




NARRATIVE

The operational context of FSA sectoral activities in the last quarter of 2017 covered a variety of projects carried out by partners mostly in Southeast Turkey, including:

- Provision of a dedicated food assistance to beneficiaries – mainly for those living in Temporary Accommodation Centers (TACs);
- Organization of a job-fair to provide beneficiaries, governmental agencies and actors from humanitarian and private sectors platform to meet and discover opportunities for collaboration;
- Implementation of small and medium scale agricultural projects, such as green-house and open field activities, support of value-chain and food processing interventions.

During the reporting period, the survey to identify capacity-building needs in the FSA sector was carried out informing the planning on current needs, priorities and ways to strengthen the capacity of partners in 2018. In addition, partners finalized the FSA chapter of 3RP for 2018-19, as well as the sectoral work-plan for 2018. Assessment related to agricultural livelihoods was carried out in partnership with local authorities and universities. The publishing of the report is expected by the first quarter of 2018. Significant job is being done towards reaching out to more actors on the ground, expanding the number of new FSA WG members and sectoral activities.
