<b>Review workplan and recommendations of child marriage task force</b>	<p>1. Child marriage task force issued <b>recommendations</b> to the SGBV SWG, they were reviewed with all members and endorsed. Best practices highlighted by members: TDH highlighted that in their experience creating theatre plays with communities was a successful way to raise awareness. CARE conducted a media campaign to promote positive role models for women and girls and provided martial art classes in Azraq for girls. INTERSOS, as part of cash for documentation project provide soft counselling to families to prevent other child marriages within the family. UNHCR developed prevention messages to be shared during mandatory courses for couples. NHF highlighted that the youth network in Zaatari created a silent play on child marriage and NHF was hoping to extend to other locations. NHF also plans to work with national conservatory for music.</p>	<p><b>Recirculate document on new instruction on child marriage</b></p> <p><b>CARE and INTERSOS to share materials</b></p> <p><b>Members to share existing materials with Co-chair</b></p>

Members also reviewed pending items on the child marriage TF <b>workplan</b> and decided to take on the following activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Develop advocacy messages: SGBV SWG will integrate advocacy messages on child marriage into existing SGBV SWG advocacy messages.</li> <li>- Develop standardized materials for awareness raising activities</li> <li>- Mapping: mapping of SGBV service provider providing specialized services to child spouse or conducted specialized prevention activities.</li> </ul>	
<b>SoPs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Validation workshop was conducted by NCFE. A number of concerns were raised, main one being that the SoPs are not fully in line with global SGBV case management guidelines.</li> </ul>	<b>N/A</b>
