

What are UNHCR's Resettlement Referral Components?

THERE ARE 4 KEY BUILDING BLOCKS FOR UNHCR RESETTLEMENT PROCESSING :

1. REGISTRATION



- Identify management/ Programme planning
- Delivery of Assistance
- Identification of specific needs
- Case management

2. REFUGEE STATUS DETERMINATION

Meet the convention refugee definition:

- Well-founded fear of persecution
- Reason of race, religion, nationality, political opinion, or member of a social group
- Outside country of origin

3. IDENTIFICATION

- Registration data
- Participatory Assessment
- Individual case referral system
- Heightened Risk Identification Tool
- Profiling refugee needs

4. RESETTLEMENT INTERVIEW

- Legal and/or physical protection needs
- Survivors of violence and/or torture
- Medical needs
- Women and girls at risk
- Family reunification
- Children and adolescents at risk
- Lack of foreseeable alternative durable solutions
