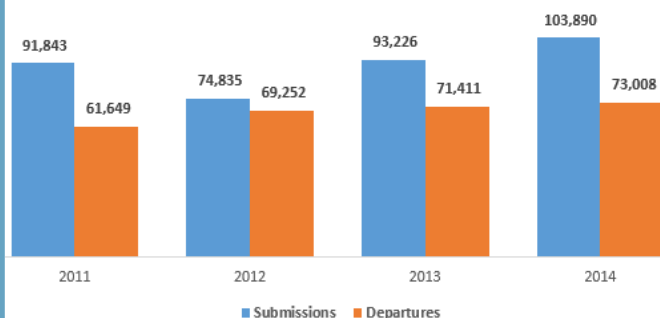

## RESETTLEMENT IN 2014

- Resettlement took place from more than 90 countries of asylum to 30 countries of resettlement (including special programmes), involving refugees from 64 countries of origin
- 103,890 refugees were submitted for resettlement in 2014
- 73,008 refugees departed for third-country resettlement
- Global average acceptance rate: 91.3%
- More than 12% of submissions under women and girls at risk category

## SYRIAN RESETTLEMENT PROGRAMME

UNHCR has called for 130,000 places under resettlement or other forms of admissions between 2013 and 2016. So far, 85,552 places have been pledged by third countries. UNHCR planned to submit 20,182 refugees in 2014, and at the end of the year, UNHCR submitted 21,154 Syrian refugees, which is 104% of its target.

## RESETTLEMENT FROM THE AFRICA REGION

UNHCR made in 2014 resettlement submissions alone out of Africa for some 35,079 refugees, which is a 24.7% increase compared to 2013 and a 123.3% increase compared to 2012.

## EMERGENCY TRANSIT FACILITIES (ETFs)

ETFs in the Philippines, Romania and Slovakia together provide over 400 places from where refugees can continue the resettlement process.

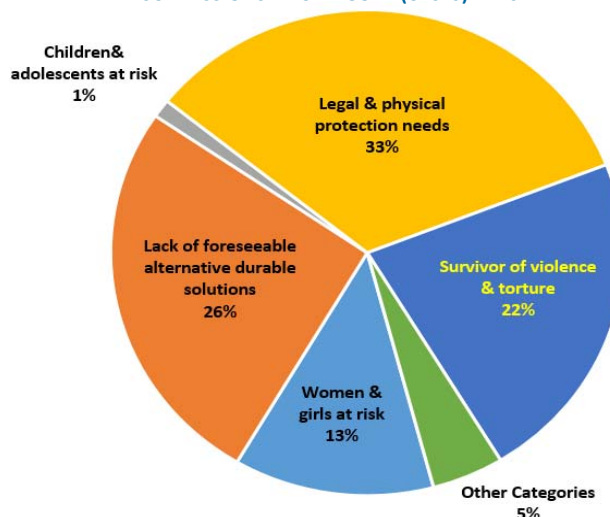
## WOMEN AND GIRLS AT RISK SUBMISSIONS OVER TIME (% OF TOTAL CASE SUBMISSIONS)
