

# LEITCHOUR REFUGEE CAMP, GAMBELLA REGION, ETHIOPIA

Analysis with WorldView-01 Data Acquired 05 May 2014

This map illustrates satellite-detected shelters and other buildings at the Leitchour Refugee Camp as seen by the WorldView-1 satellite on 5 May 2014. Fleeing outbreaks of violence in South Sudan, refugees have established a settlement in Gambella region, Ethiopia. Note that the camp occupied areas

include 2,632 improvised shelters, 2,368 tent shelters and 263 infrastructure and support buildings approximately. This is a preliminary analysis and has not yet been validated in the field. Please send ground feedback to UNITAR / UNOSAT.

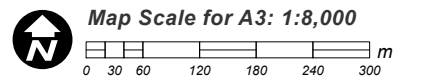
