The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR, the UN Refugee Agency) is an international organization dedicated to saving lives, protecting rights, and building a better future for refugees, forcibly displaced communities and stateless people.

The EU Communications and Visibility Team is seeking a Communications' intern for a six-month internship, starting in March 2020 (exact dates to be agreed).

The EU Communications and Visibility Team supports UNHCR operations in the planning and implementation of EU-funded Communications and Visibility activities. The team profiles the UNHCR-EU partnership in Brussels and across the EU by way of campaigns and events.

What we offer

- Experience interning with a UN agency; and
- Work in a dynamic, international environment on matters of forced displacement.

General description of internship

Main duties and responsibilities:

- Assisting with the drafting of articles and stories;
- Supporting with social media content including videos, infographics, macros;
- Assisting with the organization and hosting of events including World Refugee Day; and
- Providing administrative assistance, as required.

Skills:

- Excellent command of English and working knowledge of French;
- Creative flair and enthusiasm for design;
- Creative skills including Adobe Creative Cloud;
- Strong drafting and organizational skills; and
- Team player and professional approach.

Conditions

In order to be eligible for this internship, candidates must:

- a. Be a recent graduate (i.e. have completed studies within one year of applying) from a university or higher education facility accredited by UNESCO; and
- b. Have no direct family ties with a UNHCR staff member (including Temporary Appointment holder) nor with a member of the Affiliate Workforce.

Food and Local Transportation Allowance (FLTA), up to USD 1000 per month in local currency, will be provided to non-sponsored interns. In cases where an intern receives funding (less than the amount of allowance described above) from a sponsoring institution or another sponsor, UNHCR will pay the difference between this amount and the above allowance.
