


Canada's Resettlement Programs

Blended Visa Refugee referred by UNHCR 3 Financial assistance: Six months from sponsors, six months from government	

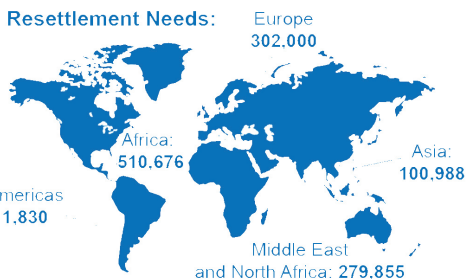
Canada's Refugee Resettlement Targets 2018-2020

Government Assisted Refugees	7,500	8,500	10,000
Blended Visa Office Referred Refugees	1,500	1,650	1,700
Privately Sponsored Refugees	18,000	19,000	20,000
Total	27,000	29,150	31,700

How many refugees are in need of resettlement?

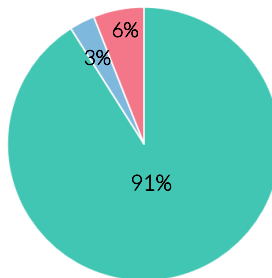
1.2 million

8% of refugees identified for resettlement by UNHCR will obtain it



In Africa, there are only 18,000 resettlement spaces available for the 510,676 refugees in need of a durable solution.

2018: Resettlement levels with Canada's overall immigration program



- 91% ALL OTHER NEWCOMERS TO CANADA
- 6% PRIVATE SPONSORSHIP (PSR 18,000)
- 3% UNHCR REFERRED (GAR 7,500, + BVOR 1,500)
