



- Meets every 2 weeks
- Mapping of ongoing and planned protection activities underway (5W)
- Ongoing IM support for partners

# SHELTER/NFI CLUSTER

- Meets every 2 weeks
- Standard NFI kits decided amongst partners and in agreement with WASH cluster coordinator
- Strategic advisory group of 7 partners put in place

### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PLANNED ACTIVITIES:

625 Protection incidents identified and documented (since mid November)



- **537** NFI kits distributed for a total of **3522** persons (since mid November)
- **5** Partners supported with trainings and database management solutions



**963** Households targeted for distributions during the week ahead
