

UNHCR Ukraine has been providing humanitarian assistance to over 1.8 million internally displaced persons (IDPs) and 2.5 million refugees in Ukraine since 2014. The agency's response is coordinated with the Government of Ukraine and other partners.

US\$ 31.1 million in funding for UNHCR Ukraine in 2018.

54% of UNHCR's 2018 budget was funded by the Government of Ukraine.




