INTRODUCTION TO UNHCR

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) was established on December 14, 1950 by the United Nations General Assembly. The agency is mandated to lead and co-ordinate international action to protect refugees and resolve refugee problems worldwide. Its primary purpose is to safeguard the rights and well-being of refugees. It also has a mandate to help stateless people.

In more than six decades, the agency has helped tens of millions of people restart their lives. Today, a staff of some 11,000 people in more than 128 countries continues to help about 66 million persons. To help and protect some of the world's most vulnerable people in so many places and types of environment, UNHCR must purchase goods and services worldwide. 1. REQUIREMENTS

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), Libya Office, invites qualified suppliers and manufacturers to make a firm offer for the establishment of Frame Agreement(s) for the supply and delivery of **Blankets**.

IMPORTANT:

Exact technical specifications of the items are detailed in Annex A of this document.

UNHCR may award Frame Agreement(s) with initial duration of **1 (one) year**, potentially extendable for **a further period of 1 (one) year**. The successful bidders will be requested to maintain their quoted price model for the duration of the Frame Agreement(s).

The estimated annual requirement of UNHCR is for 30,000 (thirty thousand) pieces of **Blankets**.

Please note that figures have been stated in order to enable bidders to have an indication of the projected requirements. It does not represent a commitment that UNHCR will require the totality of the above quantity. Quantities may vary and will depend on the actual requirements and funds available regulated by issuance of individual Purchase Orders against the Frame Agreement.

Other United Nations Agencies, Funds and Programmes shall be entitled to the same prices and terms as those contained in the offers of the successful bidders and could form the basis for a Frame Agreement with other UN Agencies.

IMPORTANT:

When a Frame Agreement is awarded, either party can terminate the agreement only upon 30 days' notice, in writing to the other party.

The initiation of conciliation or arbitral proceedings in accordance with **article 19** "settlement of disputes" of the UNHCR General Conditions of Contracts for provision of Goods and Services shall not be deemed to be a "cause" for or otherwise to be in itself a termination clause.

It is strongly recommended that this Invitation to Bid document and its annexes be read thoroughly. Failure to observe the procedures laid out therein may result in disqualification from the evaluation process.

QUALITY CONTROL THROUGHOUT THE FRAME AGREEMENT:

UNHCR will carry random quality inspections, including specific selected criteria for laboratory test to products or items selected by UNHCR or by an independent surveyor appointed by UNHCR from samples selected during production, upon departure, loading, unloading, arrival to destination or from any storage location. The cost of the quality control inspections and laboratory tests will be covered by UNHCR.

In cases of supplier's quality default, in addition to the good's PO penalty clauses, the inspection and laboratory cost will be charged to the supplier.

Sub-Contracting: Please take careful note of article 4 of the attached General Terms and Conditions (Annex E).

Note: this document is not construed in any way as an offer to contract with your firm.

2.3 REQUESTS FOR CLARIFICATION

Bidders are required to submit any request for clarification in respect of this ITB by e-mail to at supply.libya@unhcr.org. **The deadline for receipt of questions is 17:00 hrs Libyan Time on 27/01/2020.**

IMPORTANT:

Please note that Bid Submissions are NOT to be sent to the e-mail addresses above. Failure to comply with this provision will result in disqualification.

UNHCR will reply to the questions received as soon as possible by means of publication on its website or by email to all invited bidders.

2.4 YOUR OFFER

Your offer shall be prepared in English.

Please submit your offer using the Annexes provided. Offers not conforming to the requested formats will be not taken into consideration.

IMPORTANT:

Inclusion of copies of your offer with any correspondence sent directly to the attention of the responsible buyer or any other UNHCR staff other than the submission e-mail address will result in disqualification of the offer. Please send your bid directly and only to the address provided in the "Submission of Bid" section 2.6) of this ITB.

Your offer shall comprise the following two sets of documents:

- Technical offer
- Financial offer

In addition to this, product sample needs to be submitted as described under 2.4.1 "Pre-qualification of samples".

2.4.1 Content of the TECHNICAL OFFER

IMPORTANT:

No pricing information should be included in the Technical offer. Failure to comply will result in disqualification. The technical offer should contain all information required.

The technical details of the products requested by UNHCR can be found in **Annex A**.

The technical offer form (Annex B) should be completed, signed and included in the technical proposal.

Your technical offer should clearly state whether or not the goods you are offering are fully conforming to the product specifications given. Clearly state and disclose any discrepancies with the specifications given.

The following details shall also be provided in the Technical Offer.

Technical Item Description: Detailed description of the technical specifications of the Blankets, as per the Annex A. Offers must be fully compliant with the specifications provided in Annex A in order to be further considered.

Product Data Sheet / Catalogue: In addition to the confirmations provided in Annex B – Technical Offer Form, further data sheet and information must be provided on the specifications of the items, including the exact specifications of materials.

Incoterms: The International Chamber of Commerce Incoterms 2010 shall apply for this ITB and for any resulting purchase orders(s).

Packing and container utilization details: The technical offer shall clearly indicate the packing and transport options (e.g. weight, volume, etc.) in compliance with the packing and transport requirements part of **Annex A** to this ITB. (These are minimum packaging requirements, however suppliers are encouraged to propose alternative options for better container utilization).

Production Capacity: The bidder shall state annual production capacity.

Delivery Capacity: The bidder shall state the mobilization time, ex-stock quantity and quantities available after one, two, three and four weeks of production lead time.

Shelf life and usable lifespan: The bidder shall clearly state the recommended shelf life of the product, as well as the usable lifespan, i.e. the recommended usage period.

Inspection: Inspection and laboratory testing of goods will be applicable and will be advised at the time of purchase. The inspection will be arranged and paid for by UNHCR. Please note that inspection charges resulting from the supplier's default will be charged directly to the supplier.

Place of Inspection: The bidder shall state the place of inspection.

Country of Origin of the Supplier and place of Manufacture:

The technical offer shall state the country in which the supplier is registered as well as the country and place of manufacture of the products.

Warranty: The bid shall include defects and liability period with terms of warranty.

Certificate: If available, the bidder shall submit a copy of internationally recognized quality certificate of the manufacturing company together with a copy of quality certificate for the finished product.

Submission of samples:

The companies submitting a bid are requested to send 1 (one) reference sample of the product(s) to the following address:

The sample item must be delivered to the address provided above at latest by the closing deadline of the tender which is 07/02/2020 at 17:00 hrs Libya Time (UTC +2). Failure to provide the requested sample will result in disqualification of the offer.

Note that the sample must be handed over directly at the given office address and UNHCR will not be able to assist in any requirements concerning the shipment of the sample such as customs clearance procedures.



IMPORTANT: Samples will form an integral part of the Frame Agreement to be established. No discrepancy between the samples and the delivered item will be accepted during the contractual period.

Company Information: The bidder shall provide a list of at least 2 references of clients with similar contracts, and a valid business registration certificate.

Vendor Registration Form: If your company is not already registered with UNHCR, you should complete, sign and submit with your technical proposal the Vendor Registration Form (**Annex D**).

If your company is already registered with UNHCR, please submit an empty Vendor Registration Form clearly indicating your UNHCR Vendor ID.

Company Bank Account: Your technical offer should contain a proof of valid company bank account which accepts payment in USD currency.

UNHCR General Conditions for Provision of Goods: Your technical offer should contain your acknowledgement of the UNHCR General Conditions for Provision of Goods by signing **Annex E**.

However, please note that submitting an offer is deemed as full acceptance of UNHCR's General Conditions for Provision of Goods.

UN Supplier Code of Conduct: Your technical offer should contain your acknowledgement of the UN Supplier Code of Conduct by signing Annex F.

2.4.2 Content of the FINANCIAL OFFER

Your separate **Financial offer** must contain an overall offer in USD currency only.

IMPORTANT:

Please carefully consider the pricing model applicable to this invitation tender.

The Financial offer is to be submitted as per the Financial Offer Form (Annex C). Bids that have a different price structure may not be accepted.

The following details shall be provided for each item:

Unit costs: The bidder shall quote the unit price as per Annex C:

- EXW
- DAP Tripoli Libya
- DDP Tripoli Libya
- DAP Benghazi Libya
- DDP Benghazi Libya
- DAP Medenine/Tataouine Tunisia

Any quantity or other discounts (e.g. volume discounts) shall be clearly indicated.

UNHCR is exempt from all direct taxes and customs duties. With this regards, price has to be given without VAT.

You are requested to hold your offer valid for **90** days from the deadline for submission. UNHCR will make its best effort to select a company within this period. The pricing model quoted in the Supplier's offer will remain valid for the duration of the Frame Agreement.



UNHCR's standard payment terms are within 30 days after satisfactory implementation and receipt of documents in order.

The cost of preparing a bid and of negotiating a contract, including any related travel, is not reimbursable nor can it be included as a direct cost of the assignment.

2.5 BID EVALUATION:

2.5.1 Supplier Registration:

The qualified suppliers will be added to the Vendor Database after investigation of suitability based on the submitted Vendor Registration Form and supporting documents. The investigation involves consideration of several factors such as:

- Financial standing,
- Core business,
- Track record,
- Contract capacity.

This will be followed later by performance evaluation as a supplier such as:

- Random / periodic testing of the supplier's products,
- Ability to respond quickly to Agency's needs,
- Timely delivery,
- Dependability of products and services.
- Lead time for delivery

2.5.2 Technical evaluation:

The technical component of the submission will be evaluated using the criteria **PASS or FAIL by using the exact same structure as outlined in Annex B, and based on the requirements from Annex A.**

2.5.3 Financial evaluation:

The financial component will be analyzed only for those suppliers that pass the technical evaluation.

The Evaluation of Financial Offers – bids will be tabulated and compared with those received from all commercial entities participating in the solicitation exercise. Thus, it is of critical importance that the bidders submit complete Offers. The contract may then be awarded to the vendor(s) with the lowest priced offers passing the technical evaluation.

UN Global Compact and other factors: UNHCR supports the UN Global Compact Initiative put forward on 31 January 1999 by UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan that would bring companies together with UN agencies, labor and civil society to support ten principles in the areas of the human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. We encourage our suppliers to sign up with the UN Global Compact Initiative.

2.6 SUBMISSION OF BID:

The offers must bear your official letter head, clearly identifying your company.

Bids should be submitted by e-mail and all attachments should be in PDF format. (Copies of the PDF format documents may, as an addition, be included in Excel or other formats etc.). The Technical and Financial offers shall be clearly separated.

THE TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL OFFERS SHALL BE SENT SEPERATELY IN TWO DIFFERENT EMAILS.

IMPORTANT:

The technical offer and financial offer are to be sent in separate documents. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

The subject of the email must clearly state the type of offer (i.e. financial or technical).

Deadline: 10/02/2020, 17:00 hrs Libya Time (UTC +2).

IMPORTANT:

Any bid received after this date or sent to another UNHCR address may be rejected. UNHCR may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids, by notifying all prospective bidders simultaneously.

It is your responsibility to verify that all e-mails have been received properly before the deadline. Please be aware of the fact that the e-mail policy employed by UNHCR limits the size of attachments to a maximum of [20] Mb so it may be necessary to send more than one e-mail for the whole submission.

Please indicate in e-mail subject field:

- Name of your firm with the title of the attachment
- Type of the offer (Financial or Technical)
- Number of e-mails that are sent (example: 1/3, 2/3, 3/4).

UNHCR will not be responsible for locating or securing any information that is not identified in the bid. Accordingly, to ensure that sufficient information is available, the bidder shall furnish, as part of the bid, any descriptive material such as extracts, descriptions, and other necessary information it deems would enhance the comprehension of its offer.

IMPORTANT:

The Financial offer will only be opened for evaluation if the supplier's technical part of the offer has passed the test and has been accepted by UNHCR as meeting the technical specifications.

2.7 BID ACCEPTANCE:

UNHCR reserves the right to accept the whole or part of your bid, or to allow split or partial awards.

UNHCR may at its discretion increase or decrease the proposed content when awarding the contract and would not expect a significant variation of the rate submitted. Any such increase or decrease in the contract duration would be negotiated with the successful bidder as part of the finalization of the Purchase Orders for Goods.

UNHCR may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids, by notifying all prospective suppliers in writing. The extension of the deadline may accompany a modification of the solicitation documents prepared by UNHCR at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective supplier.

Please note that UNHCR is not bound to select any of the firms submitting bids and does not bind itself in any way to select the firm offering the lowest price. Furthermore, the contract




will be awarded to the bid considered most responsive to the needs, as well as conforming to UNHCR's general principles, including economy and efficiency and best value for money.

2.8 CURRENCY AND PAYMENT TERMS FOR PURCHASE ORDERS

Any Purchase Order (PO) issued as a result of this ITB will be made in USD currency. Payment will be made in accordance to the General Conditions for the Purchase of Goods and in the currency in which the PO is issued. Payments shall only be initiated after confirmation of successful completion by UNHCR business owner.

2.9 UNHCR GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACTS FOR THE PROVISION OF GOODS

Please note that the General Conditions of Contracts (**Annex E**) will be strictly adhered to for the purpose of any future contract. The Bidder must confirm the acceptance of these terms and conditions in writing.
