1 - 30 September 2010



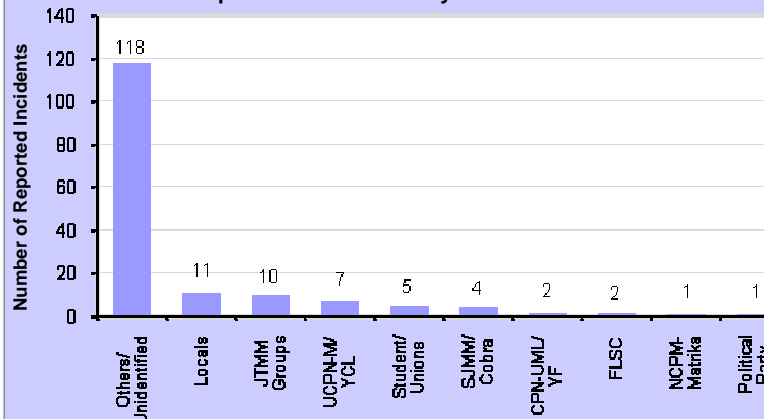
A person was injured in crossfire between two youth groups on the distribution of voters' ID card in Binauna VDC. 28 Sept.

An IED was detonated in front of a businessman's office at Dhamboji-1 in Nepalgunj. 24 Sept.

4 people were injured in a clash between UCPN-M and CPN-UML activists in Nanikot VDC. 24 Sept.

In the chart regarding groups, the "Others/Unidentified" category includes robbers/looters, landless squatters, smugglers, fire victims, refugees, farmers associations, religious communities, ethnic groups, and different armed groups, including unidentified people or groups.

Groups Involved in Security Related Incidents



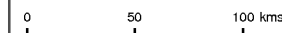

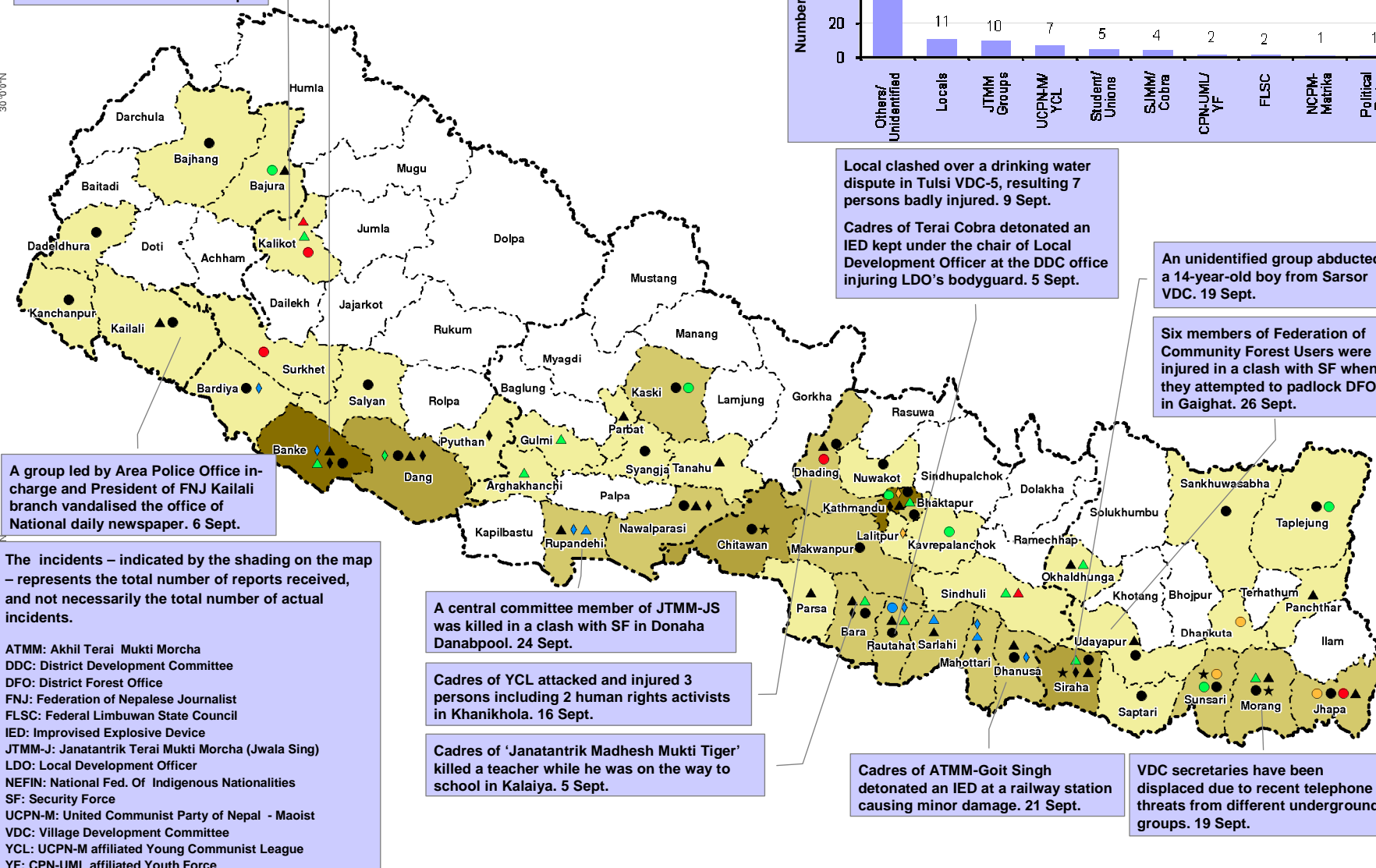

Local clashed over a drinking water dispute in Tulsī VDC-5, resulting 7 persons badly injured. 9 Sept.

Cadres of Terai Cobra detonated an IED kept under the chair of Local Development Officer at the DDC office injuring LDO's bodyguard. 5 Sept.

An unidentified group abducted a 14-year-old boy from Sarsor VDC. 19 Sept.

Six members of Federation of Community Forest Users were injured in a clash with SF when they attempted to padlock DFO in Gaihat. 26 Sept.

A central committee member of JTMM-JS was killed in a clash with SF in Donaha Danabpool. 24 Sept.

Cadres of YCL attacked and injured 3 persons including 2 human rights activists in Khanikhola. 16 Sept.

Cadres of 'Janatantrik Madhesh Mukti Tiger' killed a teacher while he was on the way to school in Kalaiya. 5 Sept.

Cadres of ATMM-Goit Singh detonated an IED at a railway station causing minor damage. 21 Sept.

VDC secretaries have been displaced due to recent telephone threats from different underground groups. 19 Sept.
