1,191 Total number of places available in UAC shelters (filled, pending assigned cases as of 15 September, including 74 vacant places out of which 34 are suspended)

1,574 Total number of UAC on waiting list for shelter (as of 15 September) including:

•211 in Reception and Identification Centers
•119 in protective custody

Waiting list does not include referrals of unknown location carried out during pre-registration exercise. Waiting list includes also separated children.




Number of places available in UAC shelters (filled, pending assigned cases) vs.

17 November 2016 - 15 September 2017




Number of UAC placed in Reception and Identification Centers/Protective Custody 17 November 2016 – 15 September 2017 (based on requests by referral agents)






Number of UAC on the waiting list by location (Safe spaces, Police Stations, RICs, Temporary accommodation sites)

UAC Shelters (transit and long-term)


- Current: 52 UAC shelters with total 1,191 places. (increased from 423 places in March 2016)
- Planned: 2 new UAC shelters with total 60 new places

Safe Zones* (short-term)

- Current: **7** Safe Zones for UAC with total **204** places.
- Planned: 3 new Safe Zones with total 90 new places
- *Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their best intractions.









