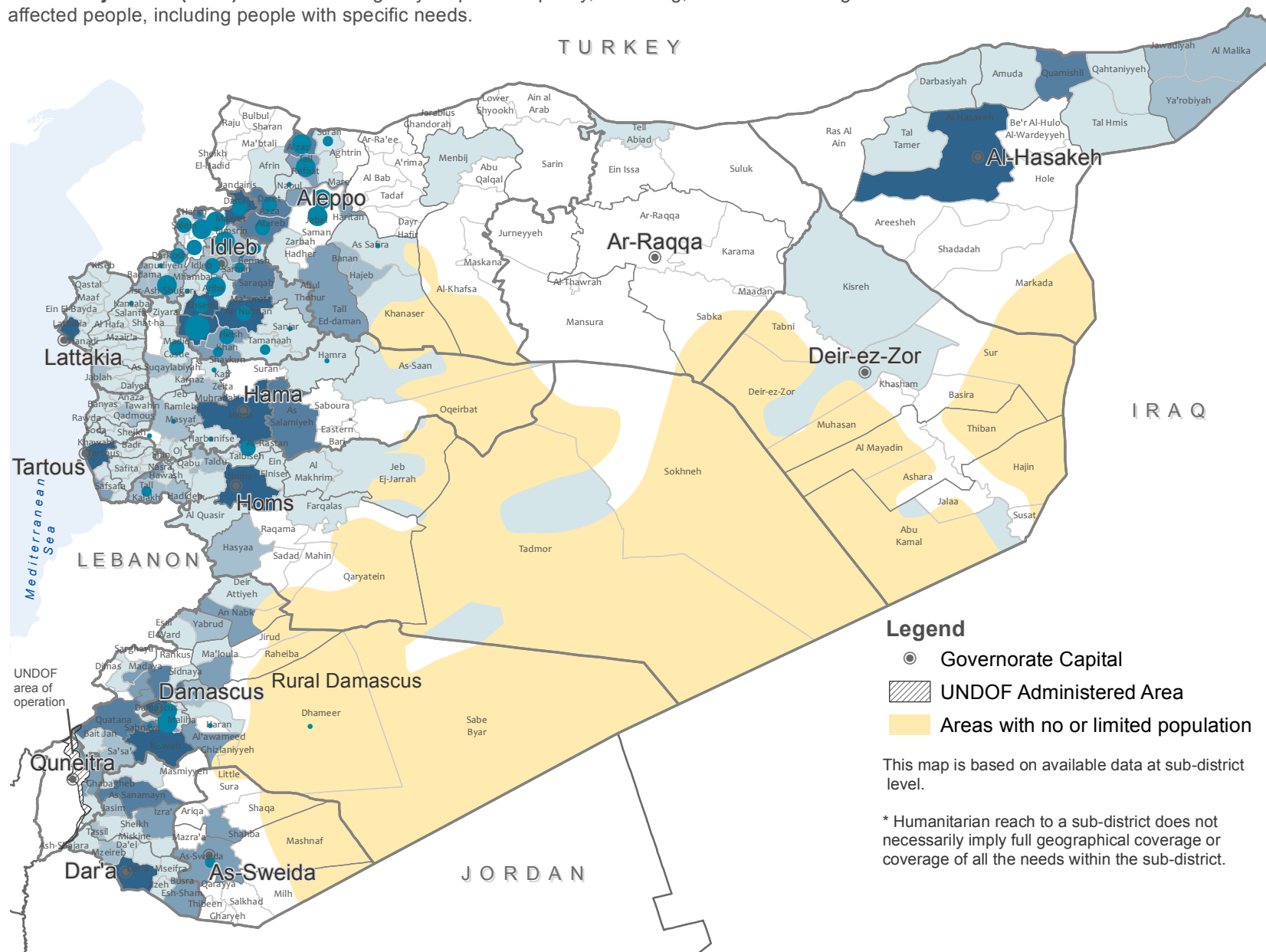


Syrian Arab Republic: Whole of Syria Food Security Sector - Sector Objective 1 (January 2016)
