

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR INTERNSHIP

Organizational Unit: Public Information/Communications

Duty Station: Bucharest, Romania

Duration of the internship: 4 months

Expected start date: 25 March 2019

Background information/Organizational Context

The UNHCR Representation in Romania is seeking a qualified intern for a four-month internship in its Public Information Unit.

The internship would suit recent graduates and final-year students interested in communications, media and public outreach, campaigning and online communication. The internship provides a unique opportunity to gain experience in a busy Public Information Unit of a UN Agency and to raise awareness on refugee and humanitarian issues.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist in collecting information, identifying and developing stories about refugees and asylum-seekers for UNHCR's media platforms, including assistance in generating content for social media;
- Assist in the preparation of print and digital communication materials (web stories, photo essays, factsheets, info graphics etc.), visibility items and publication design;
- Assist in implementing campaigns, contacting media (print, broadcast and online) to place video spots, banners and other materials, liaison with partners and stakeholders, etc.;
- Assist in monitoring the Romanian and international media and preparing summary reports in English;
- Assist in staging events, including round table discussions, exhibitions, documentary screenings, press conferences, etc.;
- Assist in maintaining the unit's visibility, photo and video libraries as well as updating media and external stakeholder contact database:
- Assist in liaising with partners, stakeholders such as NGOs, refugee communities as well as communication with service providers;
- Assist in exploring innovative forms of communication in order to reach new audiences;
- Assist in translating short documents (Romanian-English-Romanian);



Perform other duties as required by the Public Information Unit.

Minimum qualifications required

- Recent graduate or student in the final stage of his/her university studies, specializing in journalism, communications, public relations etc.; any previous experience, including internships and volunteering, is an asset;
- Native Romanian and fluency in English are essential;
- Good communication, writing and organizational skills;
- Ability to work independently as well as in a team, flexibility and strong attention to detail;
- Interest in asylum and migration issues as well as in pro-active media and public outreach;
- Knowledge of web content management systems, graphic and multimedia design software and other communication-related online platforms and applications is an important asset.

Timeframe

The envisaged duration of the internship is of four (4) months, full-time, subject to satisfactory performance and availability.

Part-time internships may also be considered. However, the selected intern will be required to work full-time during May and June in preparation of the World Refugee Day campaign.

Remuneration and insurance

Please note that a monthly Food and Local Transportation Allowance (FLTA) of approx. RON 2,940/month will be provided, as per applicable UNHCR rules.

Upon selection, the intern will have to provide a doctor's certificate attesting good health and proof of medical insurance coverage for the full duration of the internship.
