




HIGHLIGHTS


By the end of the fourth quarter of 2017, Basic Needs partners had provided cash base assistance to over 1.7 million beneficiaries, of which almost 1.2 million were in receipt of monthly cash assistance. Over half a million beneficiaries received NFIs throughout 2017. Support to shelter was increasingly identified as an area requiring support and programming. Within the Basic Needs sector, the number of beneficiaries receiving assistance to access adequate shelter solutions was twice the targeted amount for 2017.

Following the work of the Winter Task Force in Q3 to develop standard operating procedures to guide and harmonize winter assistance measures, as well as a 4W matrix to ensure broad coverage and avoid duplication, winter assistance was implemented by agencies within the sector. By the end of 2017 agencies had reached over 100,000 households throughout the country, including households in temporary accommodation centers, exceeding the initial planning figures for households to be targeted. Final figures will be available in early 2018, upon completion of the winter assistance cycle.

Partners within the Basic Needs sector completed the planning process for the revised Regional Refugee and Resilience Plan (3RP) for 2018/9. This involved a review of achievements and challenges experienced in 2017, conducted in Q3, as well as in-depth discussions on indicators to inform planning for 2018/9 within the scope of the national and regional strategies for the response to the Syria crisis. Partners worked together, under the coordination of UNHCR and WFP co-leads, to identify needs, agree upon a sector strategy within the broader national strategy, and commit to an appropriate response.
