Under the direct supervision of the Senior Protection Assistant/Registration Associate and the overall supervision of the Refugee Status Determination (RSD) Officer and Senior Protection Officer, the incumbent will perform the following duties in his/her area of responsibility:

- 1. Conduct registration interviews and merged registration-RSD assessment in accordance with local procedures and registration standards.
- 2. Support the RSD team by ensuring that files are prepared and asylum claims have been translated.
- 3. Assist with the issuance of notifications of the results of RSD interviews.
- 4. Respond to queries from asylum-seekers and refugees regarding UNHCR's registration procedures and their rights and entitlements.
- 5. Maintain accurate and up-to-date records and data related to all individual registration cases.
- 6. Identify persons with specific needs and ensure timely referral for protection follow-up as required.
- 7. Collaborate with protection staff and/or partners in the delivery of assistance and programming, including provision of identity and entitlement documentation.
- 8. Act as interpreter and translator when needed.
- 9. Perform other related duties as required.

**Authority** (decisions made in executing responsibilities and to achieve results)

- Refer cases to other units within the office and to implementing partners as necessary.

**Accountability** (key results that will be achieved)

- UNHCR's Registration Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) are implemented in accordance with relevant UNHCR standards and policies.
- Persons of concern have fair and transparent access to registration procedures.





#### Qualifications/Requirements:

**Education:** Minimum completion of secondary education but preferably with post-secondary training or certificate in social science, statistics, mathematics, information technology or related fields.

**Cross – Functional Competencies**: Analytical Thinking; Technological Awareness; Planning and Organizing

**Experience:** Minimum 5 years of relevant job experience (3 years with post-secondary certificate/training). Experience working in a multi-cultural environment or international context is an asset.

Nationality: Citizen of Indonesia; non-citizen with Indonesian permanent residence.

Languages: Excellent knowledge of English and Bahasa Indonesia (written and oral) highly essential; knowledge of other UN languages is an asset.

**Desirable Skills**: Good written and oral communication skills; computer literacy; knowledge of refugee and human rights law; client and results orientation; commitment to protect refugees and willingness to cooperate with counterparts; training in basic principles of international protection; experience in working with UNHCR proGres software; knowledge of another relevant UN language. Experience of working with refugees is desirable.
