

Communications Internship - UN Refugee Agency's Regional Representation for EU affairs (RREUA)

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) is a global organization dedicated to saving lives, protecting rights, and building a better future for refugees, forcibly displaced communities and stateless people.

The Regional Representation for EU Affairs (RREUA) is based in Brussels and works with the European Union (EU) Institutions on these issues, and closely with the European Asylum Support Office (EASO) and Frontex, the EU's Border and Coast Guard Agency. We also work hand in hand with UNHCR headquarters and country offices.

RREUA is seeking a communications intern for six months, starting March 2020 (exact dates to be agreed). This is an exciting opportunity for someone seeking professional experience in communications in a dynamic and challenging area of work. The intern will work as part of RREUA's media team.

Main duties and responsibilities

- Media and social media monitoring
- Drafting a daily media summary
- Reporting on EU developments and press conferences
- Supporting with social media content
- Assisting in the organization and running of media events
- Providing administrative assistance as required

Skills

- Excellent command of English and working knowledge of French
- Enthusiasm for all things communications (media, social, digital, events)
- Drafting and organizational skills, and attention to detail
- Team-player and professional approach

Conditions

- In order to be eligible for this internship, candidates must:
 - a. Be a recent graduate (i.e. have completed studies within one year of applying) from a university or higher education facility accredited by UNESCO; and*
 - b. Have no direct family ties with a UNHCR staff member (including Temporary Appointment holder) nor with a member of the Affiliate Workforce.*
- Food and Local Transportation Allowance (FLTA), up to USD 1000 per month in local currency, will be provided to non-sponsored interns. In cases where an intern receives funding (less than the amount of allowance described above) from a sponsoring institution or another sponsor, UNHCR will pay the difference between this amount and the above allowance.
