





Explosive Threats in Myanmar




Since 2015, 298 civilians landmine casualties were reported. This means one every 3 days. One out of 3 has been a child. In one out of 4 cases, this meant death.



9 out of Myanmar's 14 States and Regions are contaminated with landmines and ERW.




