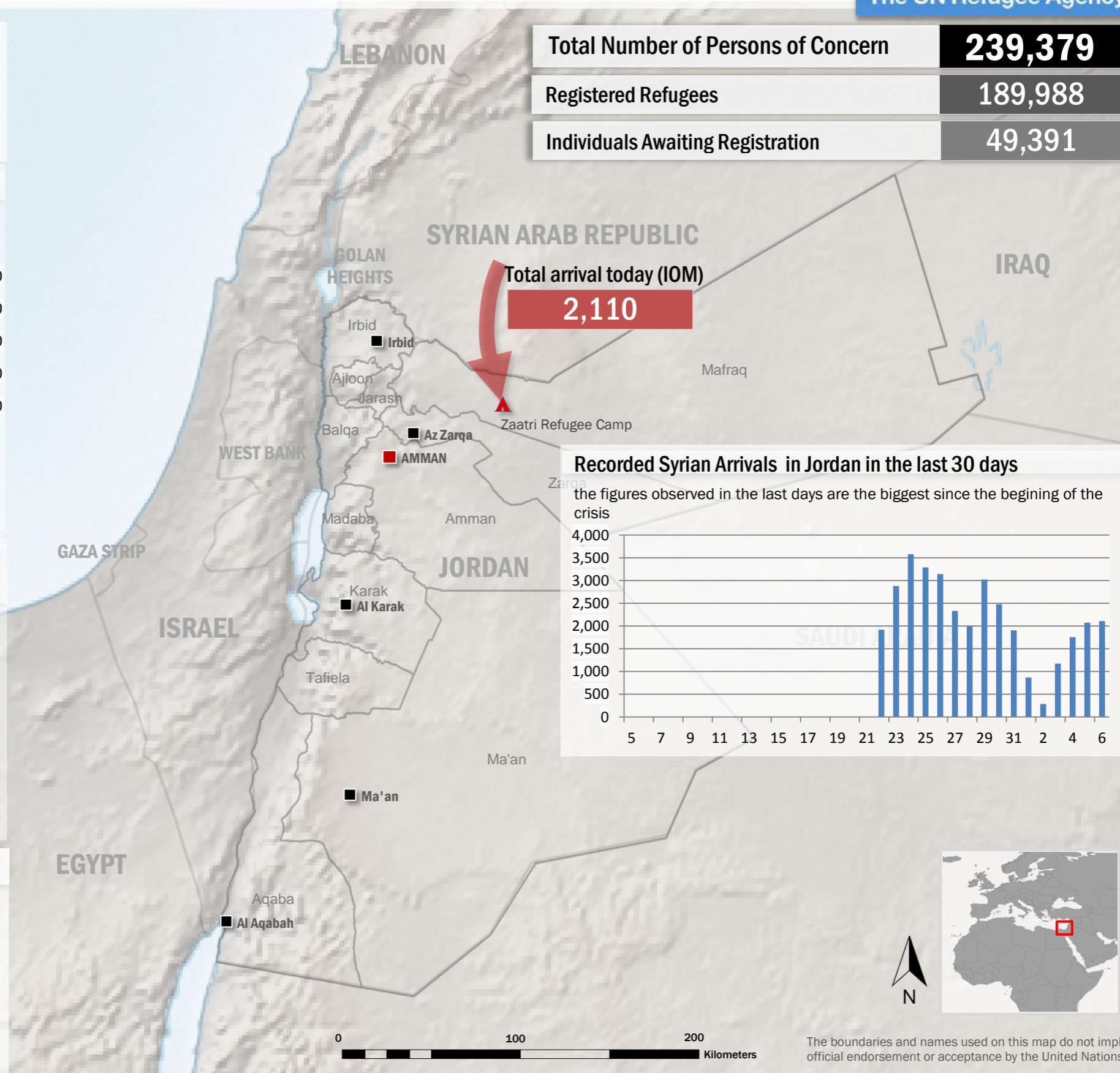
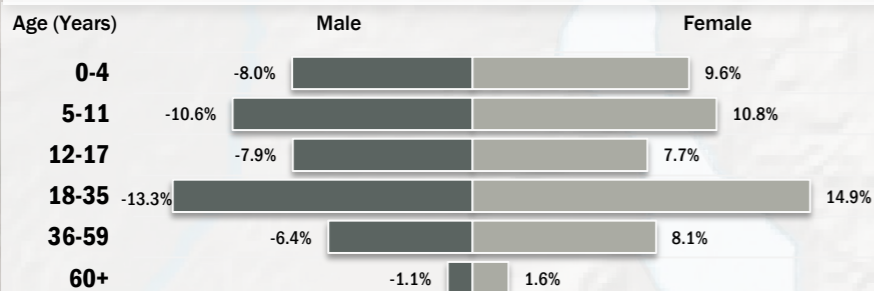
Note that IOM figures are the figures as extracted from IOM manifest everyday at 10:00 AM

Peoples of Concern awaiting registration are located in urban location

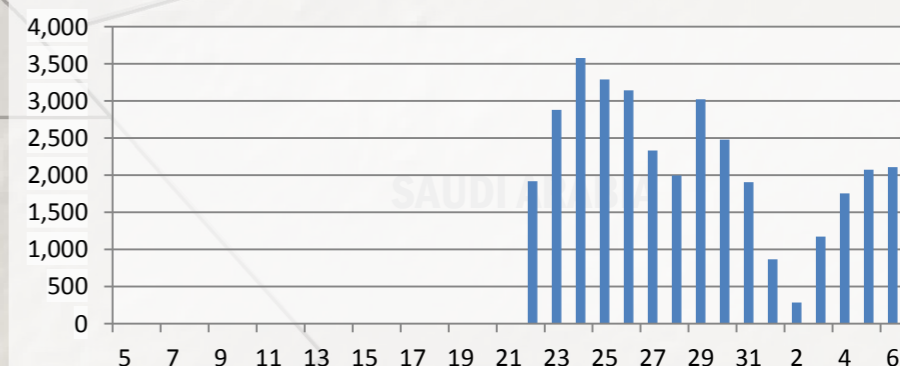


Age & Gender of Registered Refugees
